

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1646, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. LANTOS OF CALIFORNIA**

Page 153, after line 23, add the following:

1 **SEC. 863. ASSISTANCE TO LEBANON.**

2 (a) **MILITARY ASSISTANCE.**—Notwithstanding any  
3 other provision of law, the President shall not provide as-  
4 sistance under chapter 5 of part II of the Foreign Assist-  
5 ance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2347 et seq.; relating to  
6 international military education and training) to the  
7 armed forces of the Government of Lebanon unless the  
8 President certifies to the appropriate congressional com-  
9 mittees that—

10 (1) the armed forces of Lebanon have been de-  
11 ployed to the internationally recognized border be-  
12 tween Lebanon and Israel; and

13 (2) the Government of Lebanon is effectively  
14 asserting its authority in the area in which such  
15 forces have been deployed.

16 (b) **ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE.**—If the President has  
17 not made the certification described in subsection (a) with-  
18 in 6 months after the date of the enactment of this Act,  
19 the President shall provide to the appropriate congres-  
20 sional committees a plan to terminate assistance to Leb-  
21 anon provided under chapter 4 of part II of the Foreign
