10 (1) the armed forces of Lebanon have been de11 ployed to the internationally recognized border be12 tween Lebanon and Israel; and

16 (b) ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE.—If the President has 17 not made the certification described in subsection (a) with-18 in 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act, 19 the President shall provide to the appropriate congres-20 sional committees a plan to terminate assistance to Leb-21 anon provided under chapter 4 of part II of the Foreign
