Aloha

First I am not sure what the meeting is all about. I hope it is not one of those fact finding meetings that will go against the progress of Ronela with the parents. Should the GAL of Ronela be at this meeting?

I am taking a PTO on the regular job for this. Just to let you know, I have not been paid by the Insurance for my services. Long story, but I have been seeing them pro bono all my service with them.

Did they report to you that Ronela came home with a biggern than a coin blister on her leg one time, then another time with a red bruise on the corner of one of her eyes, and a blister on her hand? I think we need to carefully supevised with the Pact the condition of Ronela without disturbing her psyche in doing so. As far as I know, no one smokes in this familyl. I have visited them twice and their home does not smell anything, even bagoong.

The parents are really very excited about the favorable recommendations that they have been receiving, i.e., longer hours of visits, and overnite recommendations soon. They also told me that Ronela will be returned by the first week of March, before you take off to another assignment. They have also been thrilled about Ronela's verbal interactions with them, and how she has socialize appropriately with her cousins. This, despite, the lack of social stimulation as she has been kept home for most of her life with the foster parents. Where is the child left behind on this situation? Dela did not sense any retardation on her part when they are together. Except, perhaps, some timidity, which is the hall mark of Filipino family and children. They told me that Mr. Springer has ended, but I do not believe they understood why he has finished his task. They think it is because he has seen no obstacles to their ability as parents. They have to think positive, of course! Is this true?

How is your leaving this family affect the continuity of their rights?

I will see you as best as I could make it. Please make this as an official communication for me on this matter.

The case name is Dela Pascual and the child is Ronela Pascual.

DHS filed a Motion for Permanent Custody a while back and for various reasons, the Motion had been continued. We were in the middle of the PC trial but after the child's therapist, Dr. Barbara Rutter, testified, everyone was not convinced that parents, primarily father, was unable to care for the child now and the foreseeable near future. As a result, the PC trial has been continued. (I was the one who testified and attend the trial as this was one of [redacted] case). We have been working closely with the parents therapist and the child's therapist, and also obtained a separate family therapist for this family. Also, had an Ohana Conference (I believe more that one with at interpreters) to rally up family support for the parents.

Child is very special needs as she was initially Failure to Thrive and now has attachment problems. Visits with parents were terminated for a period of time and reinitiated. Biological father was initially in the Philippines and came to Hawaii. He has since been able to demonstrate progress. Mother is not able to care independently for the child.

Foster parents are great and take good care of the child. They very much want to adopt this child as they have cared for her for almost three years. We understand their reports of concerns regarding the child's behaviors, etc. upon return home. This was to be expected and we have been working closely with Dr. Rutter. In addition, the GAL and Courts are monitoring this case closely as well. We are transitioning to return to the child home, I believe the plan is scheduled for early March but go to court two days prior.

Given the complicated nature of this case, reunification had been slow and prolonged. Basically, reunification appears realistic next month. We are talking about reunifying a child home with parents, not placing into another home with a relative.

Both foster parents and biological parents have provided videotapes of the child's interactions and adjustment in both settings. The therapists involved with this family has also viewed the tapes.

FYI-The foster parents are going through a tough time right now. We are looking at reunifying this child with her parents next month. A paternal grandmother in another state is being explored for another child that these foster parents have had for at least the past couple of years ( [redacted] ). Although, foster mother went to Africa for a number of months in attempts to adopt a child they have been sponsoring but was not able to due to sometype of difficulties.

We feel for the foster parents but if we can reunify a child home, that should be our primary goal. Hope this info. helps.

Ronela has come home very hyper and kicks and hits foster mother and foster dad. She is also mean to foster brother.

She came home on 27 January Friday and her clothes were changed and her hair was wet. The returned clothes were not soiled.

While I helped her dress this Sunday she said the following.

"I took a bath with mommy Dela and I saw mommy Dela's gina, butt and boobies."

She also shares that she has been to Chucky Cheese and that she ate pizza and had apple pie.

She is now talking about what she does during her visits.

She over the last three weeks on several occasions says: "I want to see you naked"

She continues to be destructive and has broken her play phone the one she loves to play with.

She pulls on her belly button until it bleeds and continues to pull on it.

She becomes frustrated about simple tasks such as folding her blanket and is being very bossy and yells.

We reported this to Dr. Rutter today during Ronela's session.

Hi

I rec'd your voicemail. First of all I would like to thank you for the care, commitment and patience you have provided to Ronela these past few years. Ronela is going through a stressful time in her life and all of us need to be able to support her so that it will be a smooth transition. As far as her eczema and lack of sleep please follow-up with her PCP. I will talk to parents about having her take a nap after lunch so that she is not so exhausted when she gets home from her visitations. When I visited last week, I was glad to see that Ronela is much more verbal and active as she was initially very guarded and hypervigilant when I first became her social worker. I can tell she is very close to \_\_\_\_\_ and they have a relationship as most siblings would. You should receive a copy of the report and service plan some time next week. Thanks again!

I left a message and here is a report on Ronela's behavior, please advice us what we should do. Ronela came home very hyper after her visit and has been this way since Monday 30 January' 06. She speaks and yells and her tongue comes out in between words about two ,three times. It seems she does not realize that she is doing this. The eczema on her right leg is not improving and the eczema now is spreading to her right elbow. She has not slept in her own bed for more than a month and has been sleeping next to foster brother. She now is not sleeping next to him and refuses to go to sleep at night. Please again advice us.

Also if you would be so kind as to send us a care/service plan on her so that we can properly prepare her.

**Issue:** Their foster child is mentally deteriorating whenever she is with her real family; and the DHS caseworker still wants the child united with her family (anyone related to her). The child has been in and out of foster care for two years.

**Details:**

1. The judge ruled for continuance on permanent custody, leaving the door open for the possibility of adoption by her foster parents
2. The caseworker, ... is insisting on reunification of the child with her family (any family member), and refuses to listen to the ... concerns about the child's behavior.
3. The ... videotaped the foster child while in their care. The child was happy. The child's real family also videotaped her in their care. The child sullen, not talking, and pointing her finger to what she wanted.

Whenever she was returned to her foster parents, she was misbehaving and saying inappropriate things, such as calling them stupid.

**What they hope will happen:**

1. That someone investigate their case, and persuade the caseworker that it may not be in the child's best interest to place her back with her family.
2. That DHS accept the therapist's advice to have someone else, besides the caseworker, evaluate the child and the quality of care.

**What I told them our role is:**

1. We are not an investigating agency. However, we may have to refer her to the DHS's liaison person (did give them ... name) and see if this person can assist them. Also, that due to privacy issues, we are not allowed to ask questions and they are not allowed to give out any information.

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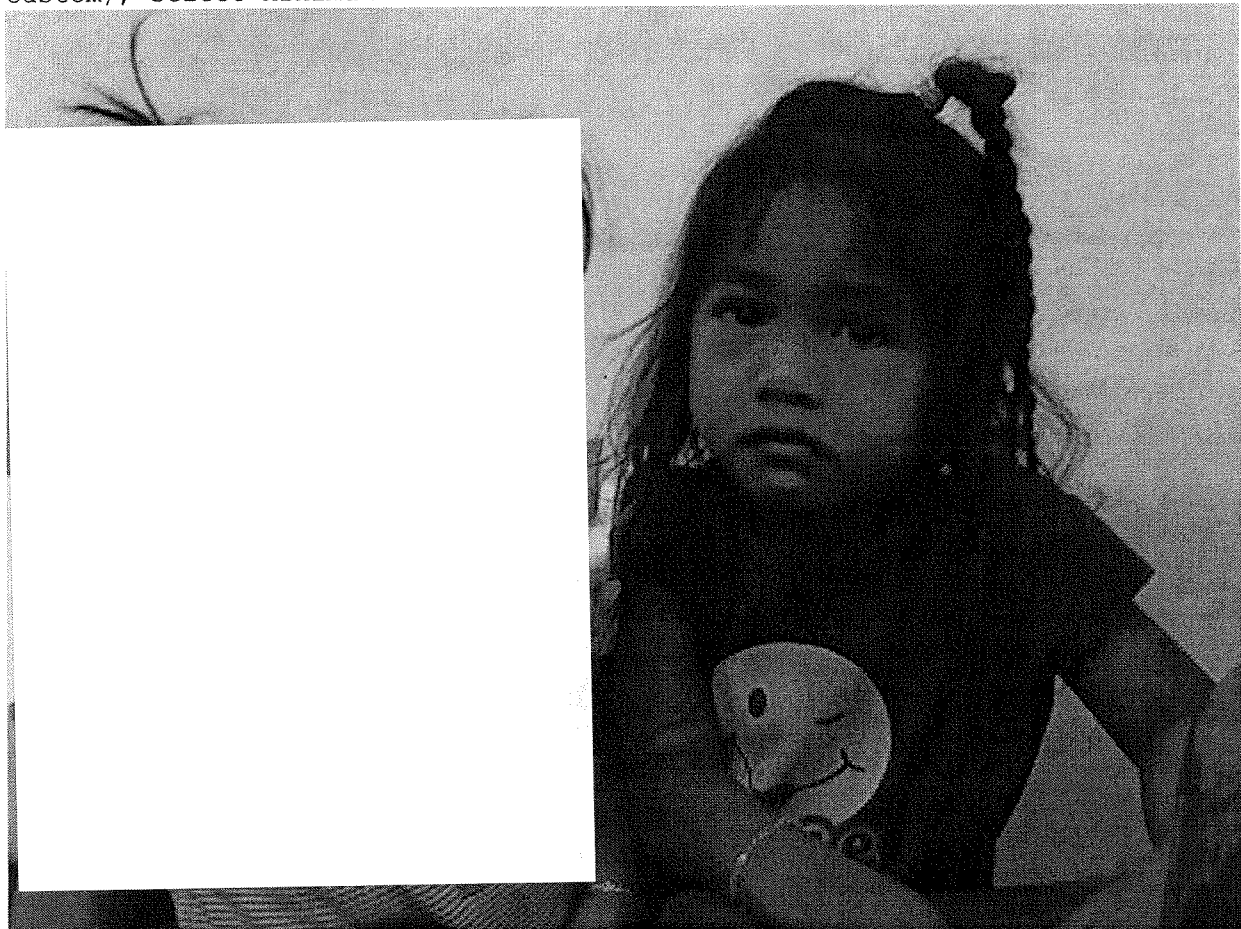


