Ministry of Finance

- Implemented Financial Management Information System (FMIS), covering 85% of GOI spending units; currently extending FMIS to remaining GOI agencies and introducing additional functions (Purchasing, Assets, and Revenue).
- Trained nearly 500 GOI staff to use the FMIS system.
- Implemented complementary government wide budgeting process and providing assistance to GOI on intergovernmental budgeting/fiscal federalism issues.
