RE: REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM COMMISSION'S CLOSED CAPTIONING RULES

Little Heart Entertainment, LLC. Respectfully submits this petition requesting exemption from the closed captioning requirements, under section 79.1 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R & 79.1 Little Heart believes their program "Dooley and Pals Christian children's Ministry Series" qualifies for this exemption for following reasons.

Part 79.1 Section D

Item 8 "Dooley and Pals Christian Children's Ministry Series is locally produced and distributed with no repeat value. The program is not a news program and the "electronic news room" technique of captioning is unavailable at this time.

Part 79.1 Section F

Compliance would impose an undue burden to Little Heart for the following reasons:

- (1.) It would be necessary to send the programs to an outside source for Captioning. This would impact meeting the airdate deadlines and the added production cost would make it unaffordable. The cost would be approximately \$25,000 for the 13 shows available. Funds not available.
- (2.) Little Heart is not funded nor granted by outside sources. We are solely responsible for any financial obligations. An added cost could put a damper on the Ministry at this time.
- (3.) Little Heart main purpose of the "Dooley and Pals Children's Christian Ministry Series is a show that creates entertainment that will awaken young minds to the joy of learning and the teachings of Jesus Christ."

Again we respectfully request that "Dooley and Pals Children's Christian Ministry Series" be exempted from the closed captioning requirement for the above stated reasons. We may be reached at:
