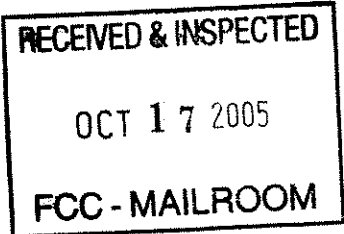

PETITION FOR FULL EXEMPTION FROM
CLOSED CAPTIONING REQUIREMENTS

COMES NOW, Listen to the Eagle and its video programming producers and video programming owners, Paul Ott Carruth and Carla Carruth Tigner, and for their Petition for Full Exemption From Closed Captioning Requirement and state as follows:

1. That Petitioners are the owners and producers of Listen to the Eagle, a hunting and fishing television show based in Jackson, Mississippi.
2. That Listen to the Eagle production company and owner consists of Paul Ott Carruth and his daughter Carla Carruth Tigner.
3. That Listen to the Eagle is broadcast weekly on television stations in the following Mississippi cities: Jackson, Meridian, Pascagoula, Tupelo, Greenville, Moselle and Columbus.
4. That Listen to the Eagle is a live call-in show using video cutaways and is non-scripted.
5. That 52 shows are produced each year, and each show is thirty minutes in duration.
6. That for Petitioners to provide for closed captioning would constitute an undue burden upon Listen to the Eagle, Paul Ott Carruth and Carla Carruth Tigner in the following respects:
 - a. That Petitioners do not have the technical capabilities to provide for closed captioning;
 - b. That to obtain the closed captioning service will cost approximately \$750.00 per show or \$39,000.00 per year. The cost quoted is for "pop up" captions;
 - c. That Petitioners would be unable to produce and market Listen to the Eagle if they were required to provide for closed captioning;
 - d. That Petitioners do not possess the financial means to absorb the cost of closed captioning and if this exemption is not granted, the Petitioners would cease production of Listen to the Eagle, because of cost and budget restraints.

- e. That the financial resources of Paul Ott Carruth and Carla Carruth Tigner are limited to the extent that they could not continue to produce Listen to the Eagle, if closed captioning is required.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners respectfully pray for an exemption from the closed captioning requirements.

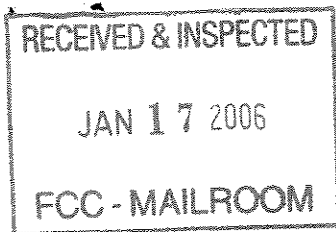


