



### Worst case: Morro das Pedras

- More than 25 thousand residents
- 24% of the families have TOTAL income below minimum wage
- 41% of labor force was unemployed. Most engage in informal activities: washing cars or sellings goods in the streets, carrying out small repair services, etc.


• 10% had no regular income

#### **Police Districts**




There are about 5,600 police officers divided into 24 police districts.


### **Homicides in 2006**




Spatial distribution of 2006 homicides (approx 1000)

### **Belo Horizonte in a nutshell**

- Belo Horizonte has 2.4 million inhabitants and about 700 thousand households.
- It ranks among the 5 largest Brazilian cities
- Its labor force is concentrated in services and industrial jobs
- Starting in 1960, population increased quickly due to rural migration but it stabilized in 1990

### **Policing With Results**

- Increase in violent crime pressed Police for improvement.
- Starting in 1999, a new program, Policing with Results, was introduced.
- Help from CRISP, an academic center affiliated with the Universidade Federal de Minas Gerais.
- Main objective: Results matter, and area
   <sup>5/6</sup>COmmanders are evaluated accordingly <sup>24</sup>

# **Peculiarities of Belo Horizonte**

- Unique experience in Latin America: collaboration between university and police!
- CRISP received an initial grant from FORD Foundation which was crucial.
- We took policemen to New York to watch the COMPSTAT in NY
- We gave several training courses in crime mapping and statistics to police force

### **CRISP:** training and policy studies

- More than 400 police officers trained on CRIMESTAT, SPSS, and GIS software
- Academic studies: victimization surveys, school violence, etc.
- Design of public safety policies for the state-level government

# Two successful experiences

FICA VIVO Program: "Stay alive program"

- Reduce homicides in high risk areas
- Data-based diagnostic (maps, graphs, stats, etc)
- Prevention: identify community leaders; activities involving sports, recreation (music, dance, arts, etc) for children under 14 years old.

- GEPAR: special police force to deal with drug sellers, and other criminals from these <sup>5/6/2007</sup> areas.

# Two successful experiences


- IGESP inspired by COMPSTAT
- Divide the city into 24 geographical regions
- In each region, monthly meetings
- Integrate the several different police agencies and public agencies (municipality, health agency, justice system, etc.)
- Evidence-based
- Accountability




Evolução Mensal dos Crimes Violentos Belo Horizonte - Janeiro de 1998 a Fevereiro de 2007




Top Police Officers Change Beginning of data use by police

Evolução Mensal dos Crimes Violentos Belo Horizonte - Janeiro de 2004 a Dezembro de 2006




# Monthly Average Number of Homicides
