## DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS LAUNCHES **NEW AND IMPROVED WEBSITE**

New Website is Customer Friendly and Designed for Easier Access to Labor Laws and Labor Related Information and News

HONOLULU - The Department of Labor and Industrial Relations ("DLIR") today launched their new and improved department website.

"The goal of the website redesign is to better serve our customers – Hawaii employees and employers – by expanding the information on Hawaii's labor laws, our department's services, goals and initiatives," said DLIR Director Nelson Befitel, "This is an important tool in expanding our outreach, educational and training programs." The new website offers information on all 17 divisions and attached agencies of the DLIR, as well as providing forms, libraries, frequently asked questions, press releases, and the department initiatives.

Although the website is a vast improvement, the DLIR will continue to enhance its website in response to its customer's needs. Future improvements include:

> On-line drug awareness and training program for Hawaii's employees;

> Future initiatives and on-going projects in improving the lives of

Hawaii's workforce;

Information employees need to know about their rights, and how to file a workers' compensation, unemployment or other employment related.

a workers' compensation, unemployment or other employment-related

claim; and

Providing Hawaii's businesses the information they need to know to

comply with our state laws, bringing transparency to our department.

The DLIR is also striving to provide better 24 hour services, 7 days a week, to its

customers on the internet. Some of those initiatives include:

> Allowing unemployment insurance claimants the ability to file on line;

> Allowing employers to file unemployment insurance quarterly wage

reports;

> Enhancing the job orders system for employers looking for employees;

Improving job search systems for job seekers; and

> Electronic filing of workers' compensation claims, and forms required to

be filed by employers, insurance carriers, and medical providers.

The website redesign culminates a yearlong project, led by the department's

information technology, with project leaders Casey Cho and David Imamura.
