

**Amendment to H.R.  
(Supplemental Appropriations, 2005)  
Offered by Mr. Hensarling of Texas**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert  
the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_ (a) OFFSETTING GOVERNMENT-WIDE  
2 RESCISSION.—Of the discretionary budget authority pro-  
3 vided in appropriation Acts for fiscal year 2005, there is  
4 rescinded the total amount determined by the Director of  
5 the Office of Management and Budget to be required to  
6 offset the discretionary budget authority that is provided  
7 in this Act and designated as an emergency requirement.

8       (b) APPLICATION.—The rescission made by sub-  
9 section (a)—

10           (1) shall take effect immediately after the en-  
11 actment of all of the regular appropriation Acts for  
12 fiscal year 2005 (whether enacted separately, in-  
13 cluded in a consolidated appropriations law, or cov-  
14 ered by a continuing appropriations law that funds  
15 programs through the end of the fiscal year);

16           (2) shall not apply to the discretionary budget  
17 authority provided for the Departments of Defense,  
18 Homeland Security, and Veterans Affairs; and



1           (3) shall be applied proportionately to the dis-  
2           cretionary budget authority provided for each other  
3           department, agency, instrumentality, and entity of  
4           the Federal Government.

5           (c) REPORT.—The Director of the Office of Manage-  
6           ment and Budget shall include in the President's budget  
7           submission for fiscal year 2006 a report specifying the re-  
8           ductions made to each account, program, project, and ac-  
9           tivity pursuant to this section.
