The Coast Guard Institute in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma offers Nonresident Training which is available to Auxiliary members.

Nonresident Training is training that is not conducted at a training facility. Examples include on-the-job training, exportable training and **CORRESPONDENCE COURSES.**

The Institute's mission is to coordinate the submission, production, stocking, and

Coast Guard Auxiliary members are eligible for all courses except for classified courses.
