**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2844, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. SKELTON OF MISSOURI**

In section 26(b) of the Revised Statutes of the United States, as proposed to be added by the bill, add at the end the following new paragraph:

1           “(5) PERIOD FOR BALLOT TRANSIT TIME FOR  
2           ABSENT MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTERS.—Not-  
3           withstanding the deadlines referred to in paragraphs  
4           (2) and (3), in the case of an individual who is an  
5           absent uniformed services voter or an overseas voter  
6           (as such terms are defined in the Uniformed and  
7           Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act), a State  
8           shall accept and process any otherwise valid ballot or  
9           other election material from the voter so long as the  
10          ballot or other material is received by the appro-  
11          priate State election official not later than 45 days  
12          after the State transmits the ballot or other material  
13          to the voter.”.
