NARRATIVE ACCOUNT:

REPORT:

PHYSICAL NEGLECT OF 7 MONTH OLD FEMALE- RONELA PASCUAL, BY MOTHER- 19 Y.O. DELA PASCUAL. CHILD REMAINS HOSPITALIZED AT KAPIOLANI MEDICAL CENTER (KMC) PENDING CPS INVESTIGATION.

HARM:

FIRST FAILURE TO THRIVE DIAGNOSIS:

- AT BIRTH, CHILD WAS IN THE 75 PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT, AND WAS DISCHARGED TO MOTHER'S CARE
- CHILD THEN CAME TO THE ATTENTION OF KMC AS FAILURE TO THRIVE ON 7/26/02
- ON 7/26/02, CHILD HAD DROPPED TO BELOW THE 5 PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT
- MOTHER REPORTED CHILD WAS REFUSING BOTTLES, AND WOULD ONLY BREAST FEED.

MOTHER REPORTED GIVING CHILD SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD, AND REPORTED FEEDING CHILD "STRANGE" FOOD, SUCH AS CHEETOS (SNACK CHIPS). MOTHER REPORTED GIVING CHILD CHEETOS TO DR. ALLAN IKEDA, PEDIATRIC INTERN AT KMC.

-FOLLOWING PSYCHIATRIC CONSULTATION FOR MOTHER, AND REFERRAL FOR SERVICES TO INCLUDE COUNSELING FOR MOTHER AND 0 TO 3 PROGRAM FOR CHILD, KMC DISCHARGED CHILD TO MOTHER

SECOND FAILURE TO THRIVE DIAGNOSIS:

-CHILD WAS ADMITTED TO KMC ON 8/13/02, AGAIN WITH FAILURE TO THRIVE, NOW BEING BELOW THE 3 PERCENTILE

-MOTHER REPORTED CHILD CONTINUED TO REFUSE BOTTLES, AND MOTHER WAS TRYING TO BREAST FEED AND GIVE SUPPLEMENTAL BABY FOOD

-HOSPITAL STAFF ATTEMPTED TO BOTTLE FEED CHILD, AND CHILD REFUSED

-CHILD WAS PUT ON IV FOR NUTRITION, AND IMMEDIATELY BEGAN TO GAIN WEIGHT

-AT THE TIME OF THIS ADMISSION, MOTHER HAD FAILED TO FOLLOW THROUGH WITH KMC'S PREVIOUSLY RECOMMENDED SERVICES

MEDICAL CONSULTATION:

-THERE IS A POSSIBILITY THAT MOTHER IS TRYING TO BREAST FEED, BUT BREAST MILK IS INADEQUATE TO PROVIDE NUTRITION NEEDED (THIS WAS EXPLAINED TO MOTHER AT FIRST ADMISSION)

-THAT THERE IS NO OTHER EXPLANATION TO ACCOUNT FOR RAPID WEIGHT LOSS, AND

IMMEDIATE WEIGHT GAIN FOLLOWING IV, THAN THAT MOTHER IS NOT FEEDING CHILD ADEQUATELY. MOTHER REPORTS THAT "BABY EATS FINE AT HOME".

PSYCHIATRIC CONSULTATION:

-MOTHER

-MOTHER IS EXHIBITING BEHAVIORS CONSISTENT WITH \_\_\_\_\_ ALTHOUGH SHE DENIES ANY SYMPTOMS

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR VICTIMS:

- 7 MONTH OLD RONELA IS FAILURE TO THRIVE, AND IN THE LESS THAN 3RD PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT. CHILD IS CURRENTLY ON IV FOR NUTRITION AT KMC.
- CHILD IS IN THE HIGHEST RISK AGE GROUP FOR SERIOUS/FATAL HARM.

NEED FOR OUT OF HOME PLACEMENT:

HOSPITALIZED AT KAPIOLANI MEDICAL CENTER (KMC) PENDING CPS INVESTIGATION.

ASSESSMENT:

PROTECTIVE SERVICES INVESTIGATION IS WARRANTED, AND THE HOME CANNOT BE DEEMED SAFE BASED ON:

- 1) MAGNITUDE OF NEGLECT IS IDENTIFIED AS SEVERE, WITH CHILD HAVING BEEN DIAGNOSED ON TWO OCCASIONS (7/26/02 AND 8/13/02) WITH FAILURE TO THRIVE, CURRENTLY BEING BELOW THE 3RD PERCENTILE FOR WEIGHT. FAILURE TO THRIVE IS POTENTIALLY LIFE THREATENING, AND SITUATION MUST BE INVESTIGATED PRIOR TO CHILD'S RELEASE FROM HOSPITAL.
- 2) MOTHER APPEARS UNABLE TO GRASP THE GRAVITY OF CHILD'S MEDICAL CONDITION, AND APPEARS UNWILLING/UNABLE TO RESOLVE CURRENT CONCERNS, AS SHE HAS FAILED TO

FOLLOW THROUGH WITH SERVICES REQUESTED BY KMC.

- 3) MOTHER IS \_\_\_\_\_, AND MUST BE FURTHER ASSESSED AS TO \_\_\_\_\_ CONDITION/DIAGNOSIS, VIA COMPLETE \_\_\_\_\_ EVALUATION.
- 4) MOTHER HAS BEEN RESISTANT TO PROVIDING INFORMATION TO KMC MEDICAL STAFF, WITH REFUSAL TO ANSWER QUESTIONS, OR GIVING VAGUE ANSWERS AND STATING "I DON'T KNOW".
- 5) MOTHER IS CURRENTLY UNEMPLOYED AND \_\_\_\_\_ UNKNOWN HOW MOTHER PLANS TO FINANCIALLY SUPPORT HERSELF AND CHILD.
- 6) MULTIPLE STRESSORS FOR MOTHER, INCLUDING HER YOUNG AGE, COUPLED WITH \_\_\_\_\_ BEING A SINGLE PARENT AND HER OWN CPS HISTORY AS A MINOR VICTIM, RAISES CONCERNS AS TO HER ABILITY TO NURTURE AND PARENT A YOUNG INFANT.
- 7) MOTHER HAS A LIMITED SUPPORT SYSTEM, AND CURRENTLY RESIDES WITH HER PARENTS, WHO WERE CONFIRMED PERPETRATORS OF ABUSE AND NEGLECT IN SEVERAL CPS INVESTIGATIONS DURING MOTHER'S CHILDHOOD.
- 8) MOTHER'S DRUG USE IS UNKNOWN, AND MUST BE FURTHER ASSESSED.

DISPOSITION:

- INTAKE IS ASSIGNED FOR INVESTIGATION TO UNIT #60, BASED ON CENSUS TRACT #92
- CHILD RISK ASSESSMENT: SEVERE
