ANNOUNCER:

MORE THAN ONE IN EVERY EIGHT WYOMING RESIDENTS IS A
MINORITY. THE TOTAL MINORITY POPULATION OF WYOMING HAS
REACHED AN ESTIMATED 66-THOUSAND. HISPANICS REPRESENT THE
LARGEST MINORITY GROUP HERE, WITH ALMOST 38-THOUSAND
PEOPLE. SECOND WAS AMERICAN INDIANS AND ALASKA NATIVES,
WITH ALMOST 17-THOUSAND PEOPLE. NATIONALLY, HISPANICS
REMAIN THE LARGEST MINORITY GROUP, WITH BLACKS SECOND. FOR
