MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH MORE THAN 396-THOUSAND PEOPLE.  
SECOND WAS ASIANS, WITH 169-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY,  
HISPANICS REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS
