NO RULES COMBAT OR SIMILAR CONTESTS

§16-182-1 Application for matches or exhibitions involving no rules combat, extreme or ultimate fighting, and other similar competitions

§16-182-1 Application for matches or exhibitions involving no rules combat, extreme or ultimate fighting, and other similar competitions. (a) At least thirty days prior to any match or exhibition involving no rules combat, extreme or ultimate fighting, and other similar competitions, a promoter shall complete and submit an application to the department to establish that the match or exhibition is not prohibited under chapter 440D, HRS. The application shall be on a form prescribed by the department. The failure to comply with any of the requirements in this subsection shall be grounds to deny the application.

(b) The application shall be accompanied by a report from a licensed physician for every contestant listed in the application, stating that the contestant is in satisfactory physical and mental health to participate in the match or exhibition. The report shall be dated no more than sixty calendar days prior to the date of the match or exhibition, and shall be signed by the physician who examined the contestant. In the report, the physician also shall attest that the contestant:

- (1) Has had, within sixty calendar days prior to the date of the match or exhibition, a proper serological test for syphilis, human immunodeficiency virus, and hepatitis virus;
- (2) Is free from active venereal diseases or other contagious diseases, including but not limited to the human immunodeficiency virus and hepatitis virus; and
- (3) Has no postured or skeletal difficulty, recent fracture, heart or blood or kidney disease, or any recent acute illness which might in any way endanger the life or health of a contestant.

If the physician's report does not contain the information required under this subsection, the contestant shall be prohibited from participating in the match or exhibition.

(c) This section shall be in effect until July 1, 2009." [Eff and comp] (Auth: §§440D-3, 440D-6) (Imp: §440D-3)

2. The adoption of chapter 16-182, Hawaii Administrative Rules, shall take effect ten days after filing with the Office of the Lieutenant Governor.
