Recommended studies: 2 studies

1. Type of study: Fasting

Design: Single-dose, two-treatment, two-period crossover *in-vivo* Strength: 250 mg (please administer a 500 mg dose; 2 X 250 mg) Subjects: Normal healthy males and females, general population.

Additional Comments: Females must have a negative baseline pregnancy test within 24 hours prior to receiving the drug. Females should not be pregnant or lactating, and if

applicable, should practice abstention or contraception during the study.

2. Type of study: Fed

Design: Single-dose, two-treatment, two-period crossover *in-vivo* Strength: 250 mg (please administer a 500 mg dose; 2 X 250 mg) Subjects: Normal healthy males and females, general population.
