Interview With Mother

Jaylin reports that she has provided care for her children since they were born. She denies any use of physical discipline on the children. She reports she "talks" to them when they do something wrong. Jaylin denies any drug or alcohol use, either by herself or Peter. Jaylin reports Peter "used to drink" but he reportedly quiet prior to their moving to Hilo. Jaylin reports that Peter does not hit her or threaten her. She also reports that Peter does not hit the children.

Interview With Boyfriend

Peter reports that when he met Jaylin, she was living in Kona with her cousin, who Peter reported was a prostitute. Jaylin had 2 children. He described how he met Jaylin at Hale Malawai one evening. Jaylin had left her 2 children in the car alone. Peter reports he felt sorry for Jaylin's living situation and wanted to help her to see that she needed to have a better life for herself and her children. Peter and Jaylin reportedly moved in with Jaylin [REDACTED] in December 1989. Peter reports he does not use physical discipline on the children. He reports he "yells" and "points" when the children do something wrong. Peter denies any current drug or alcohol use. He admits to previously "drinking a lot and smoking pot heavily". Approximately one year ago, Peter was accused of breaking in to a home and stealing items. He reports the case is currently being sent to the prosecutor. He reports he was previously on probation for accomplice to a burglary.

Interview with Jaylin and Peter

Jaylin and Peter report that Jaylin [REDACTED]s have "filled the kids' heads" with false information, such as "mom no love you". Jaylin and Peter report that [REDACTED] will say anything that [REDACTED] tells them to. Jaylin and Peter report that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have fallen off the merry-go-round and jungle gym and that is how they received bruises. They also report that the children have fallen while climbing and have fallen down the stairs to their apartment on occasion which could have caused the bruises. Jaylin and Peter live on the second floor of their apartment building. They reported that on May 3, 1991, [REDACTED] backed into a table in their apartment which caused the bruise on her face. They also report that [REDACTED] recently fell down the stairs and caused a sore on her lower lip. They reported that [REDACTED] bruise on his face was due to a fall from the jungle gym. Jaylin and Peter's newborn remains at Kapiolani hospital due to fluid in the lungs. Jaylin and Peter had planned to visit the baby in Honolulu, so on May 7, 1991, they left [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in the care of Peter's sister, Dorothy Kepano. They did not want Dorothy to take the children to [REDACTED] home. Jaylin and Peter report [REDACTED] have been in a long time battle with them because [REDACTED] want to raise the children.

Interview with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] reported that she has cared for [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] off and on since their birth. She reports she has provided care so that Jaylin, mother, could go to school, obtain employment and "get her life together". [REDACTED] reports that Jaylin remains very unstable to date. [REDACTED] reported that Jaylin and her live-in boyfriend, Peter, lived with them until approx. 2 months ago, when Jaylin and Peter moved to Hilo. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] came to Kona to visit [REDACTED] and on April 7, 1991, [REDACTED] refused to leave. Jaylin allowed [REDACTED] to remain with [REDACTED] until April 11, 1991 when she returned to pick him up. Again, [REDACTED] reportedly clung to [REDACTED] and said he did not want to return home. Jaylin insisted that he return to the family home in Hilo. On April 28, 1991, [REDACTED] visited the children in Hilo. [REDACTED] noticed a bruise on [REDACTED] face. Jaylin reported that [REDACTED] had fallen. During this visit [REDACTED] reportedly told [REDACTED], "I no like Peter, I no like mom."

Jaylin gave birth to a son May 1, 1991. Jaylin returned home May 3, 1991. Jaylin informed [REDACTED] that the baby is fine and "sleeping in his room" referring to their home in Hilo. Peter's sister, Dorthy Kepano, informed [REDACTED] that in fact, the baby is at Kapiolani Hospital due to respiratory problems. On May 7, 1991, Jaylin left [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] in the care of Dorthy Kepano as she and Peter were planning to fly to Honolulu to visit their son. Dorthy was concerned about the children's bruises and took the children to [REDACTED] that same day. [REDACTED] reported she did not know what to do. She wanted to handle the matter within the family. [REDACTED] was told by her boss that she should take pictures of the bruises, which she reportedly did. On May 8, 1991 the police contacted [REDACTED] and told her that Jaylin wanted her children returned. [REDACTED] was fearful of the children's safety, so she went to the DHS welfare office. The welfare office reportedly informed her to go to the DHS CPS crisis unit. [REDACTED] reported she went to the Kona CPS crisis unit on May 8, 1991 and the social worker, [REDACTED], informed her she needed to contact Hilo CPS as mother lives in Hilo. [REDACTED] reported she called Hilo and was told they were short staffed and a worker would contact them "in a couple of days". [REDACTED] then took the children to the Kona Police Station asking for assistance. Kona police reportedly attempted to reach the CPS stand by worker on 2 occasions. They did not receive a response from the Hilo stand-by worker and contacted the stand-by worker in Kona.

[REDACTED] reports that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] birth father is [REDACTED] Jaylin and [REDACTED] were not married. [REDACTED] reportedly maintains visits with the children and the children are aware that he is their father. [REDACTED] resides in Kona. [REDACTED] does not support the children financially.

[REDACTED] STATED THAT SHE IS CALLING FROM KONA. SHE WAS REFERRED TO THE HOU CPS OFFICE BY AN INVESTIGATOR IN KONA [REDACTED] BECAUSE [REDACTED] JAYLIN ALSO RESIDES IN PEPEHEO [REDACTED] IS CONCERNED ABOUT HER [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] CHILDREN ARE PRESENTLY [REDACTED] IN KONA.

[REDACTED] STATED THAT JAYLIN (DOB 4/10/79) GAVE BIRTH ON 1/1/91. THIS CHILD IS PRESENTLY AT LAPOHANI HOSPITAL. JAYLIN'S BOYFRIEND IS PETER KENA. PETER'S SISTER, DOROTHY (LAST NAME UNKNOWN), HAS BEEN WATCHING [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED]. DOROTHY BROUGHT THE CHILDREN TO KONA YESTERDAY BECAUSE [REDACTED] TOLD HER THAT HE WANTED TO STAY WITH [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] TRIED TALKING JAYLIN INTO GOING TO OAHU TO BE WITH HER BABY SO THAT THE CHILDREN COULD STAY WITH HER A FEW DAYS LONGER. THE REASON [REDACTED] WANTED THEM TO STAY IS BECAUSE SHE WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE BRUISES THAT THEY HAD ON THEIR FACES.

[REDACTED] TOOK THE CHILDREN TO THE KONA CPS OFFICE. SHE STATES THAT IN SHOULD CONTACT [REDACTED] [REDACTED] SAW THE BRUISES ON THE CHILDREN AND SPOKE WITH [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] WOULD NOT TELL [REDACTED] WHAT [REDACTED] TOLD HER BECAUSE THE INFORMATION WAS CONFIDENTIAL.

[REDACTED] SUSPICIONS BEGAN ON 4/28/91. SHE VISITED THE CHILDREN AND SAW A BRUISE ON [REDACTED] RIGHT CHEEK. IT WAS ABOUT THE SIZE OF A NICKEL AND WAS DARK BLUE IN COLOR. [REDACTED] DID NOT HAVE BRUISES AT THE TIME. [REDACTED] ASKED JAYLIN ABOUT THE BRUISE AND JAYLIN'S REPLY WAS THAT [REDACTED] RAN AND FELL DOWN. [REDACTED] THOUGHT THAT THIS WAS TYPICAL AND WASN'T CONCERNED AT THE TIME.
