ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY TEN NORTH DAKOTA RESIDENTS IS A  
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF NORTH DAKOTA HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 64-THOUSAND. AMERICAN INDIANS AND  
ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE,  
WITH ALMOST 38-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS HISPANICS, WITH  
12-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE  
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR MORE
