**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3550, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. BEREUTER**

At the end of title IV, add the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 4133. OPERATORS OF VEHICLES TRANSPORTING AGRICULTURAL**
2 **COMMODITIES AND FARM SUPPLIES.**

4 (a) **AGRICULTURAL EXEMPTION.**—Sec. 345(a)(1) of
5 the National Highway System Designation Act of 1995
6 (49 U.S.C. 31136 note; 109 Stat. 613) is amended to read
7 as follows:

8 “(1) **TRANSPORTATION OF AGRICULTURAL COM-**
9 **MODITIES AND FARM SUPPLIES.**—Regulations pre-
10 scribed by the Secretary under sections 31136 and
11 31502 of title 49, United States Code, regarding
12 maximum driving and on-duty time for drivers used
13 by motor carriers shall not apply to drivers trans-
14 porting agricultural commodities or farm supplies
15 for agricultural purposes in a State if such transpor-
16 tation is limited to an area within a 100 air mile ra-
17 dius from the source of the commodities or the dis-
18 tribution point for the farm supplies.”.

1 (b) DEFINITIONS.—Section 345(e) of such Act of
2 1995 (109 Stat. 614) is amended by adding at the end
3 the following:

4 “(7) AGRICULTURAL COMMODITY.—The term
5 ‘agricultural commodity’ means products grown on
6 and harvested from the land during the planting and
7 harvesting seasons within each State, as determined
8 by the State.

9 “(8) FARM SUPPLIES FOR AGRICULTURAL PUR-
10 POSES.—The term ‘farm supplies for agricultural
11 purposes’ means products directly related to the
12 growing or harvesting of agricultural commodities
13 during the planting and harvesting seasons within
14 each State, as determined by the State, and livestock
15 feed at any time of the year.”.
