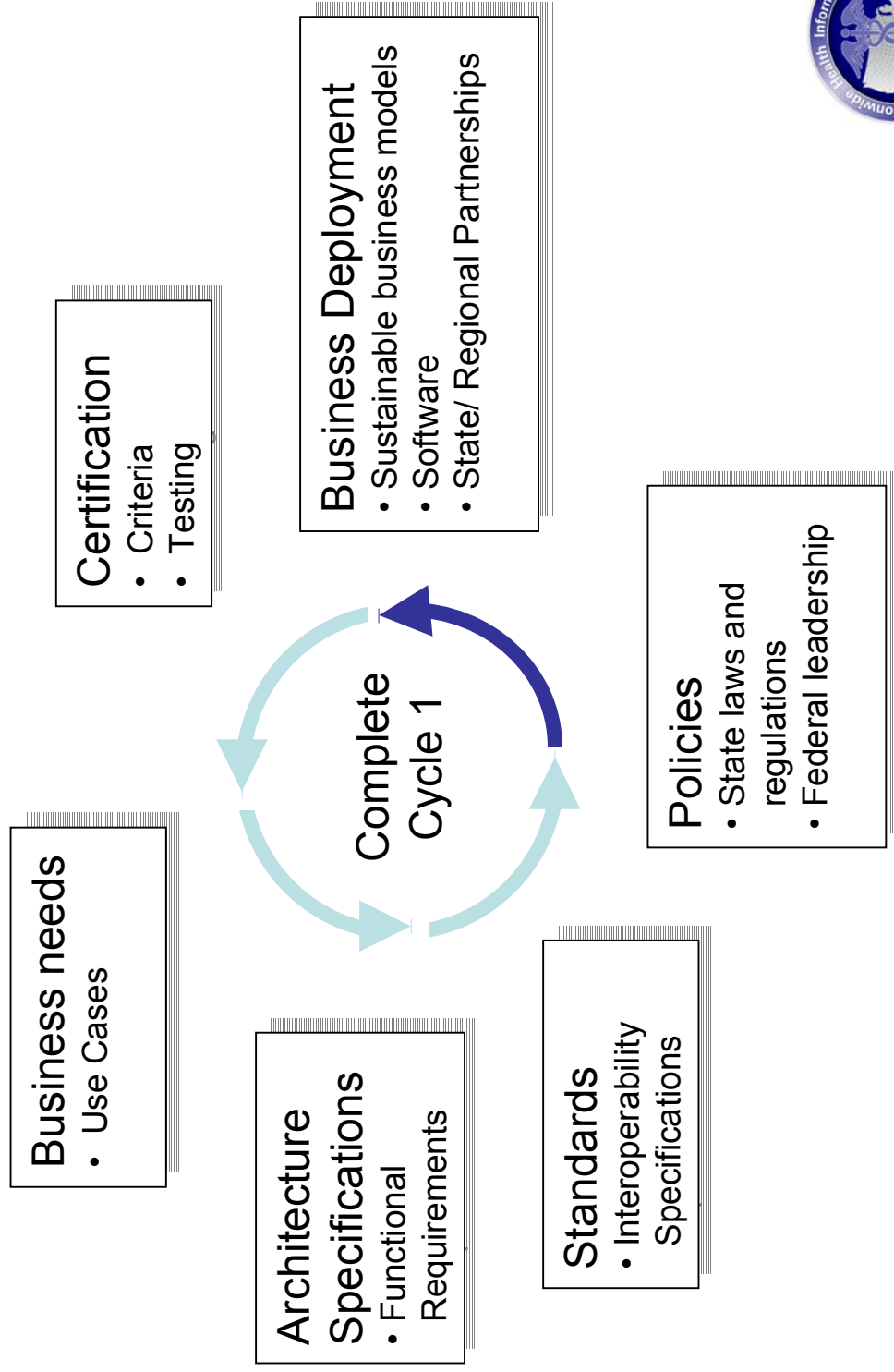

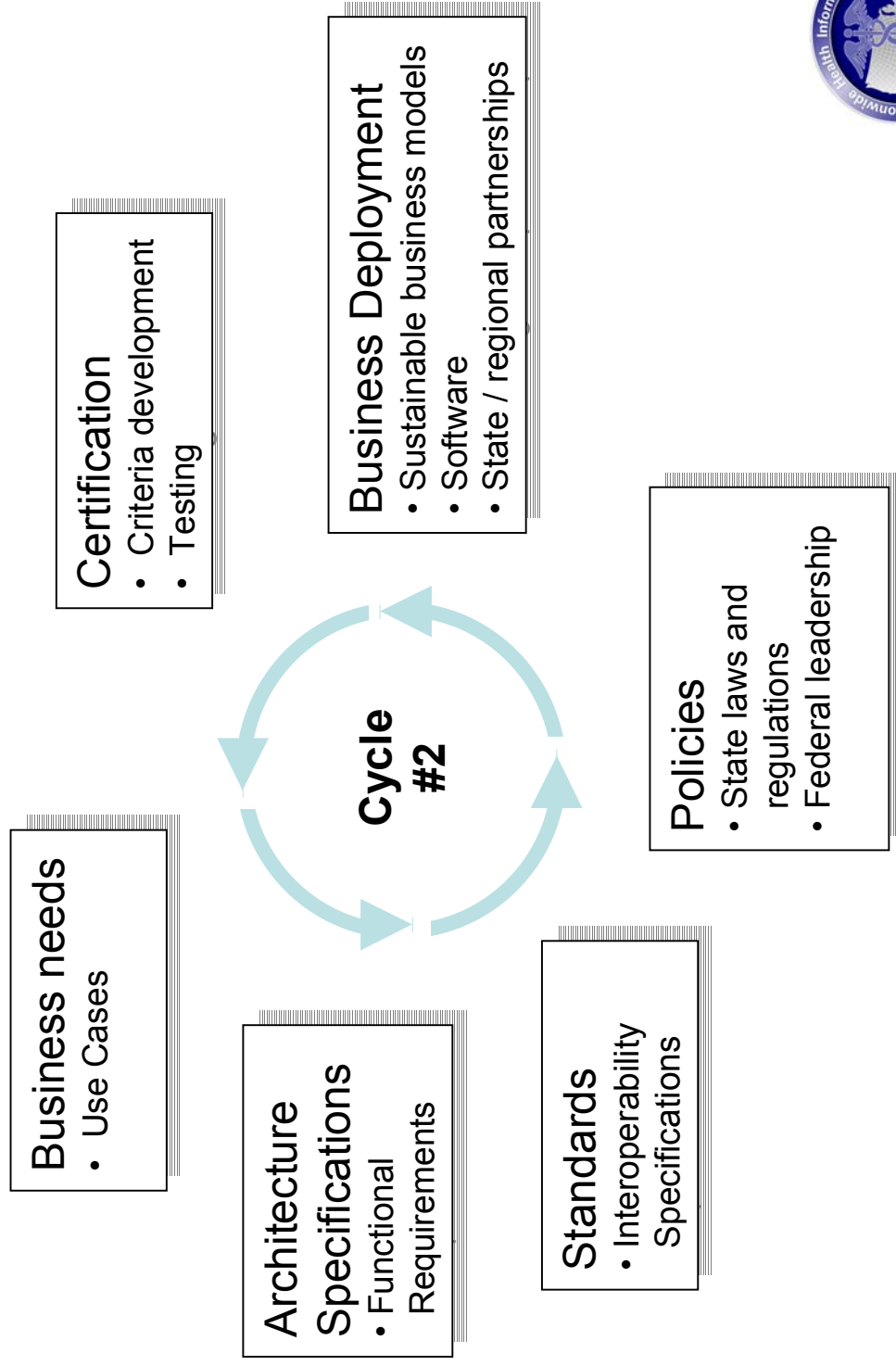
Completing the first cycle

1. Third NHIN forum
 - Prototypes
 - Business models for health information network services
2. Advance interfacing standards needs to AHIC and HITSP
3. Work policy considerations through state and federal groups (State Alliance for e-Health, CPS workgroup, etc.)
4. Initiate development of certification criteria for health networks

NHIN Cycle #2

- Tie NHIN initiative even more closely to state and regional efforts
- Further develop health information network service providers and service partnerships
- Focus on connections between networks and systems (standard interfaces, processes...)
 1. Other health information network service providers
 2. EHR's and PHR's
 3. Government systems (e.g. VA / DOD, state biosurveillance, vital statistics)
 4. Special function networks
- Develop testing approaches for network service interoperability
