What Can YOU Do?

Here are simple, yet important steps you can take to prevent or respond to threats to our food supply:

Be Aware –

- Know who your local law enforcement officials are and how to contact them.
- Identify areas that may be particularly susceptible to intrusion or tampering.

Be Bold –

- Train all your employees on security measures.
- Establish systems to increase vigilance in protecting our food supply.

Be Careful –

- Control access to data processing system, supplies, and heating, air conditioning, and ventilation systems.
- Add extra security guards, cameras and lights.

Be Diligent –

- Secure all doors, windows, vents, water sources and storage tanks.
- Monitor all deliveries and maintenance.

Be Enterprising –

- Screen potential employees; check background and references.
- Be sure that employees know emergency contact information and evacuation procedures.

Be Focused –

- Require photo ID and escort visitors while in your plant.
- Watch for any suspicious activities or unusual actions and report them to your local officials.
