Attorneys will be considered for contract under Hawaii Revised Statutes §103D-304, as the need arises.

A new statement must be submitted pursuant to this Notice, even if you submitted a statement in the past. **Attorneys from the same firm must submit separate statements.**

In the past, we have contracted for legal services in the following areas. Attorneys may list other areas of practice **but are limited to no more than three areas.**
