Social Security Number Requirement, Authority and Disclosure Statement

As part of your application for an initial, renewed, or reinstated professional license issued by the Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (PT Board), you are required to provide your Social Security Number to the PT Board. This is mandatory. The authority for this requirement is Oregon Laws 1997, Chapter 746, Section 117 (ORS 25.785) and 42 USC § 666(a)(13). Failure to provide your Social Security Number will be a basis for the PT Board to refuse to issue, renew or reinstate the license. Although a number other than your Social Security Number appears on the face of the license, your Social Security Number will remain on file with the PT Board. If warranted, the record of your Social Security Number may be used for Child Support Enforcement, Federal and State Tax Administration, and the reporting of final disciplinary actions against your PT License to the Healthcare Integrity and Protection Data Bank (HIPDB). Any other use or disclosure of your Social Security Number will require your written authorization.
