SEC. 747. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING THE MURDER 1 2 OF JOHN M. ALVIS. 3 (a) FINDINGS.—The Congress makes the following 4 findings: 5 (1) On November 30, 2000, John M. Alvis was 6 brutally murdered in Baku, Azerbaijan. 7 (2) John Alvis was serving his final two weeks 8 of a two year full-time commitment to the Inter-9 national Republican Institute, an American non-10 governmental organization carrying out assistance 11 projects for the United States Government to help 12 promote democracy and strengthen the rule of law 13 in Azerbaijan. 14 (3) Almost immediately following the news of 15 the murder of John M. Alvis, our United States Am-16 bassador to Azerbaijan, Ross Wilson, raised the 17 issue with the President of Azerbaijan and with

the Minister of Interior, and was assured that every

effort would be made to carry out a prompt and

thorough investigation.
