**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4200, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HUNTER OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of title X (page 409, after line 13), insert
the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT CERTAIN VOLUNTARY**
2 **SERVICES.**

3 Section 1588 of title 10, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
6 following new paragraph:

7 “(8) Voluntary services to support programs of
8 a committee of the Employer Support of the Guard
9 and Reserve as authorized by the Secretary of De-
10 fense.”; and

11 (2) in subsection (f)(1), by inserting “and
12 (a)(8)” before the period at the end.

At the end of subtitle G of title X (page 385, after
line 10), insert the following new section:

13 **SEC. ____ . PHASED IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW PROGRAM**
14 **FOR TRANSPORTING HOUSEHOLD GOODS OF**
15 **MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

16 The Secretary of Defense may not implement the new
17 program for the transportation of household goods of
18 members of the Armed Forces and their dependents be-



1 yond phase I of the program, which includes the testing
2 of electronic bill processing at 14 sites, until the Secretary
3 submits to Congress a report evaluating whether Phase
4 I met its objectives and whether it is in the best interest

9 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2004 (Public Law 108-136;
10 117 Stat. 1582) is amended by striking "\$2,500,000,000"
11 and inserting "\$3,000,000,000".

12 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON AMOUNTS REMITTED AND REIM-**

15 Not later than 30 days after the end of fiscal year
16 2004, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the con-
17 gressional defense committees a report on amounts remit-
18 ted and reimbursed during fiscal year 2004 under section
19 1007 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal

At the end of title I (page 27, after line 10), insert the following new section:

3 **SEC. 1 ____ . ADDITIONAL AMOUNT FOR PATRIOT MISSILE**

4 **PROCUREMENT.**

5 (a) **ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS.**—The amount in section
6 101 for Army procurement, missiles, is hereby increased
7 by \$90,000,000, to be available for Patriot missiles.

8 (b) **OFFSETTING REDUCTIONS.**—(1) The amount in
9 section 101 for Other Support Space Programs is hereby
10 decreased by \$27,000,000, to be derived from Titan Space
11 Boosters (SPACE).

12 (2) The amount in section 301(4) for operation and
13 maintenance, Air Force, is hereby reduced by
14 \$15,000,000, to be derived from the transportation work-
15 ing capital fund.

16 (3) The amount in section 201(4) for research, devel-
17 opment, test, and evaluation, defense-wide, is hereby re-
18 duced by \$48,000,000, to be derived from the Ballistic

At the end of subtitle A of title II (page 28, after line 14), insert the following new section:

3 **SEC. 2___ . PROGRAM INCREASES.**

4 (a) NANO-COMPOSITE HARD-COAT FOR AIRCRAFT
5 CANOPIES.—The amount provided in section 201(2) for
6 research development, test and evaluation, Navy, is hereby
7 increased by \$5,000,000, to be available for Nano-com-
8 posite hard-coat for aircraft canopies in Program Element
9 0205633N.

10 (b) COMMAND-AND-CONTROL SERVICE LEVEL MAN-
11 AGEMENT.—The amount provided in section 201(3) for
12 research development, test and evaluation, Air Force, is
13 hereby increased by \$5,000,000, to be available for com-
14 mand-and-control service level management in Program
15 Element 0207443F for best-commercial practices and en-
16 terprise wide architectures for military command-and-con-
17 trol applications.

At the end of subtitle A of title III (page 43, after line 3), insert the following new section:



1 **SEC. 3. REDUCTION IN AUTHORIZATION FOR AIR FORCE**
2 **OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE.**

3 The amount authorized to be appropriated in section
4 301(4) is hereby reduced by \$10,000,000, to be derived
5 from the transportation working capital fund.

Strike section 215 (page 36, lines 1 through 9).

Strike section 2818 (page 514, lines 1 through 16)
and insert the following new section:

6 **SEC. 2818. REPORT ON FEASIBILITY OF VETERANS MEMO-**
7 **RIAL AT MARINE CORPS AIR STATION, EL**
8 **TORO, CALIFORNIA.**

9 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
10 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Navy shall submit
11 to Congress a report on whether the City of Irvine's antici-
12 pated future uses of the former MCAS El Toro property
13 would permit the establishment and maintenance of a vet-
14 erans memorial at no cost to the Federal Government.
