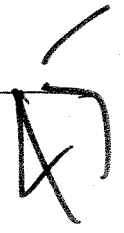

At the end of title II (page , after line),
 insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL AMOUNTS FOR ORDNANCE TECH-
 2 NOLOGY AND FOR STRATEGIC CAPABILITY
 3 MODERNIZATION.

4 (a) AIR FORCE CONVENTIONAL MUNITIONS.—The
 5 amount in section 201(3) for research, development, test,
 6 and evaluation for the Air Force is hereby increased by
 7 \$25,000,000, of which—

8 (1) \$10,000,000 is to be available in program
 9 element 0602602F, Conventional Munitions, for ord-
 10 nance technology applicable to defeat of weapons of
 11 mass destruction and hardened, deeply buried tar-
 12 gets; and

13 (2) \$15,000,000 is to be available in program
 14 element 0603601F, Conventional Weapons Tech-
 15 nology, for ordnance technology applicable to defeat
 16 of weapons of mass destruction and hardened, deep-
 17 ly buried targets.

18 (b) DEFENSE-WIDE STRATEGIC CAPABILITY MOD-
 19 ERNIZATION.—The amount in section 201(4) for research,
 20 development, test, and evaluation, Defense-wide, is hereby



1 increased by \$11,557,000, to be available for program ele-
2 ment 0603910D8Z, Strategic Capability Modernization.

3 (c) OFFSET.—The amount in section 3101(a)(1) for
4 weapons activities is hereby reduced by \$36,557,000, of
5 which—

6 (1) \$27,557,000 is to be derived from the
7 Stockpile Services Robust Nuclear Earth Penetrator
8 study; and

9 (2) \$9,000,000 is to be derived from the Stock-
10 pile Services Advanced Concepts program.
