Hi

As we discussed last week, I've done some research to identify precedent cases and found DoD Uniformed Services and the USCG exceptions in accepting delays in and suspension of A-76 studies. I've included a couple web inks, pdf files with additional background information that might be helpful, and we can discuss further on Monday. I was not able to locate a specific document backing up the USCG, however we are currently helping the USCG with

the one we understand is the only study currently being conducted.

Kelly Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas - At Kelley AFB all A-76 studies were suspended while discussions on Base Re-Alignment and Closure (BRAC) Act were decided. This suspension of A-76 studies saved the USAF budget significant funds as Kelly eventually went on to be closed under the Congress BRAC Act. This occurred around 1997.

The Defense Logistics Agency (DLA), at Fort Belvoir, VA - The DLA suspended all A-76 studies on Depot Operations from 1989 to 1996 (approximately). This happened when DLA initiated a consolidation of their Five Depot Area Commands into three Distribution Regions. A-76 studies

further delayed as the Three Distribution Regions were restructured into a centralized Defense Distribution Center (DDC) now Headquartered in PA.

The USCG has delayed seven of their eight announced A-76 studies pending their realignment under the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the outcome of the Iraqi War. One of these studies involved 600 positions performing Financial Services.
