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Auditing Data Access

Even when there is broad availability of role based access controls, networked health information exchange will bring substantial needs for auditing access to patient data

There are needs to record

- **incoming access to EHR and PHR data,**
- **outgoing requests for data**
- **inter-organizational exchanges of data**

This session will focus on different approaches for auditing access to data in a complex networked care environment, including the data exchanges needed to support the various auditing models
