ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY FOUR OKLAHOMA RESIDENTS IS A  
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF OKLAHOMA HAS  
REACHED AN ESTIMATED ONE-MILLION. AMERICAN INDIANS AND  
ALASKA NATIVES REPRESENT THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE,  
WITH MORE THAN 393-THOUSAND PEOPLE. SECOND WAS BLACKS, WITH  
321-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS REMAIN THE  
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR MORE
