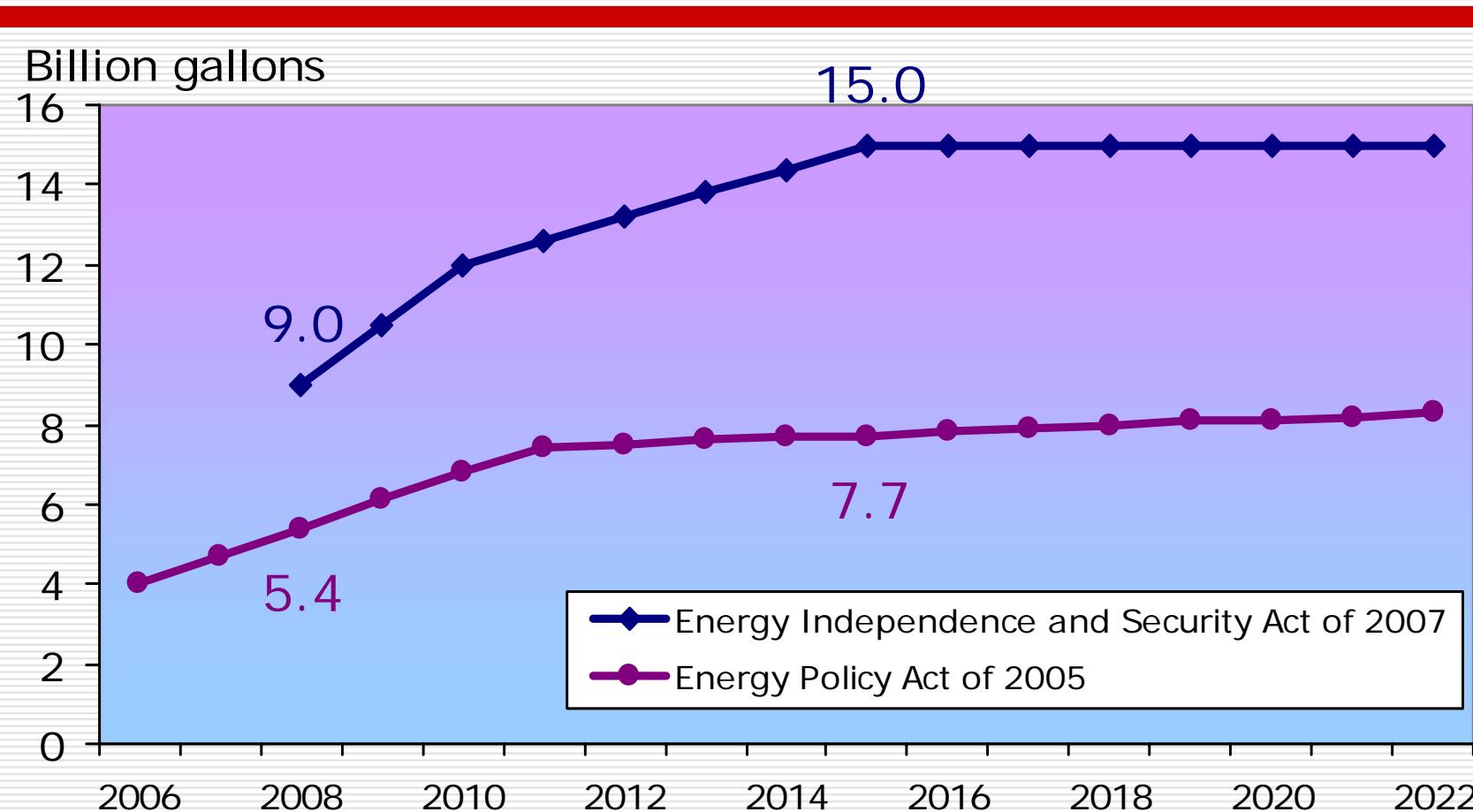

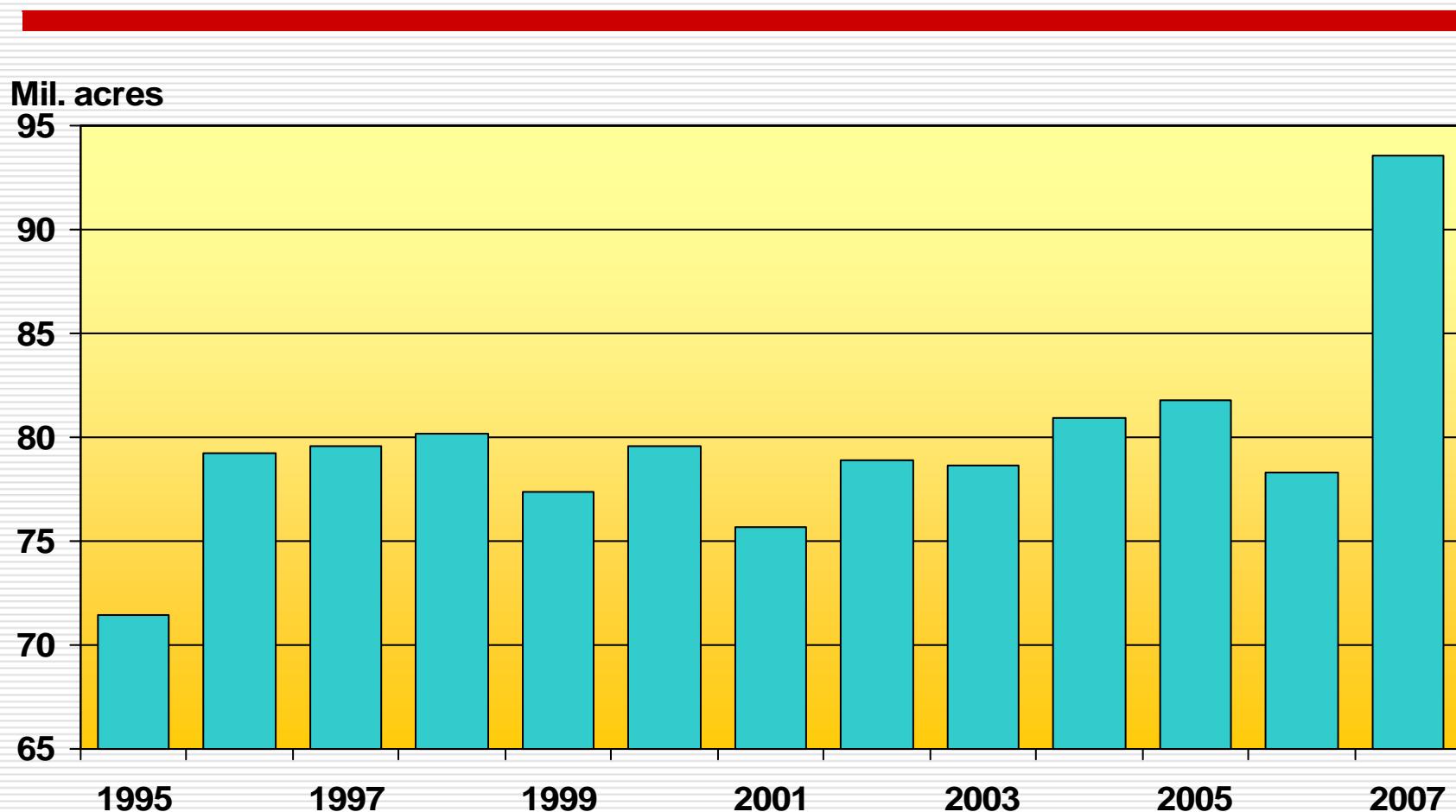

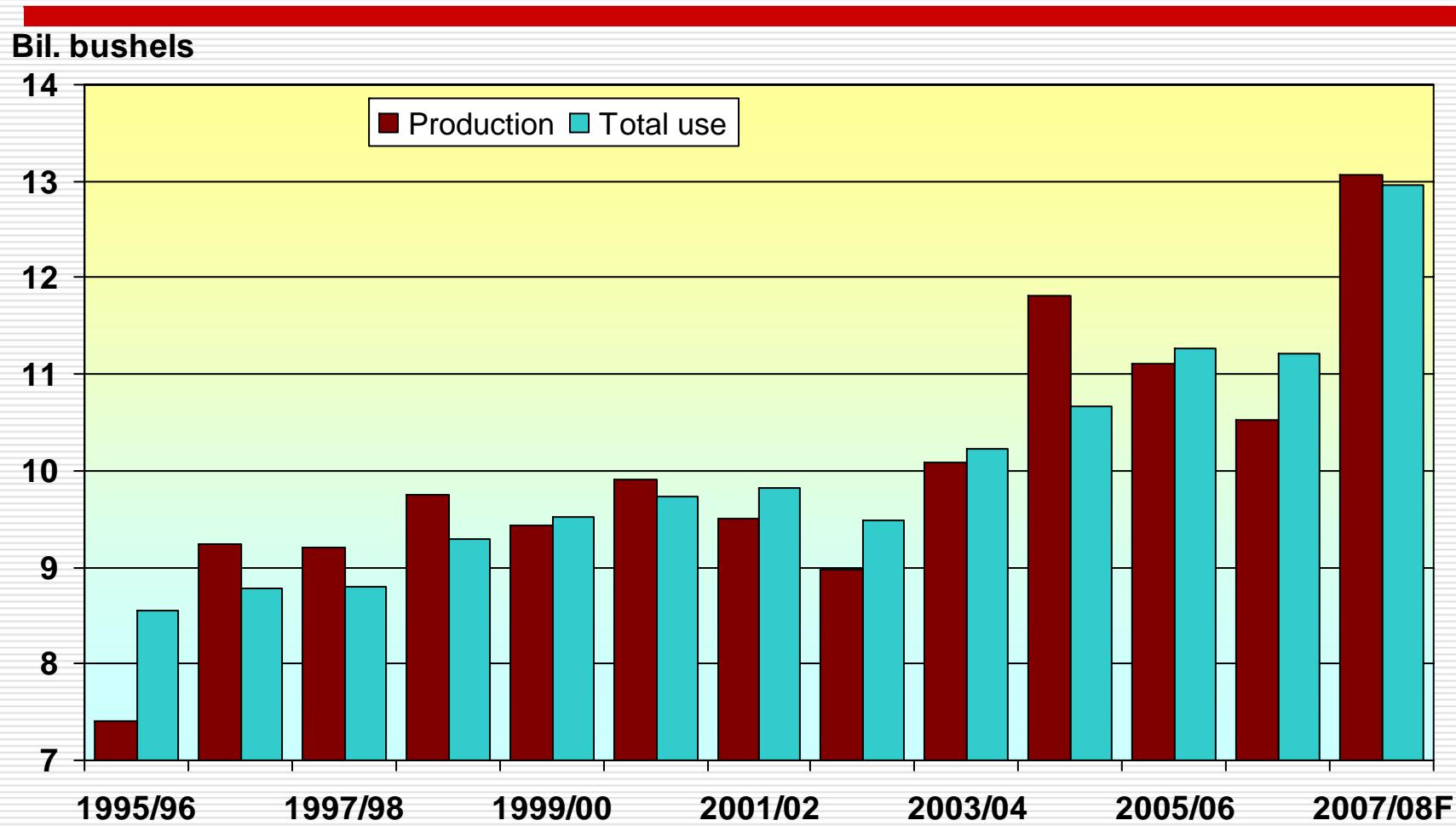
U.S. Corn Planted Area

U.S. Corn Production and Total Use

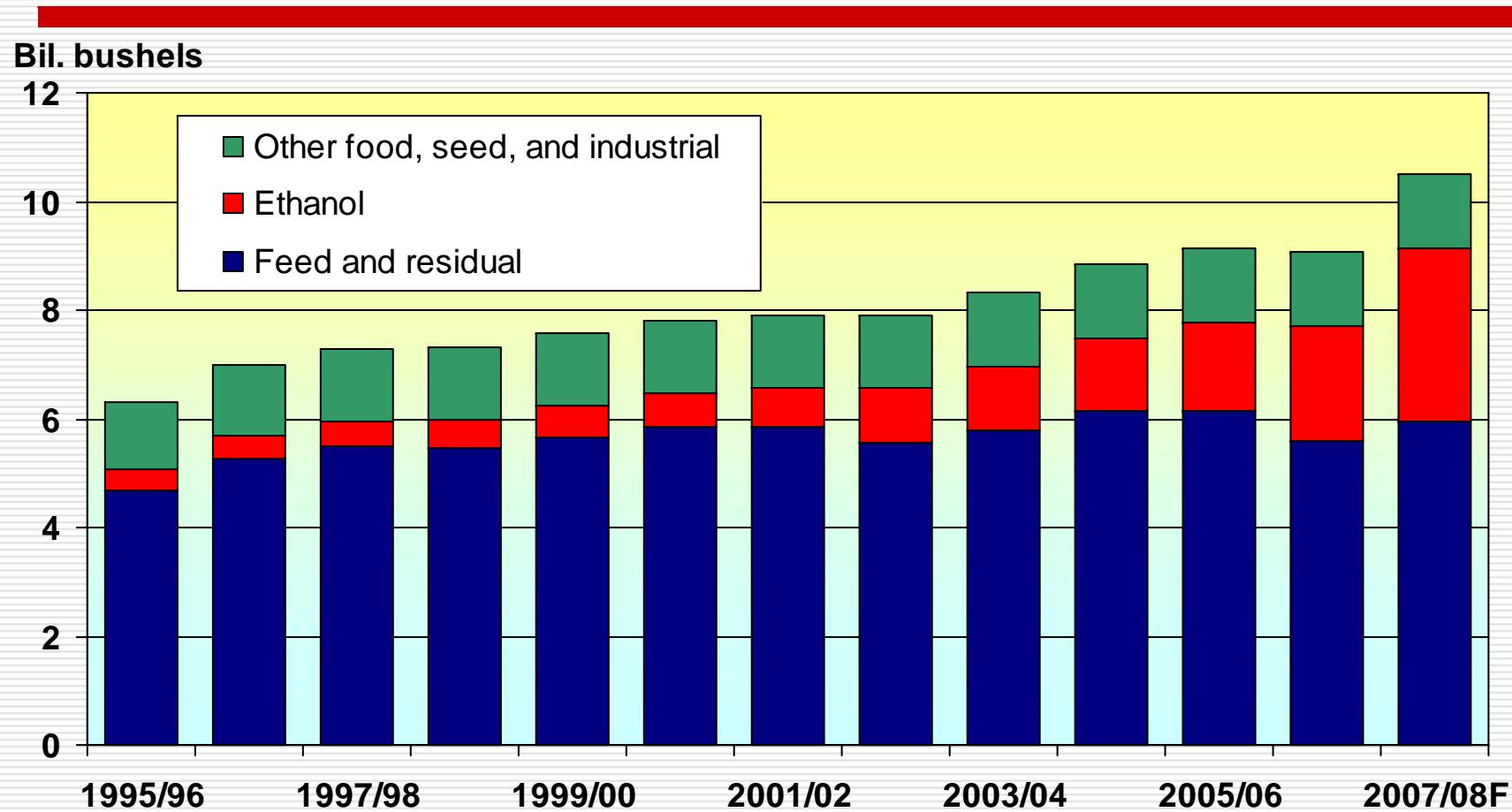
1995/96 through 2007/08F

U.S. Domestic Corn Use

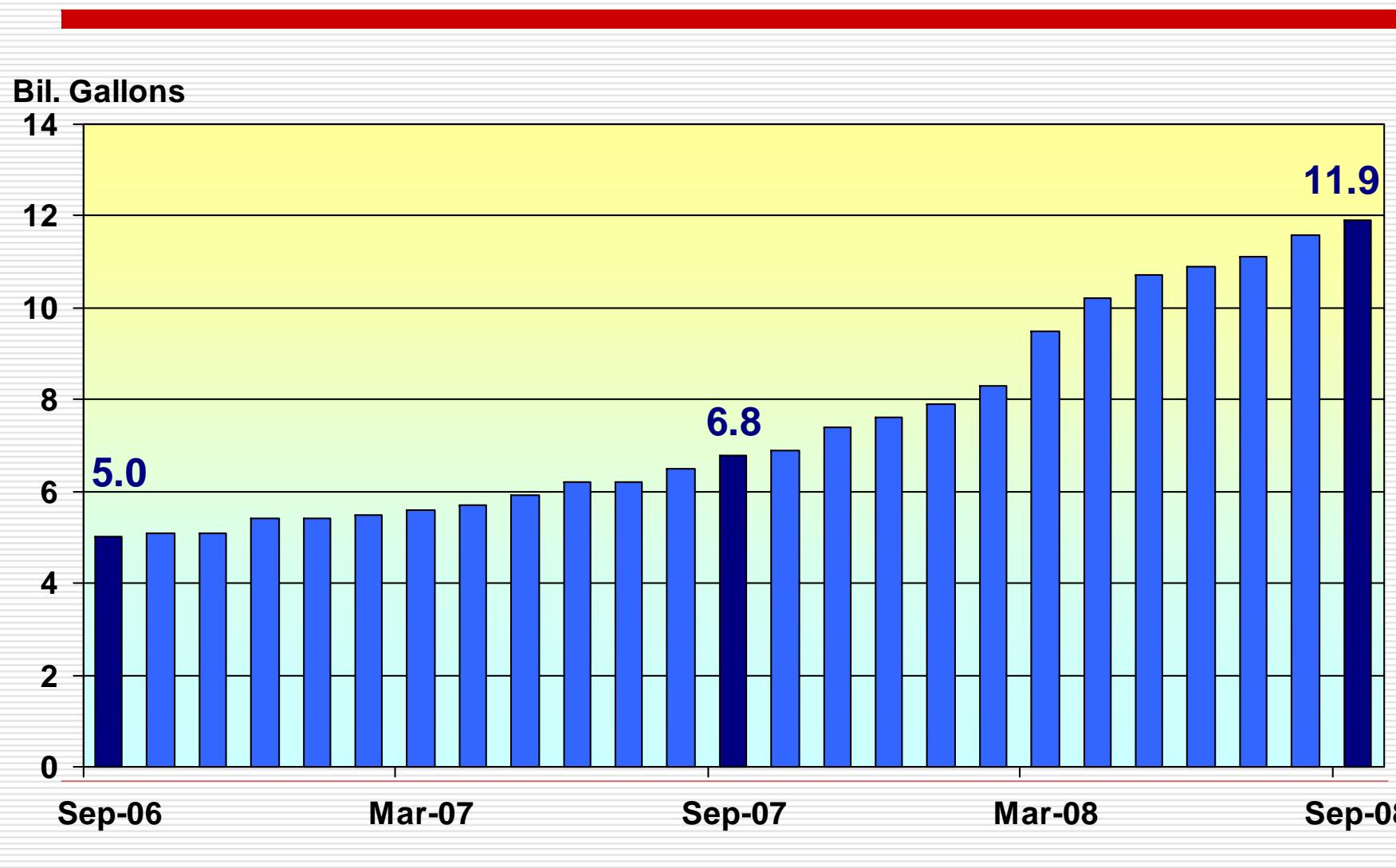
1995/96 through 2007/08F

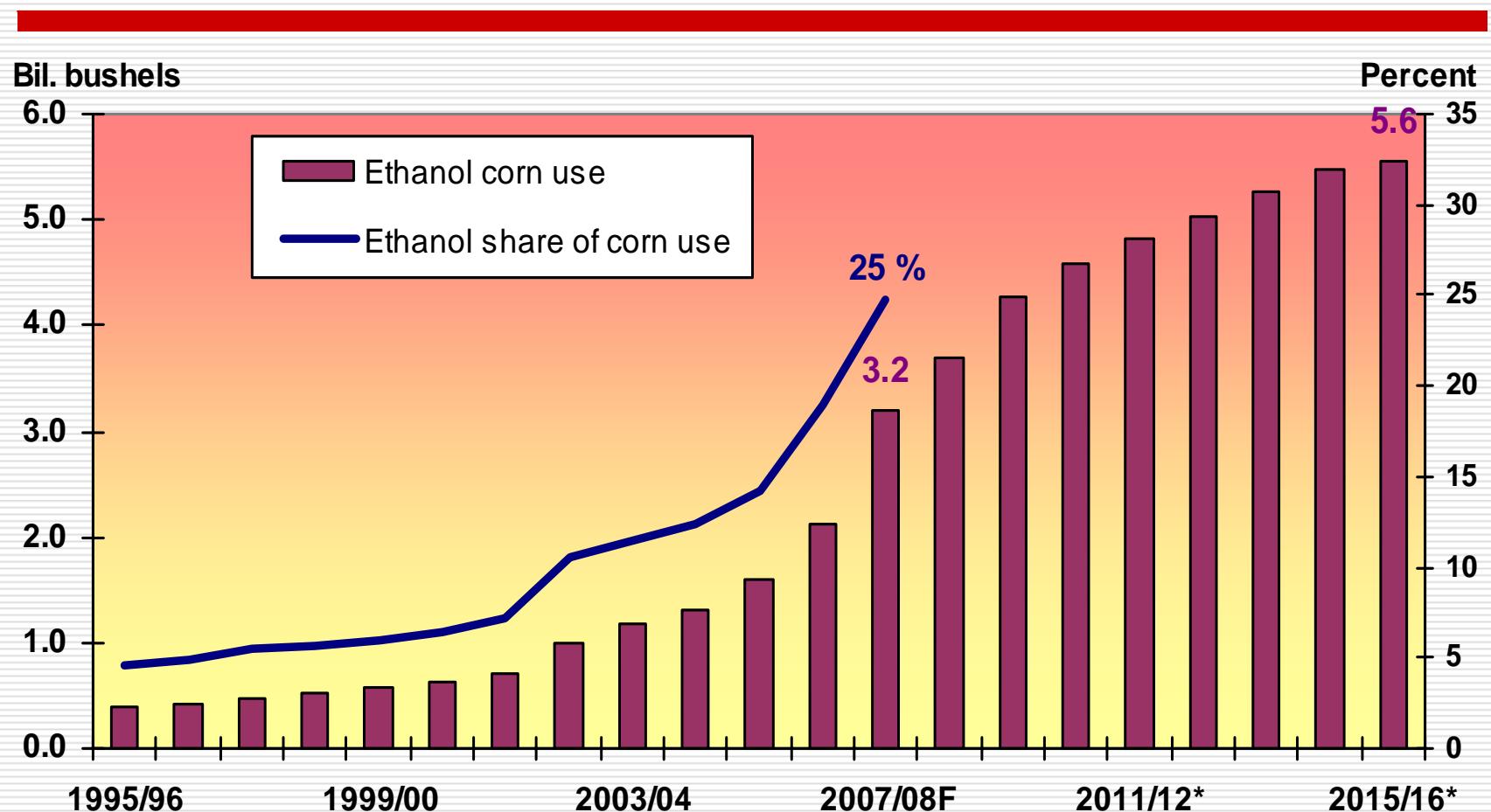
U.S. Ethanol Production Capacity

U.S. Corn Used for Ethanol

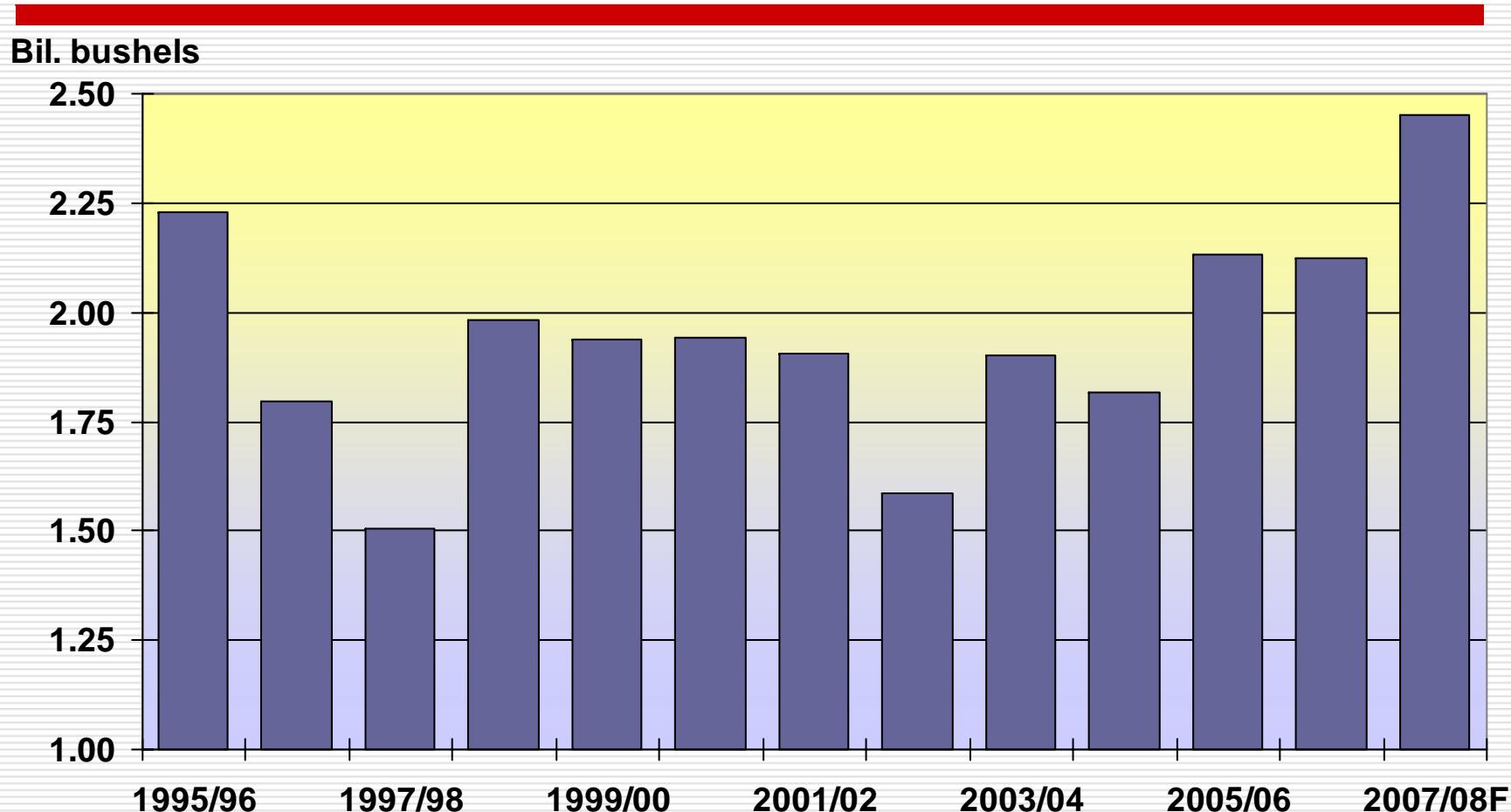
1995/96 through 2015/16*

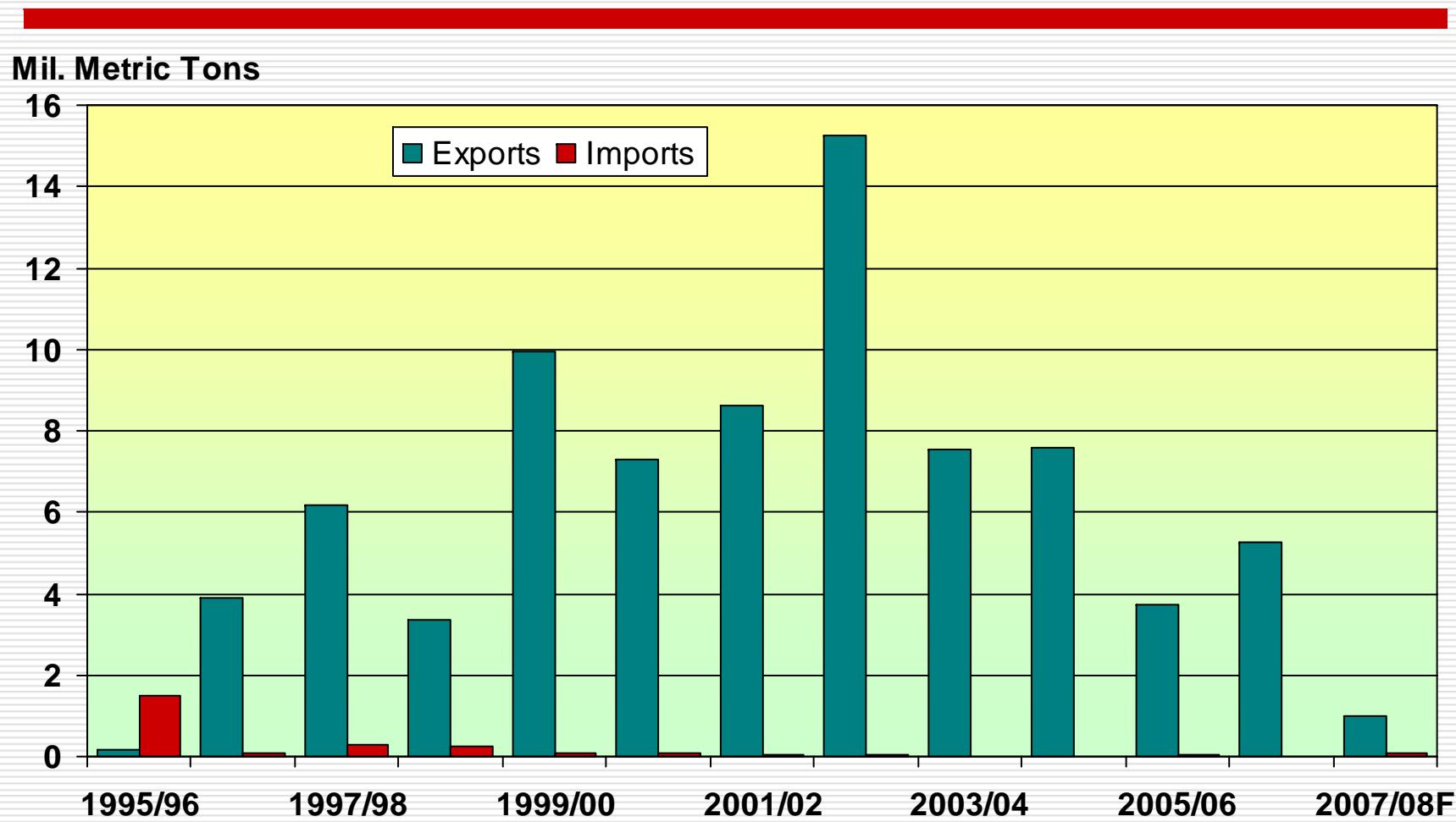
1995/96 through 2007/08F

China Corn Exports

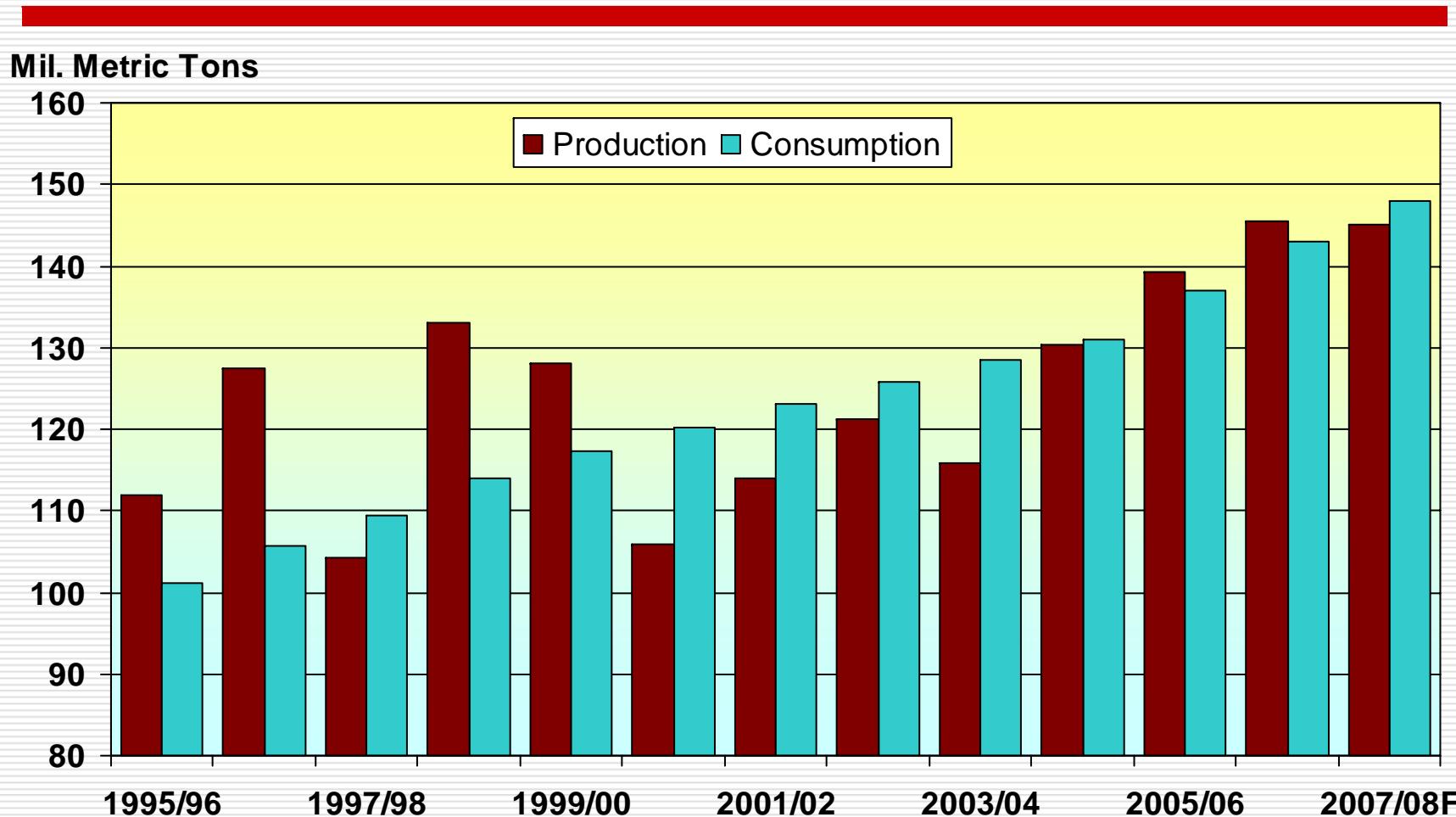
1995/96 through 2007/08F

China Corn Production and Consumption

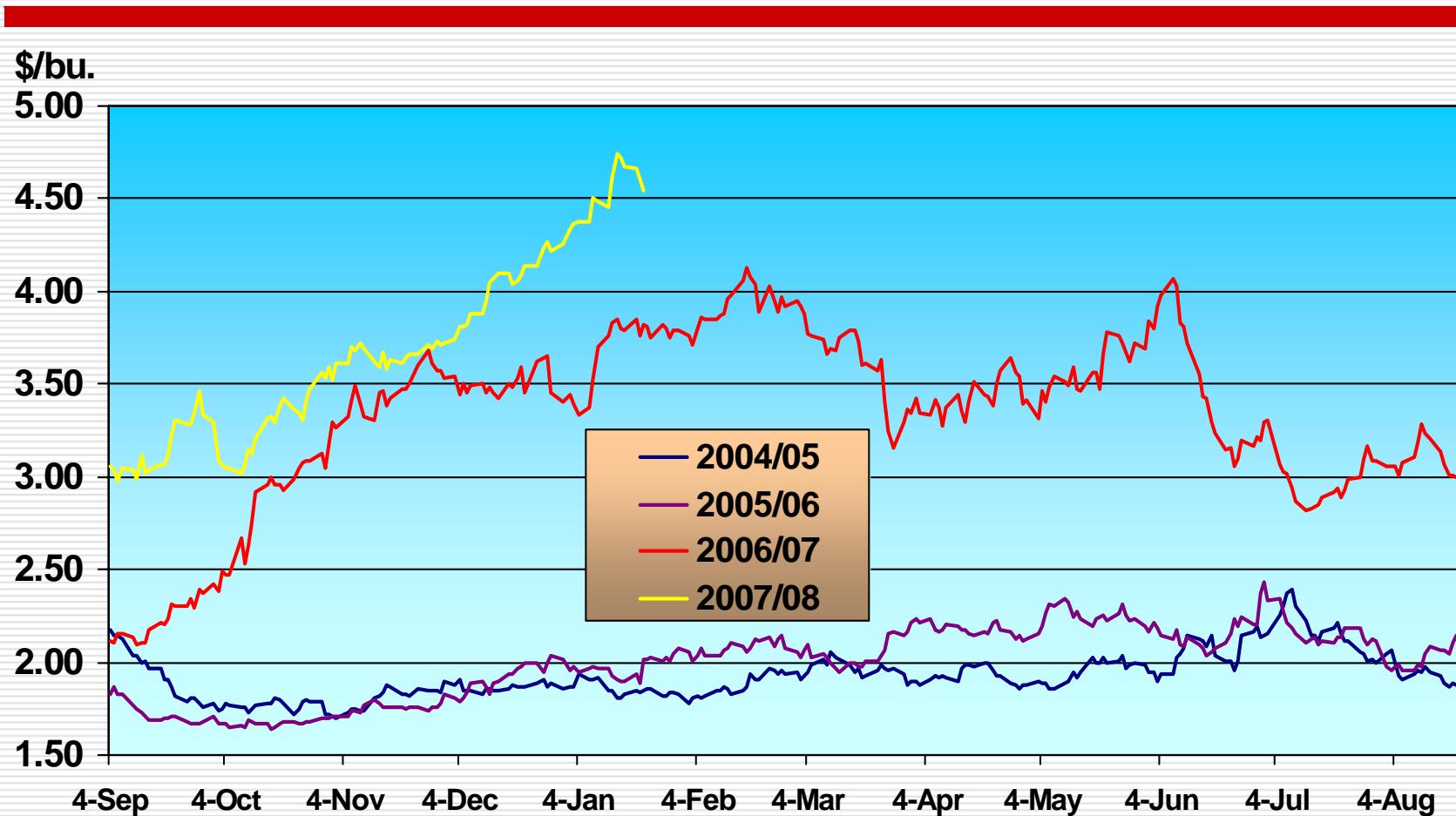
1995/96 through 2007/08F

Daily Cash Market Corn Prices

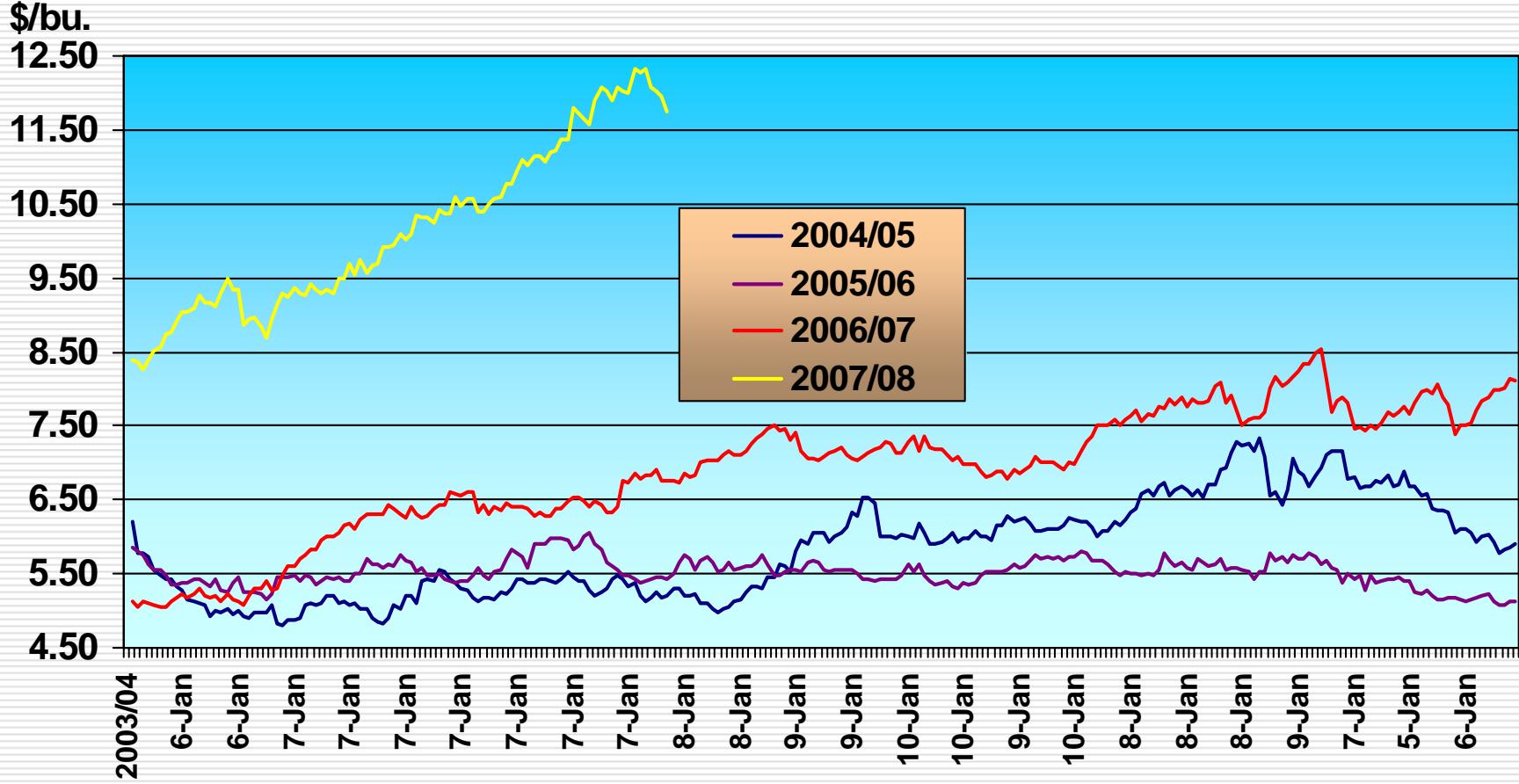
2004/05 through 2007/08 to date

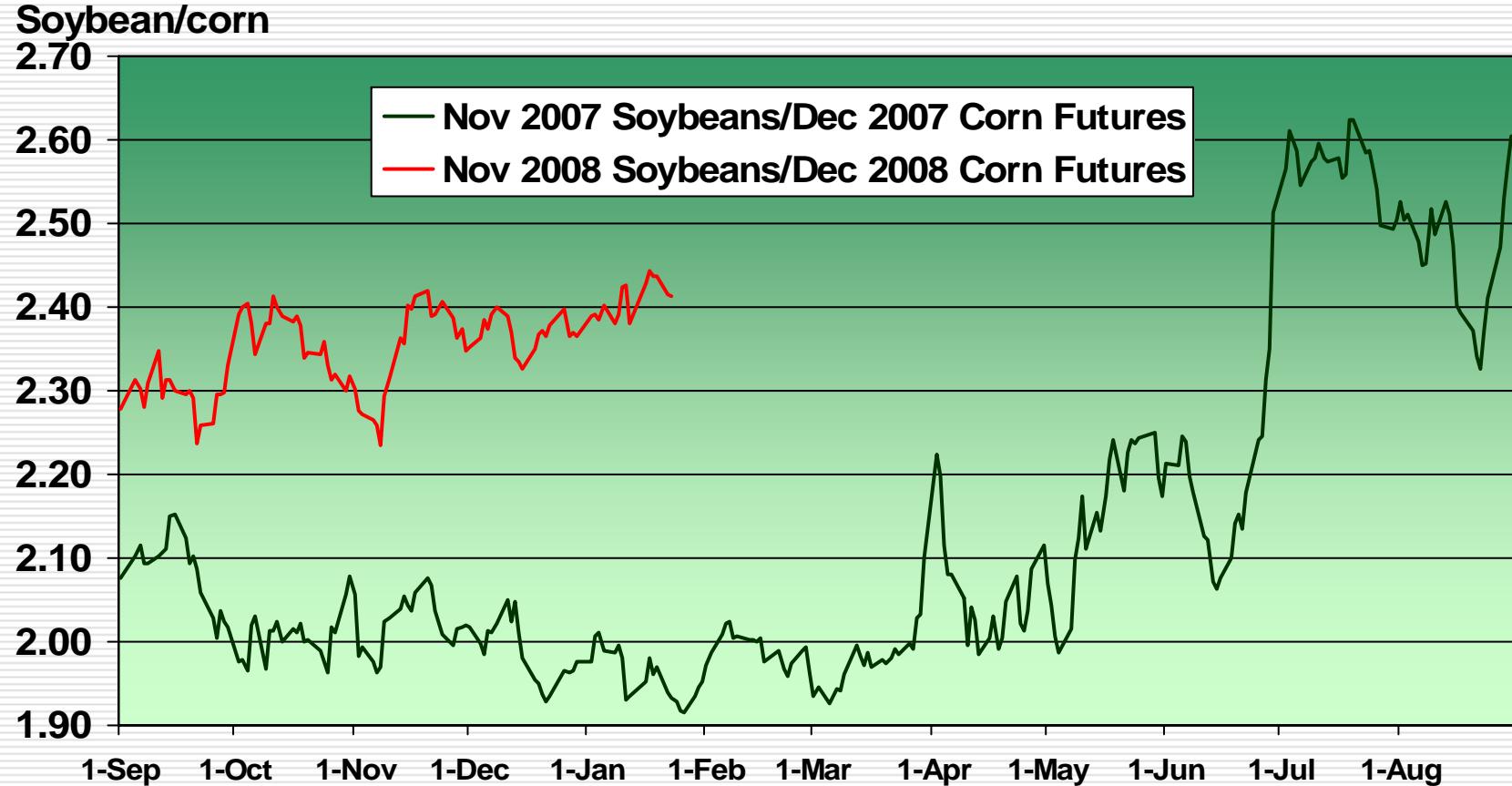
Daily Cash Market Soybean Prices

New-crop Soybean/Corn Price Ratios

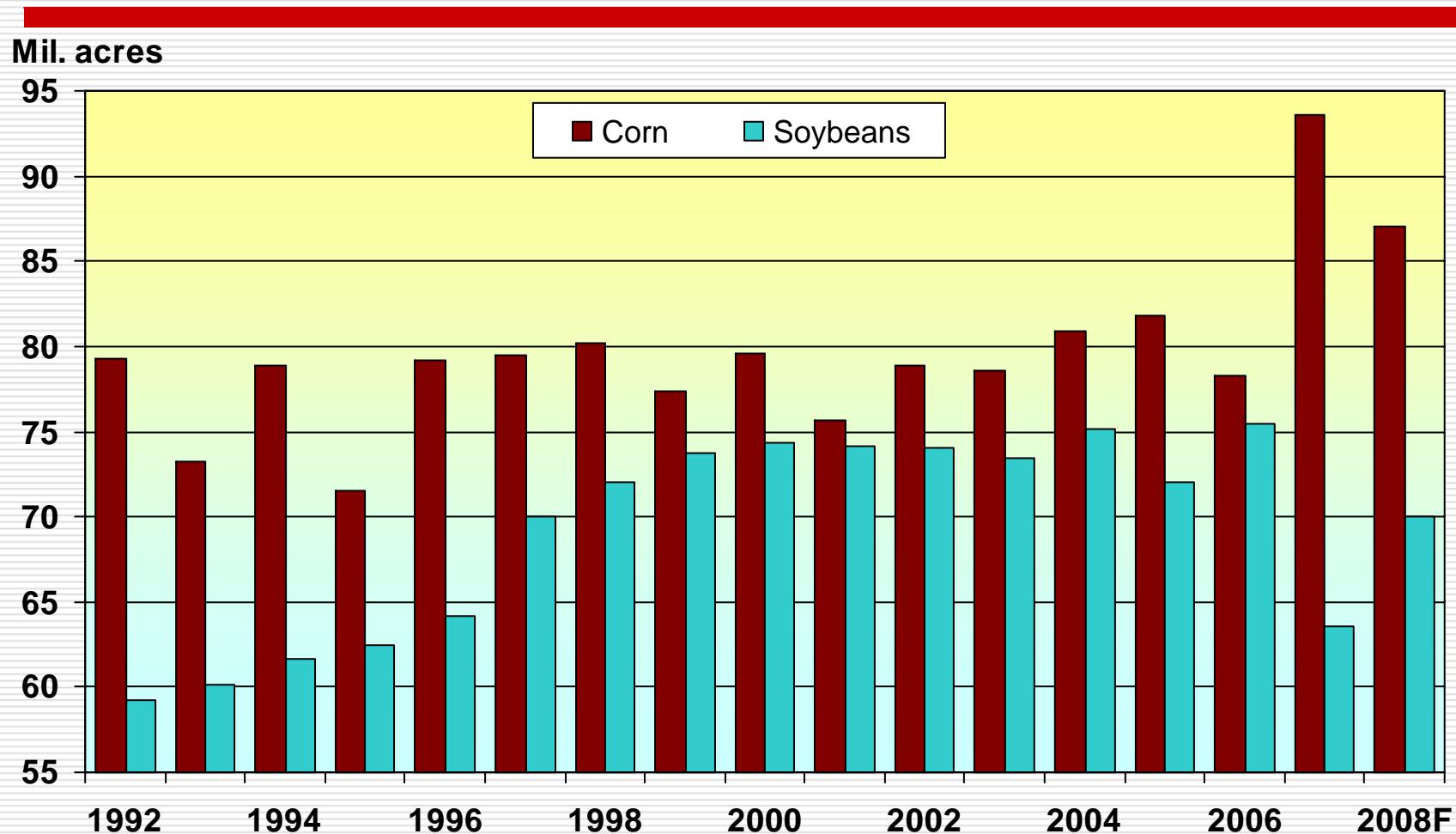
2007-crop and 2008-crop to date

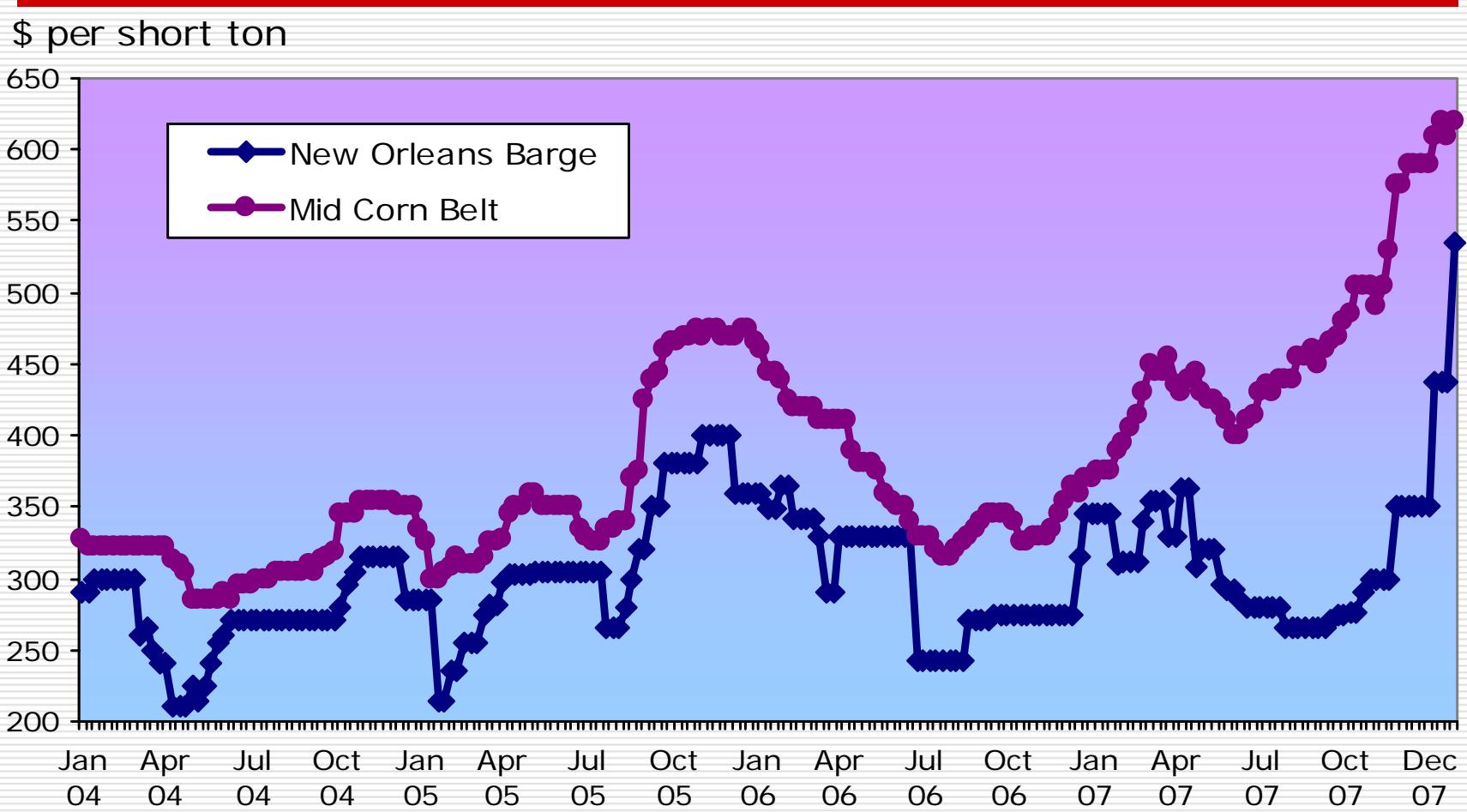
U.S. Planted Area, Corn and Soybeans

U.S. Ammonia Prices, weekly



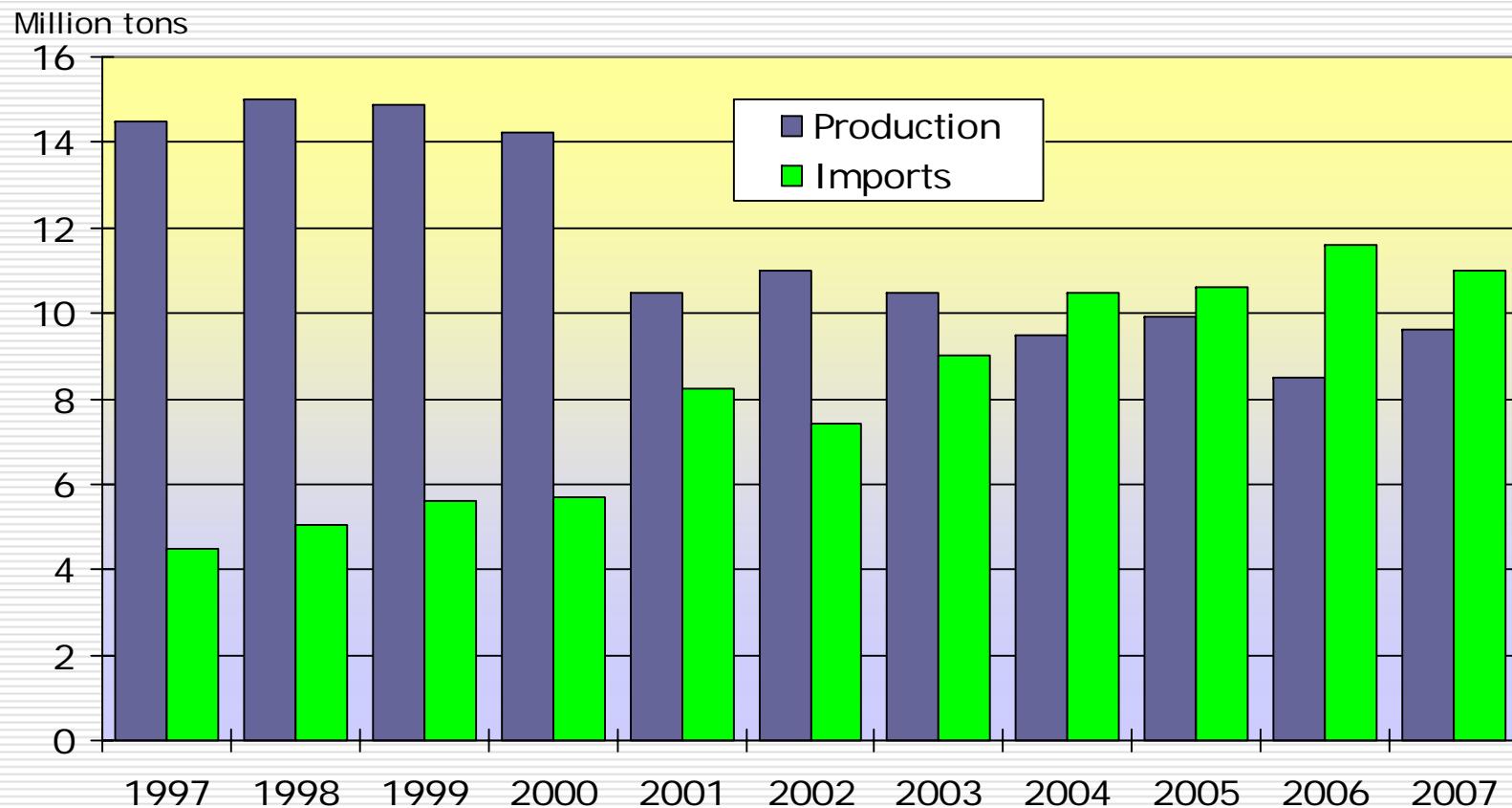

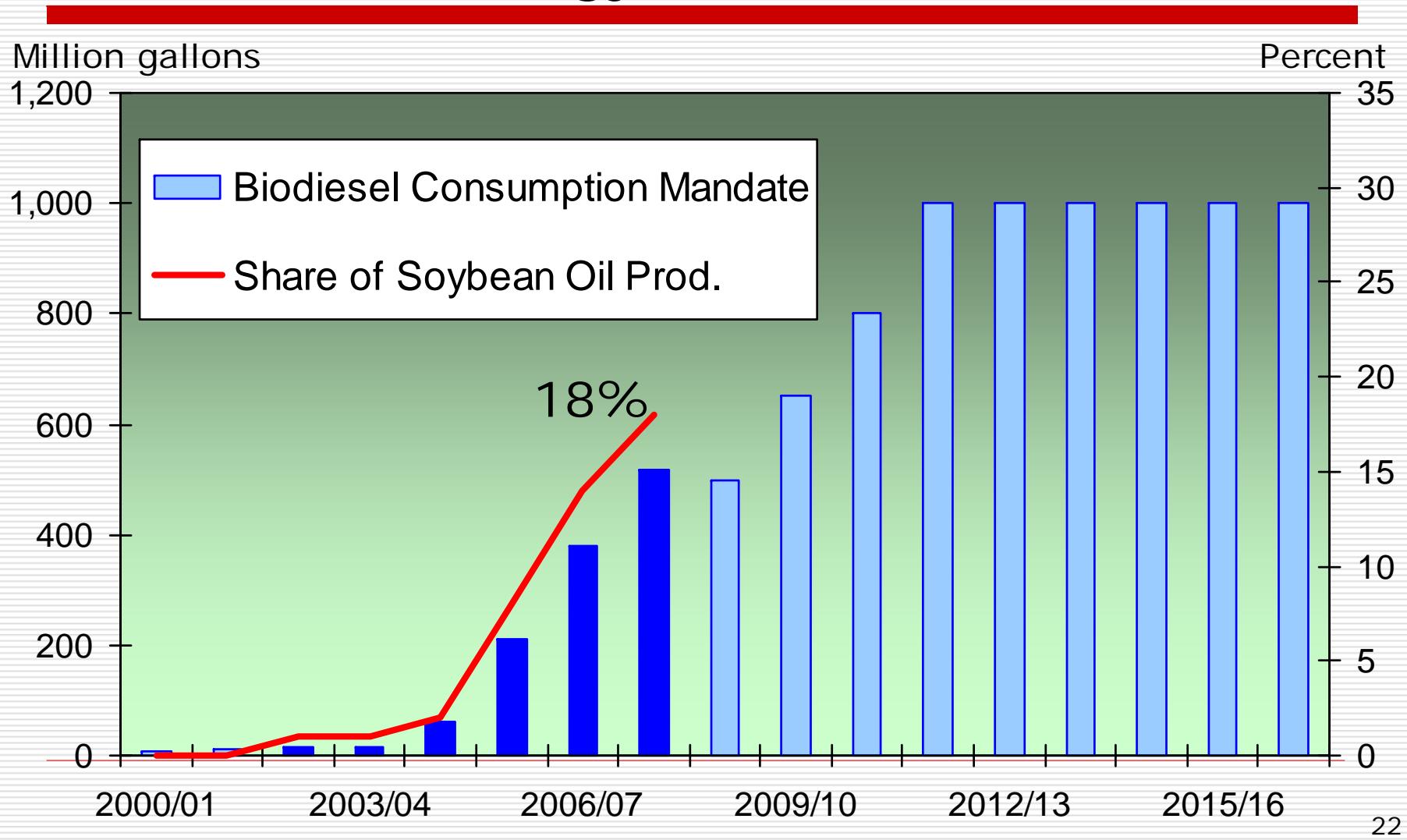

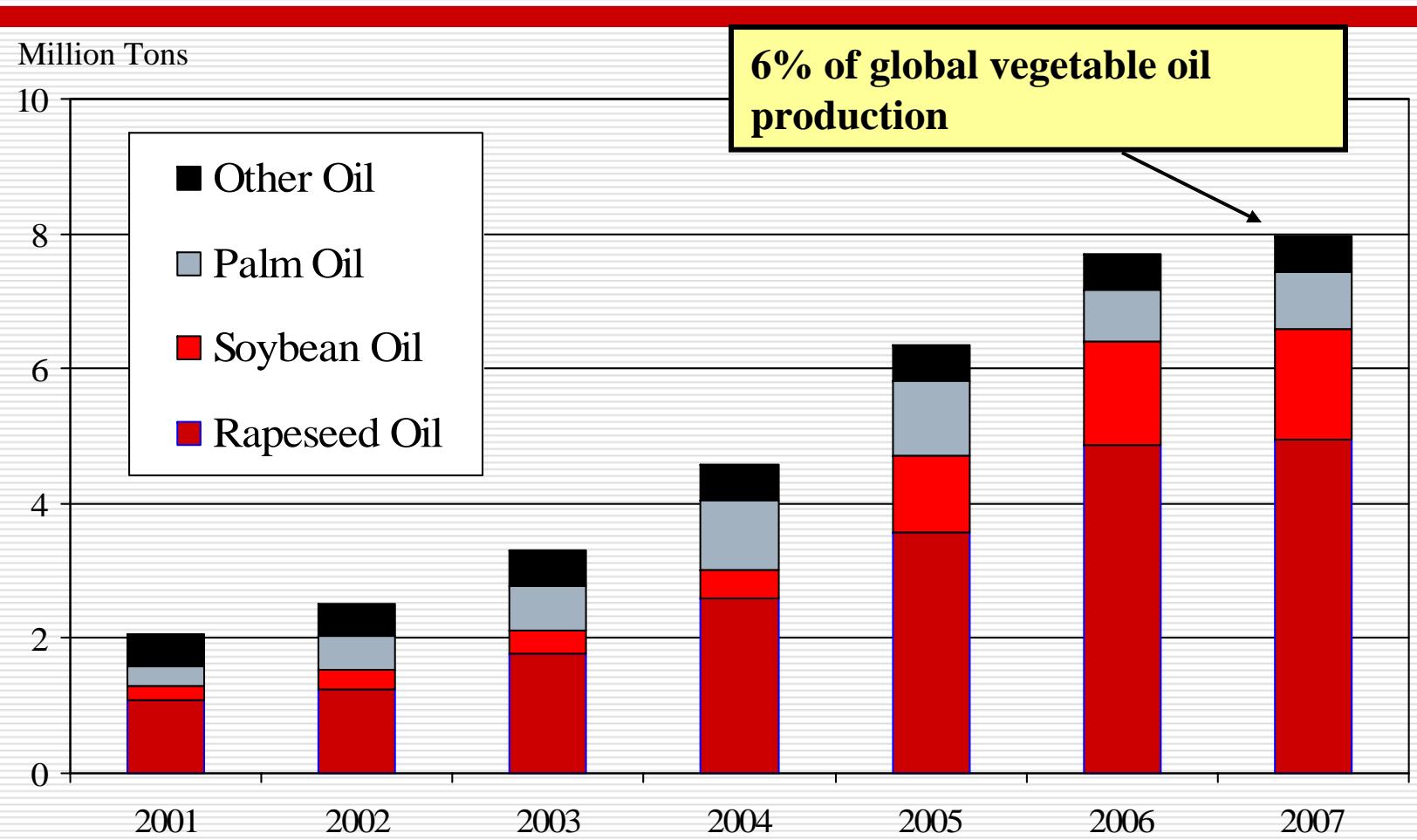

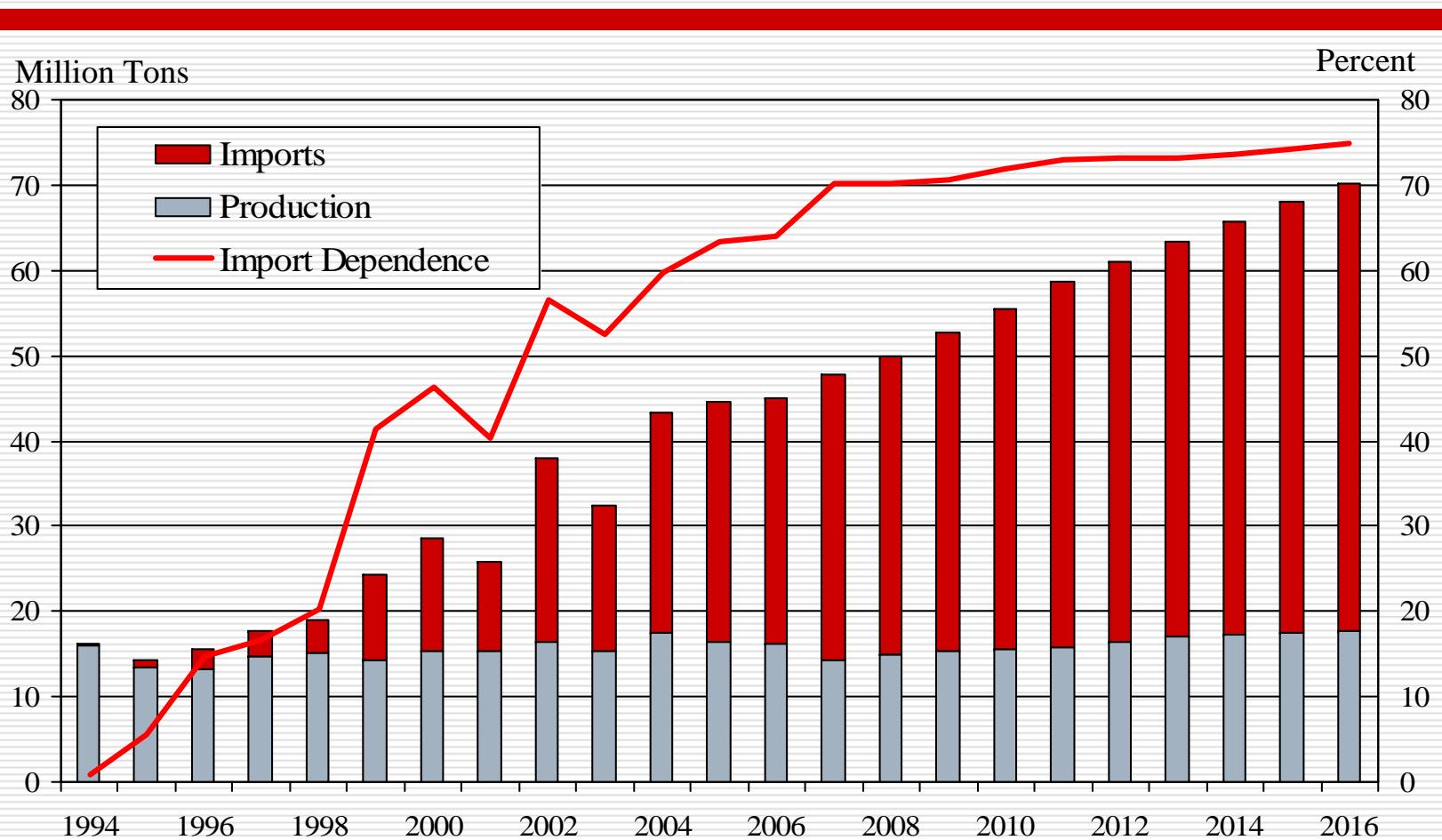

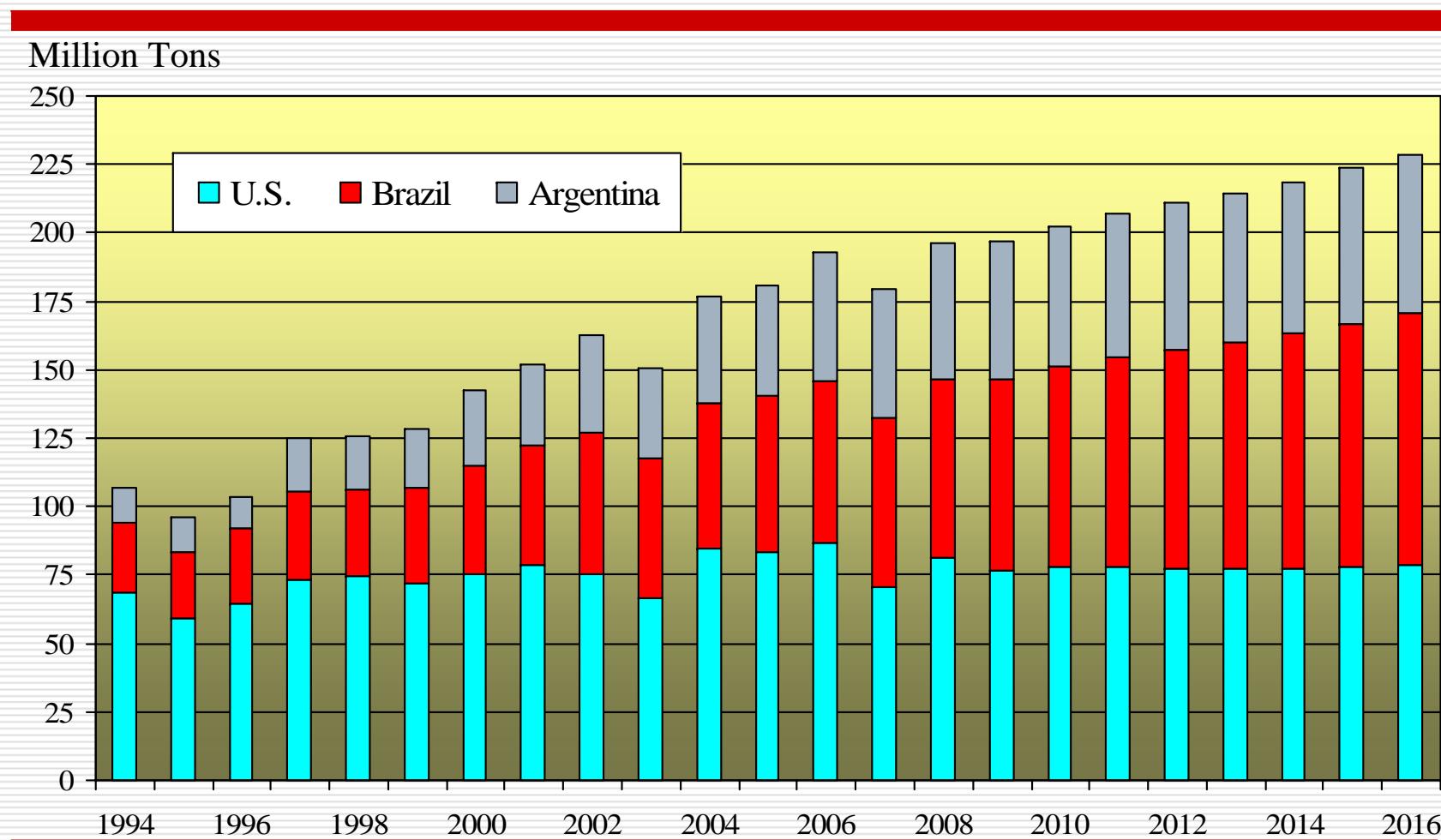
EU Industrial Use of Vegetable Oil

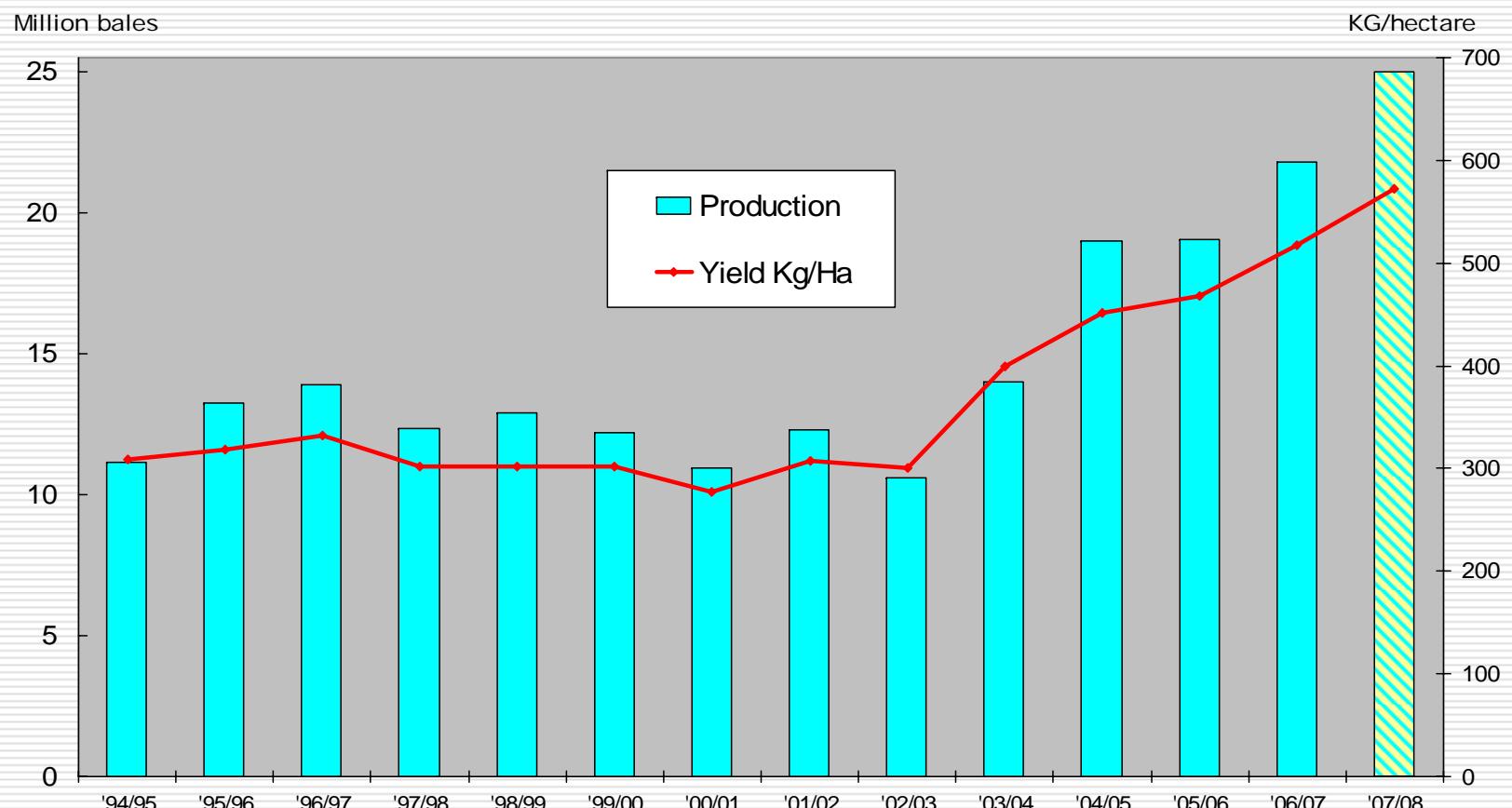

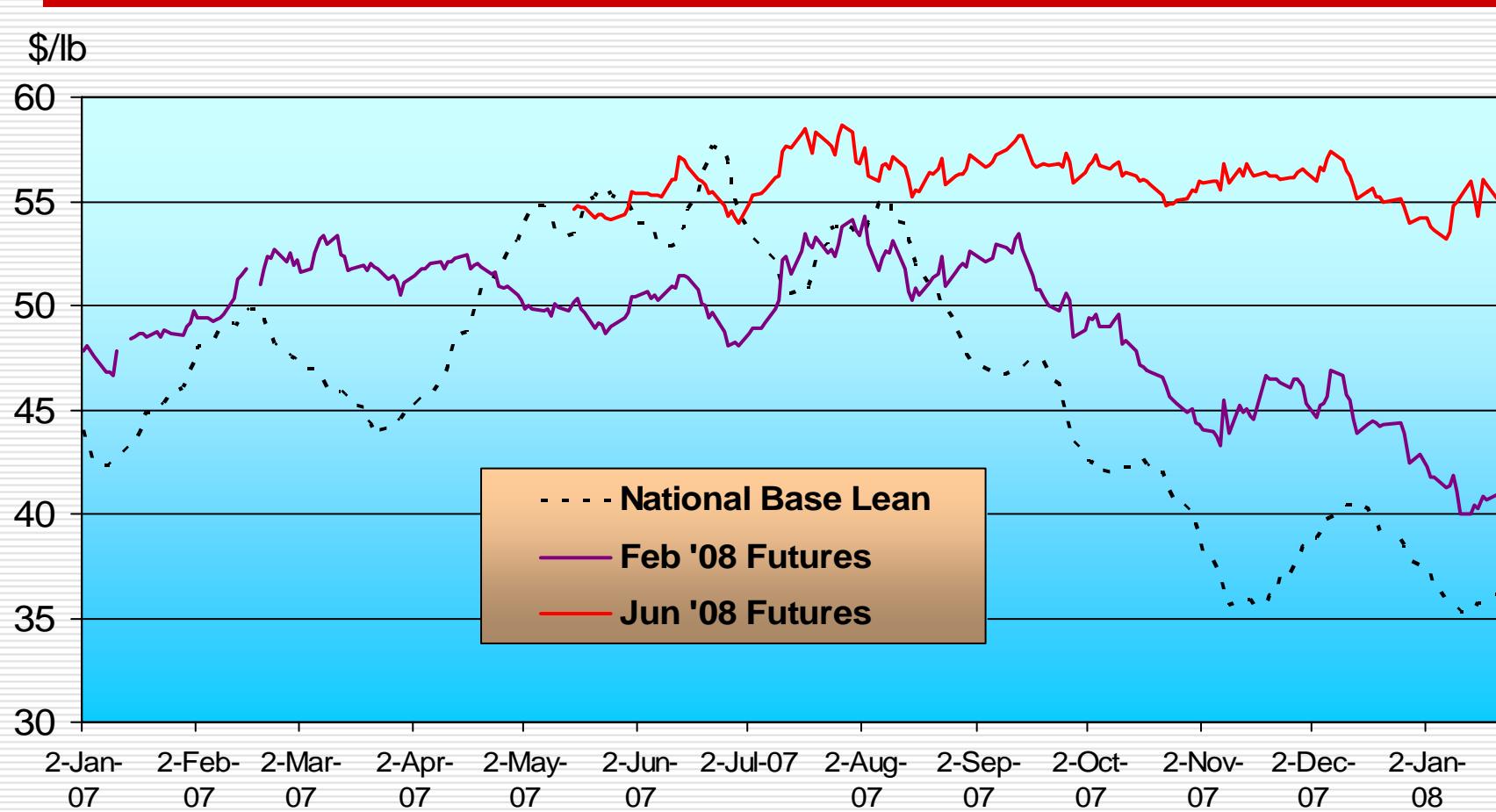
India Cotton, Production and Yield

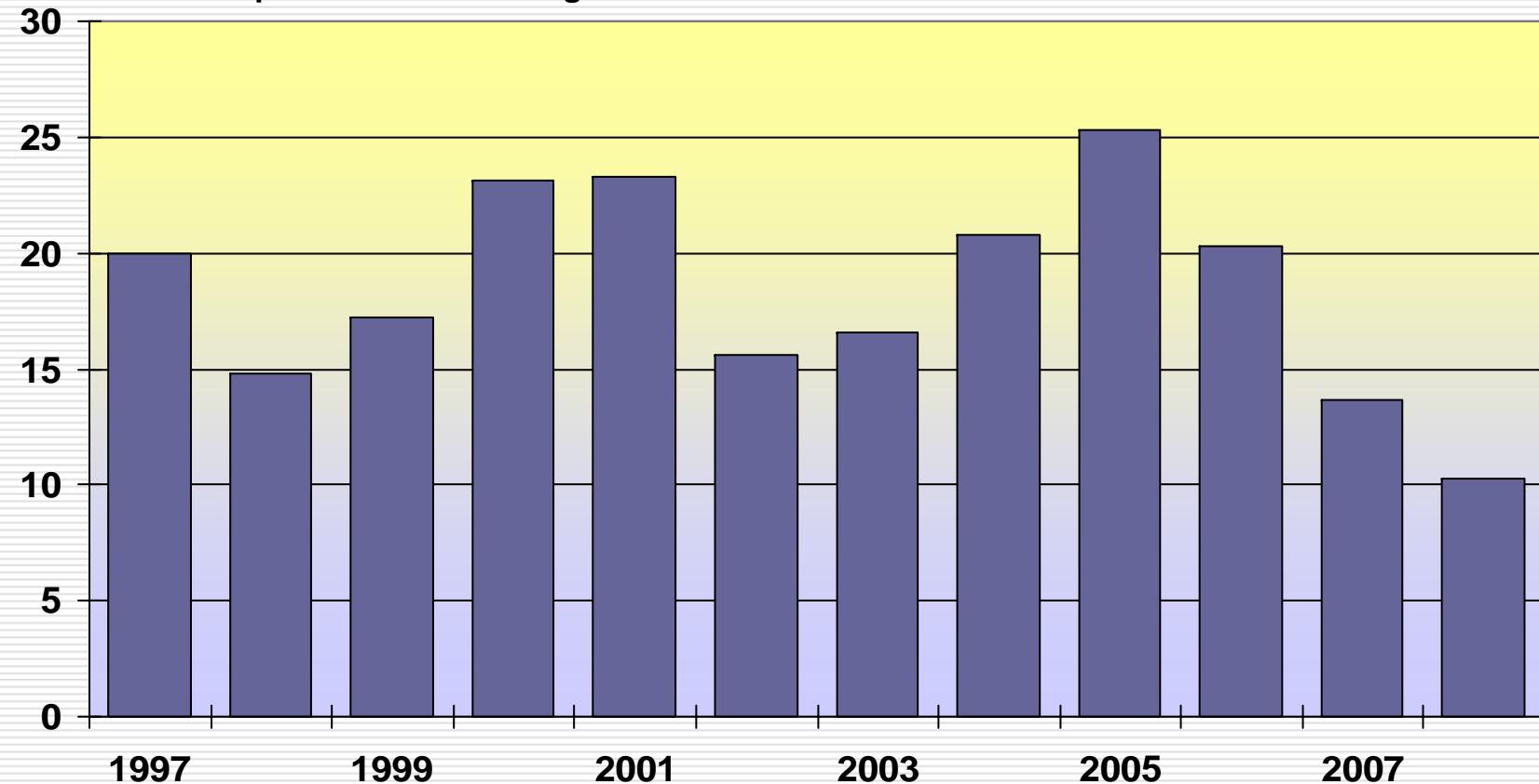
Cash Hog and Futures Prices*

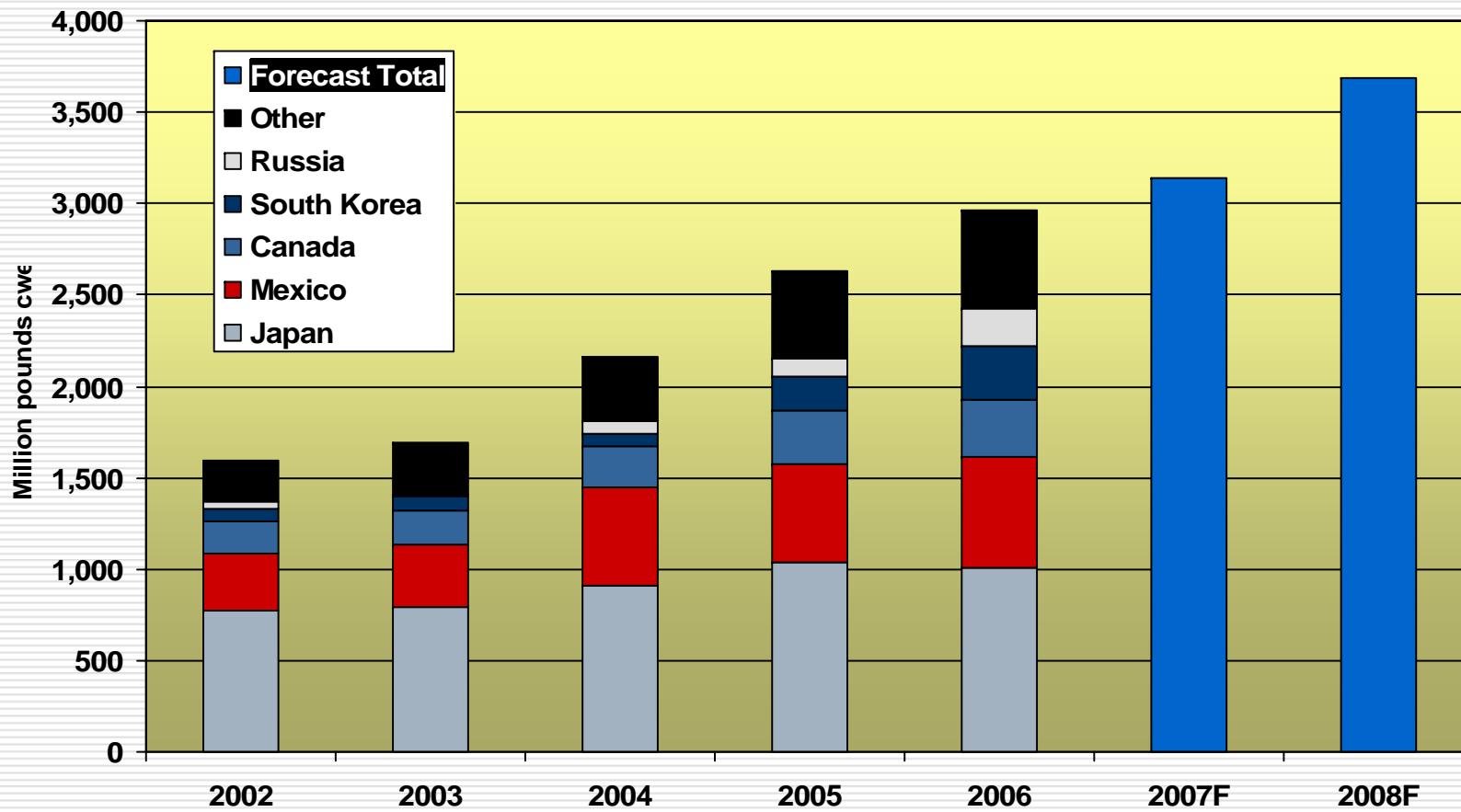

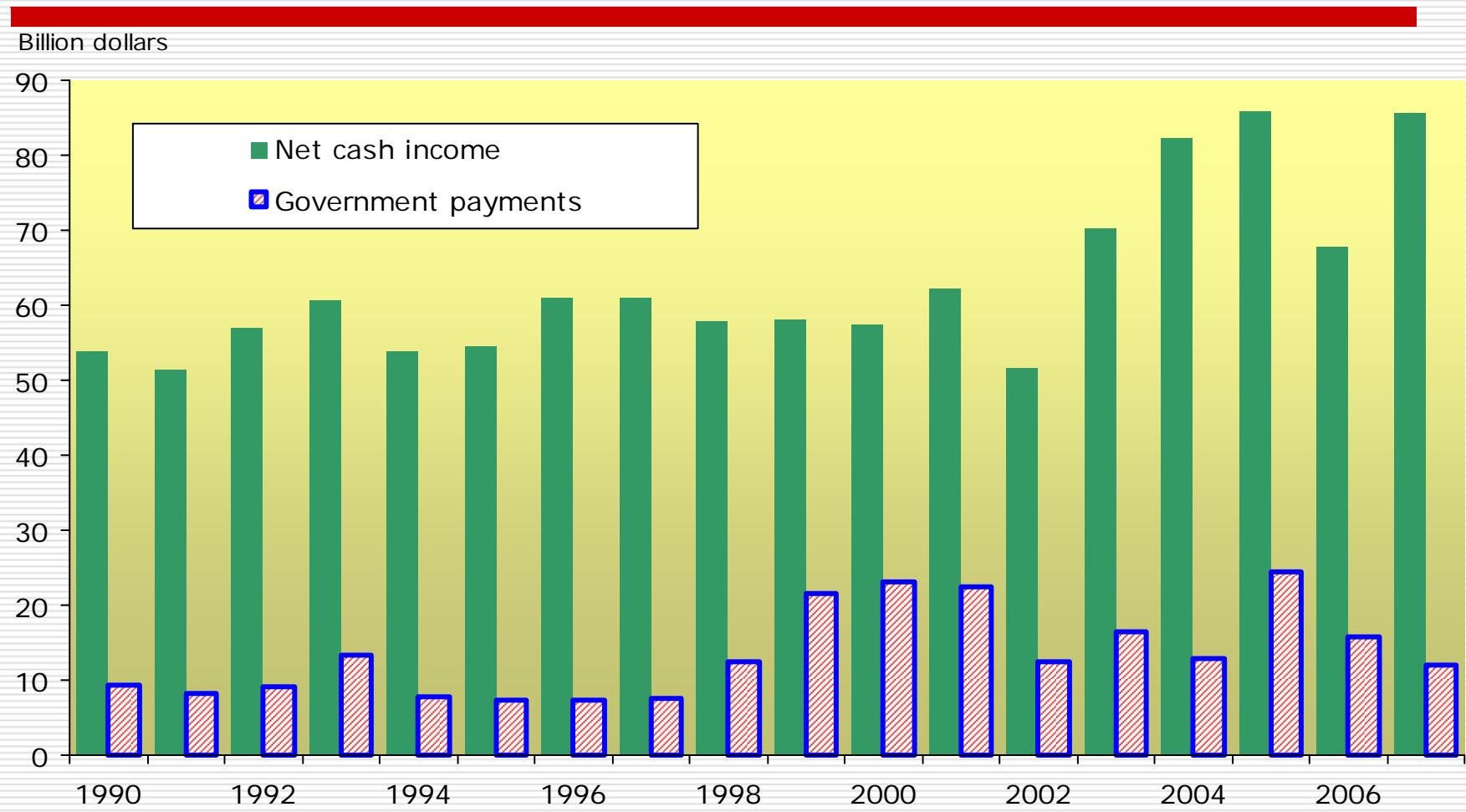
U.S. Meat Imports
