## Renewals require you to be current with ARRT

Under Oregon Revised Statutes 688.465 and 688.475, the qualifications of radiologic technologists in the diagnostic and therapeutic fields state, "for licensure as a radiologic technologist in the diagnostic and therapeutic fields, an applicant must be currently certified by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) in x-ray technology or radiation therapy".

Radiation Protection Services' Administrative Rule 333-106-0005(89) states, "RT (ARRT) means a radiologic technologist certified in radiography, currently registered with the <u>ARRT</u> and currently licensed by the <u>Oregon Board of Radiologic Technology</u> (OBRT)".
