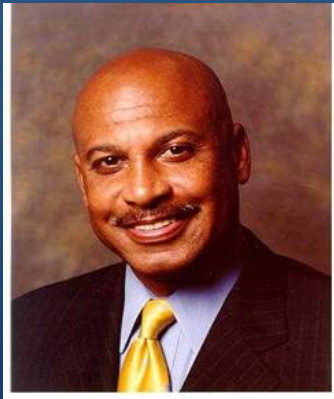

Crime Mapping Also Provides Law Enforcement Executives With An Accountability System That Can Determine If Personnel Within Their Agency Are Performing Their Duties As Directed.




**City Of Trenton Police

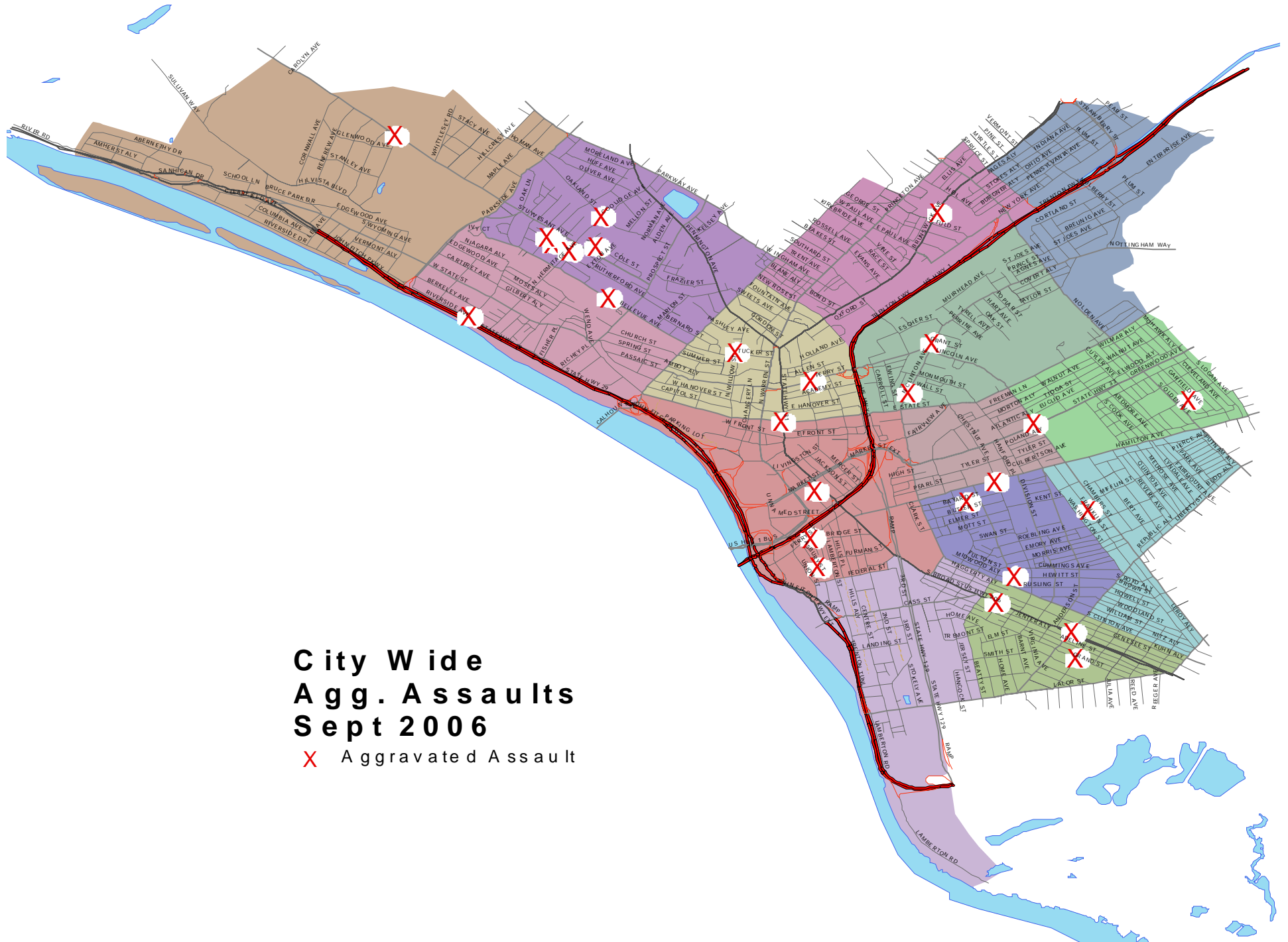
# City Wide Sexual Assaults Sept 2006

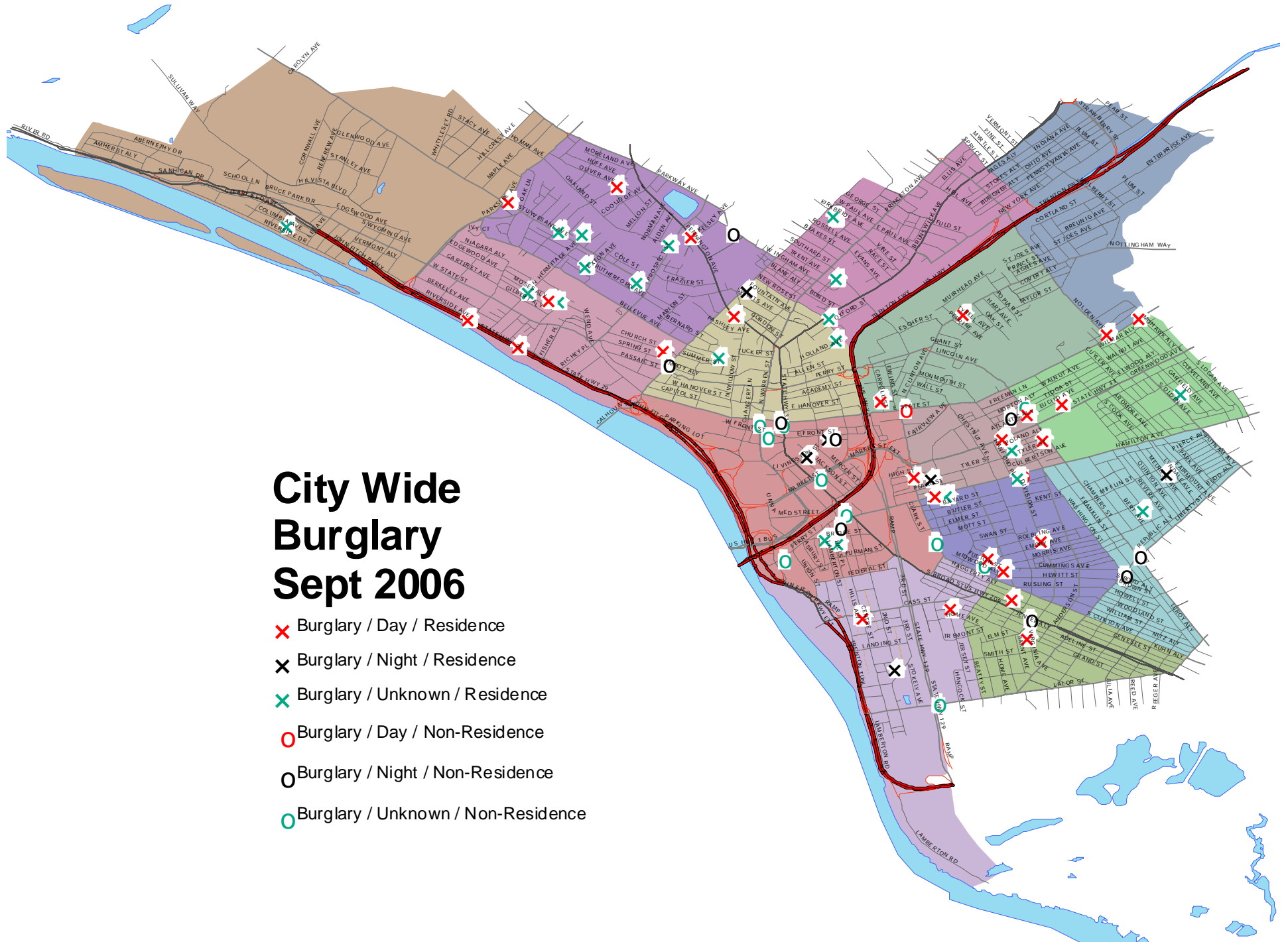
# City Wide Robbery Sept 2006

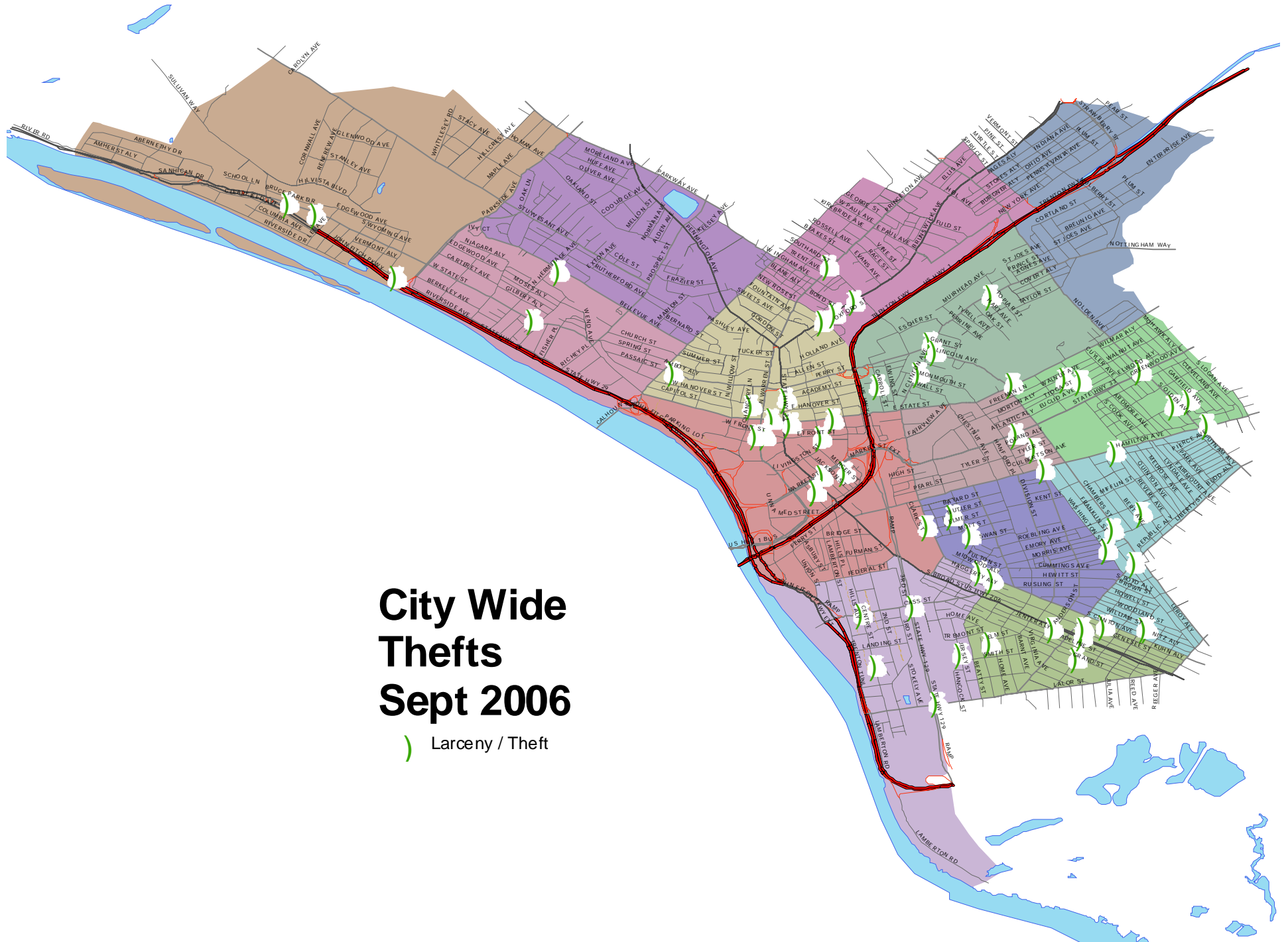

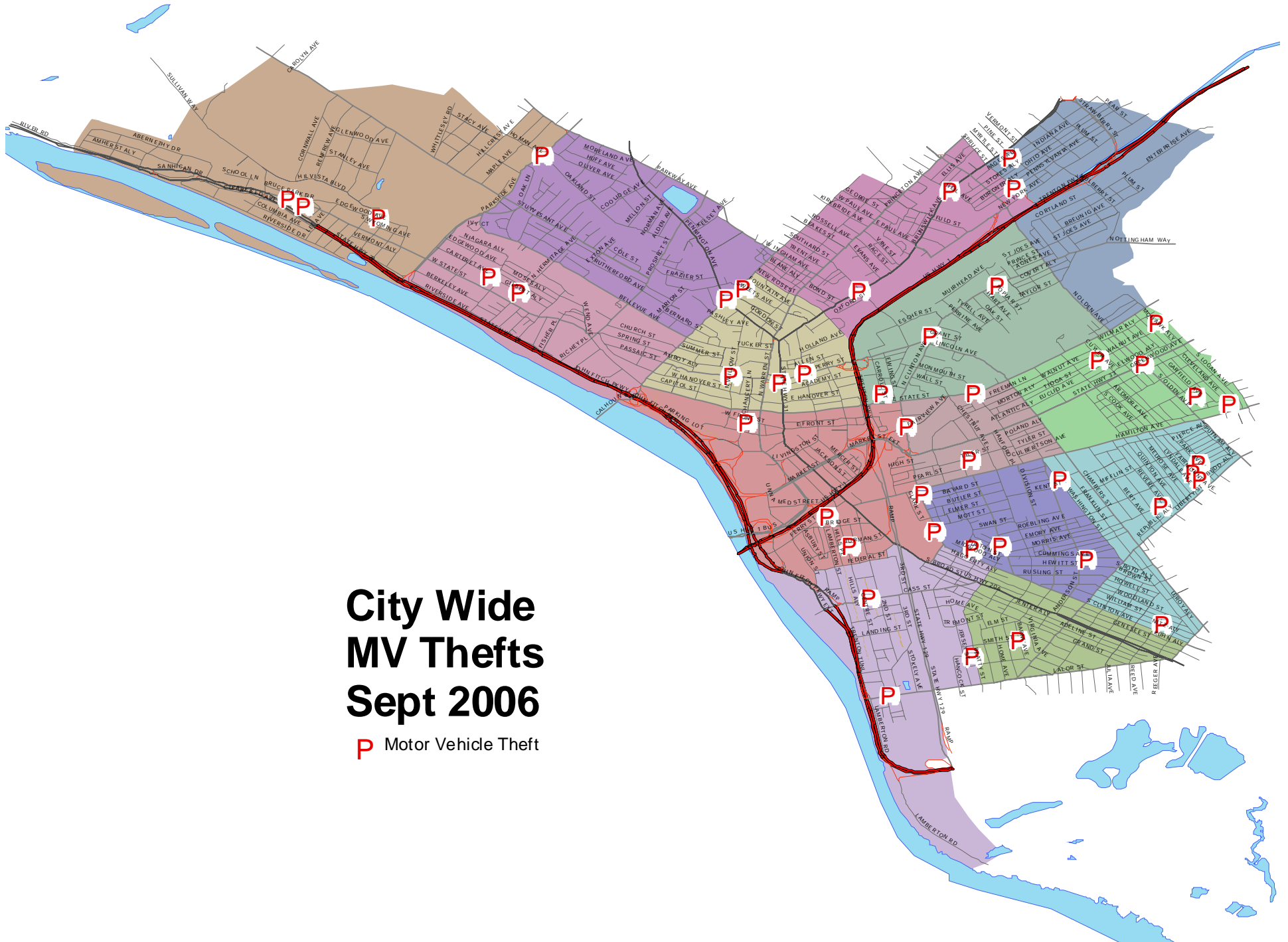

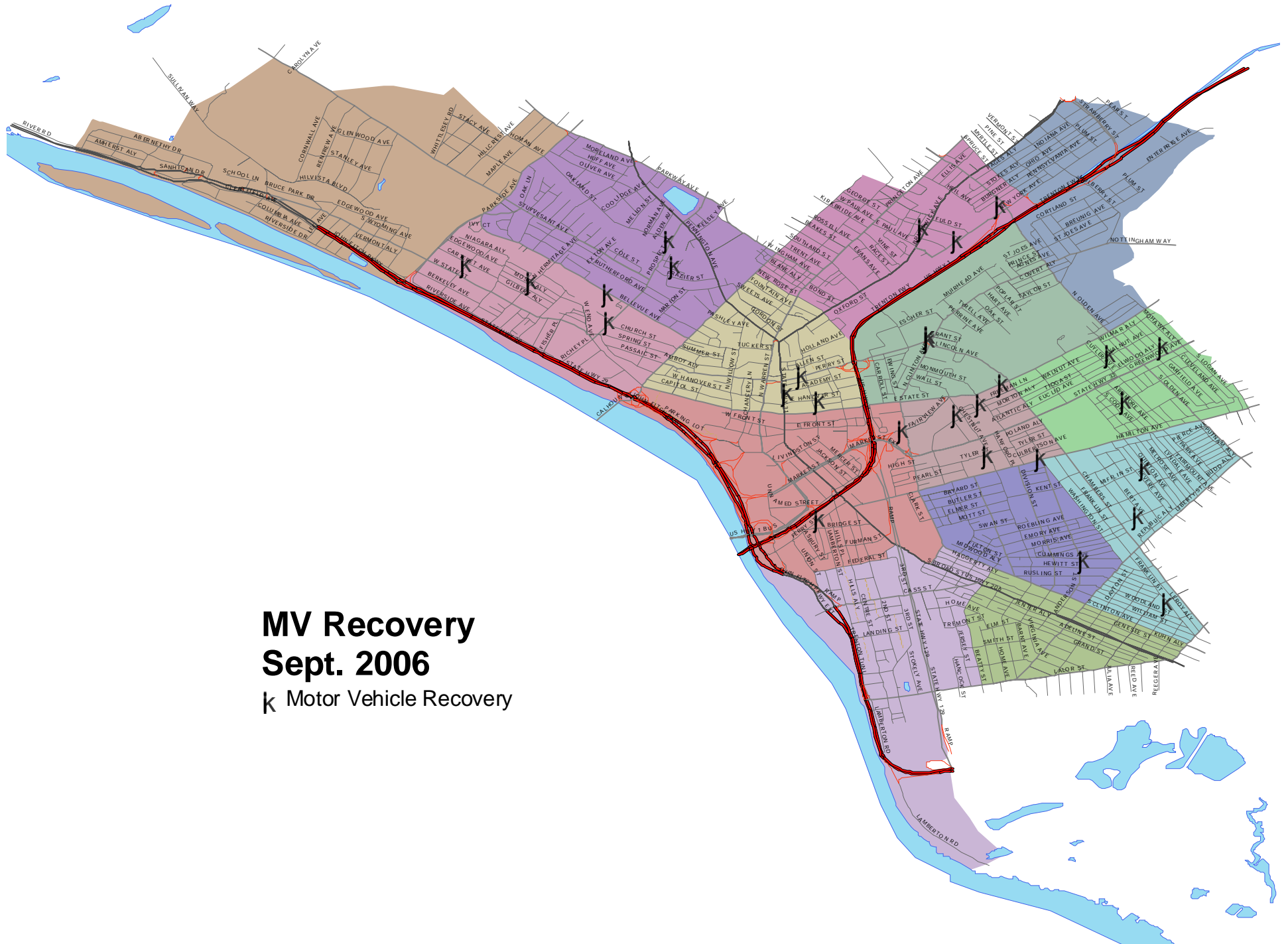

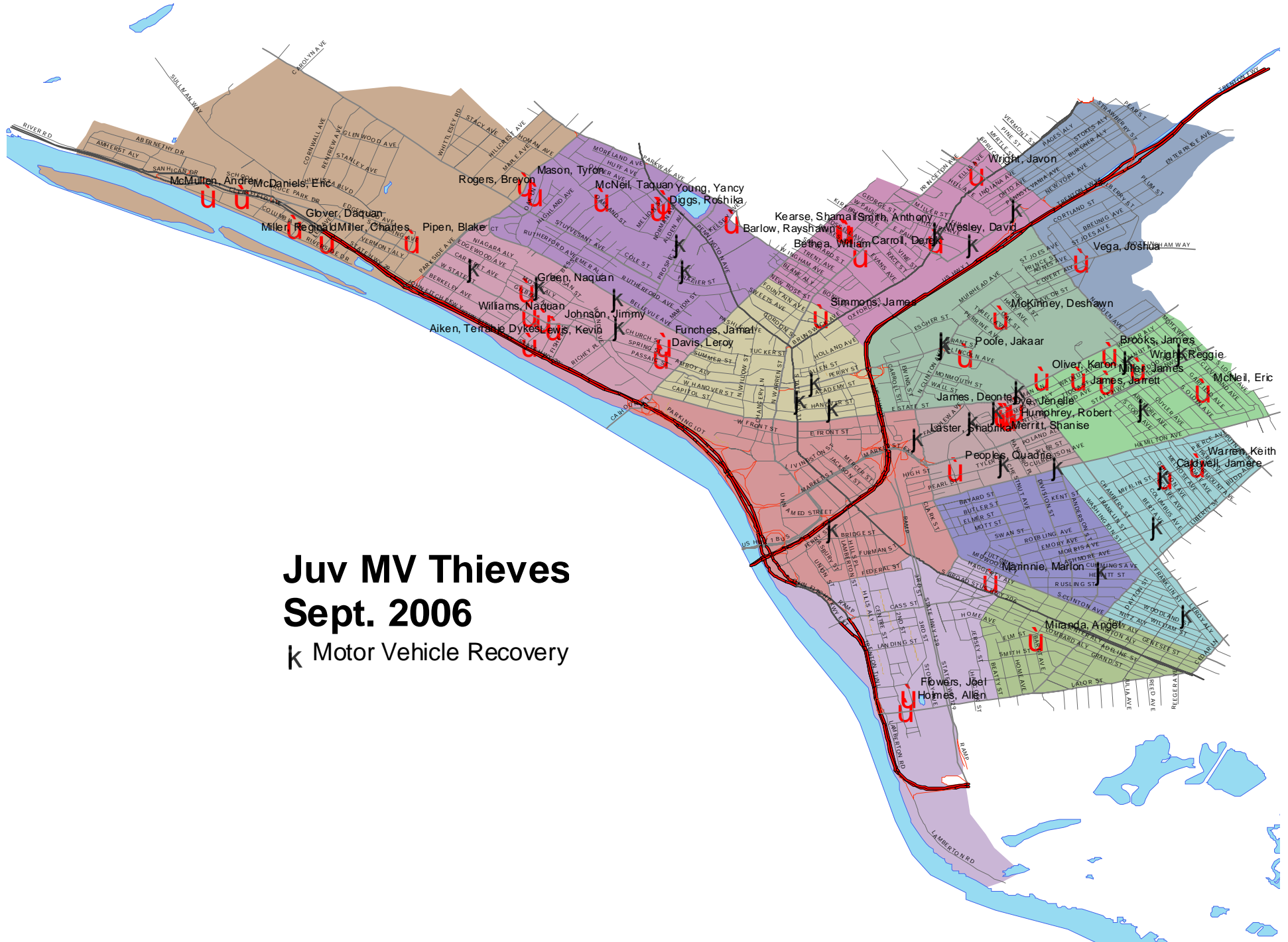
P Motor Vehicle Theft

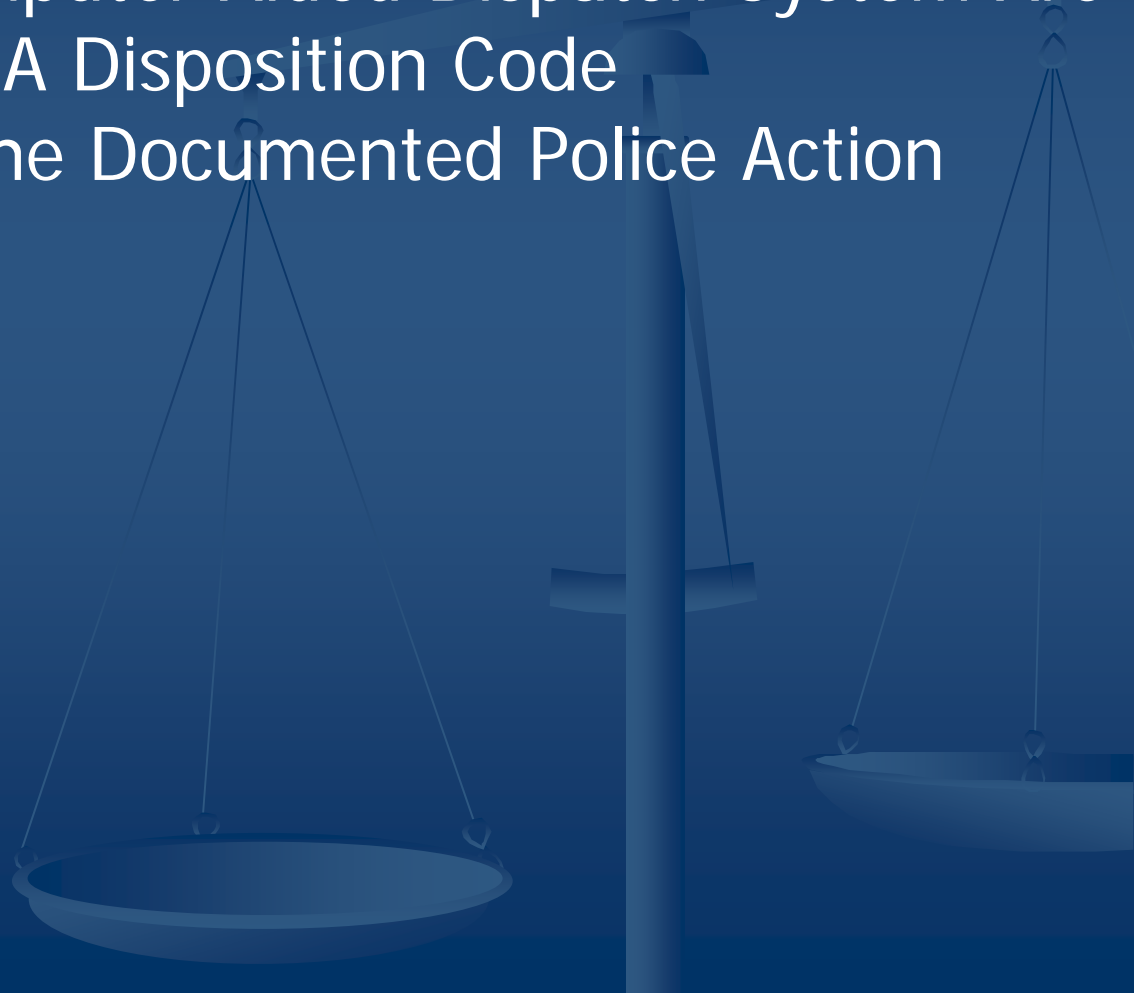

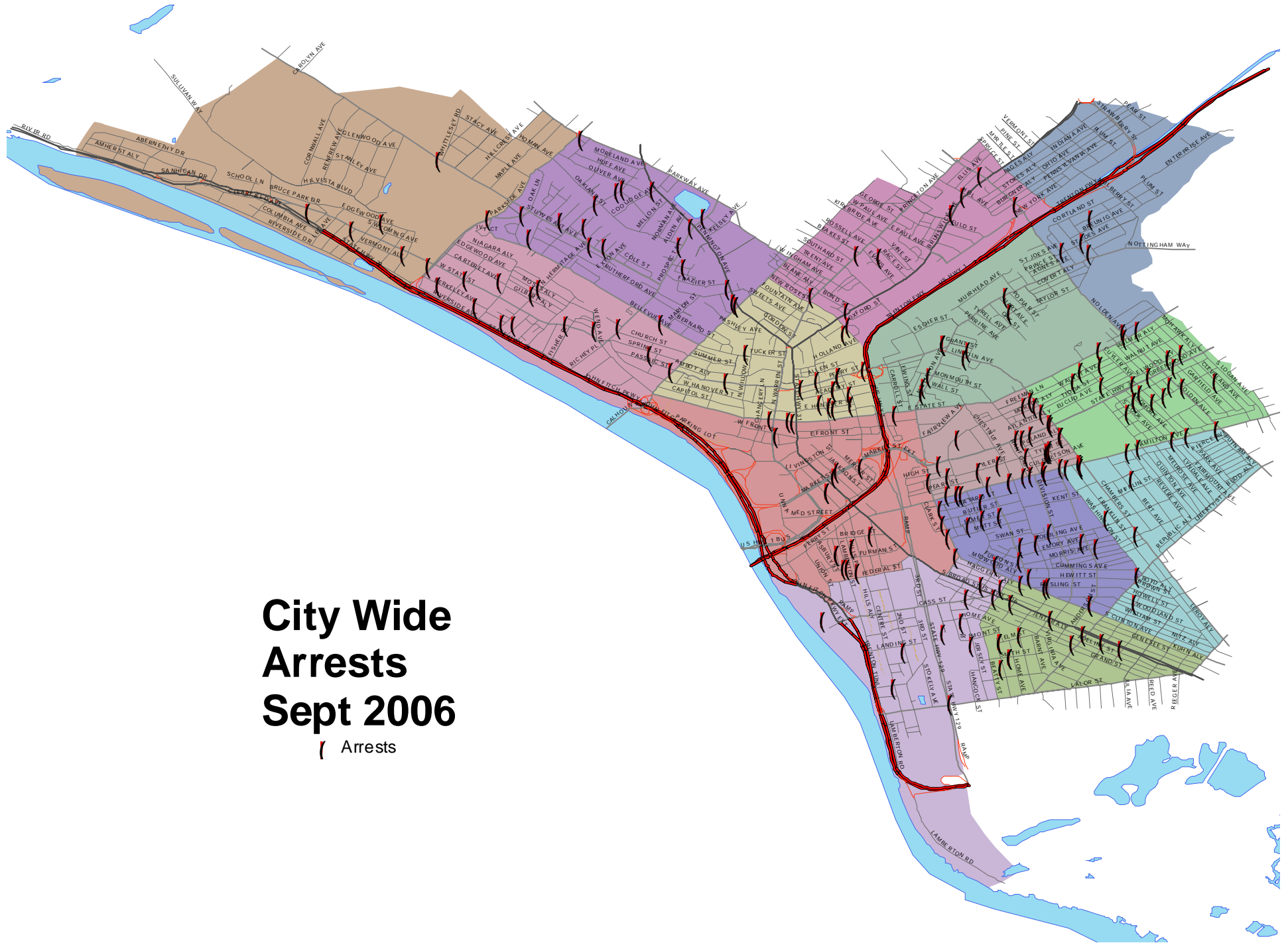


# DISPOSITION CODES

- 901 Investigation Report Submitted**
- 902 Supplementary Report Submitted**  
All supplementary reports shall be referenced to an original or controlling Investigations Report and Case Number.
- 903 Missing Person Report Submitted**  
All Missing Persons Reports shall consist of an Investigations Report. However, the broadcast description shall be Code 903.
- 904 Towed Vehicle Report Submitted**  
Disposition only when assignment is **not immediately** related to an Investigation or Motor Vehicle Accident Report disposition. [i.e. vehicle towed as recovered stolen, abandoned auto, obstructing roadway, etc.]
- 905 Property (Evidence) Report Submitted**  
Disposition only when assignment is **not immediately** related to Investigations Report. [i.e. shell casings recovered with report of crime or property damage, found property evidence from previous crime or call.]
- 906 Drug Arrest Report**  
Any and all arrests related to the possession of a controlled dangerous substance or the possession of drug paraphernalia or the conspiracy to possess or distribute a controlled dangerous substance.
- 907 Arrest Report Submitted**  
Custodial Arrests shall require Investigations Report. However, broadcast disposition shall be Code 907.  
Code 907 shall also include all Hand Summons issued for 2C offenses, as well as an Investigations Report.
- 908 Warrant Arrest Report**  
Custodial Arrests for outstanding Trenton Municipal Court warrants shall require an arrest report (docket) only. In the event that an outstanding Trenton Police Warrant or Summons (CDR 1 or CDR 2) is being served on a defendant, a Supplementary Report shall be submitted, in both cases the broadcast disposition shall be 908.
- 909 Arrest For Other Authority (F.O.A.)**  
Custodial Arrests for outstanding warrants/charges for an outside jurisdiction shall require an arrest report to be submitted, however the disposition shall be 909.
- 910 V.C.O. Hand Summons Issued**

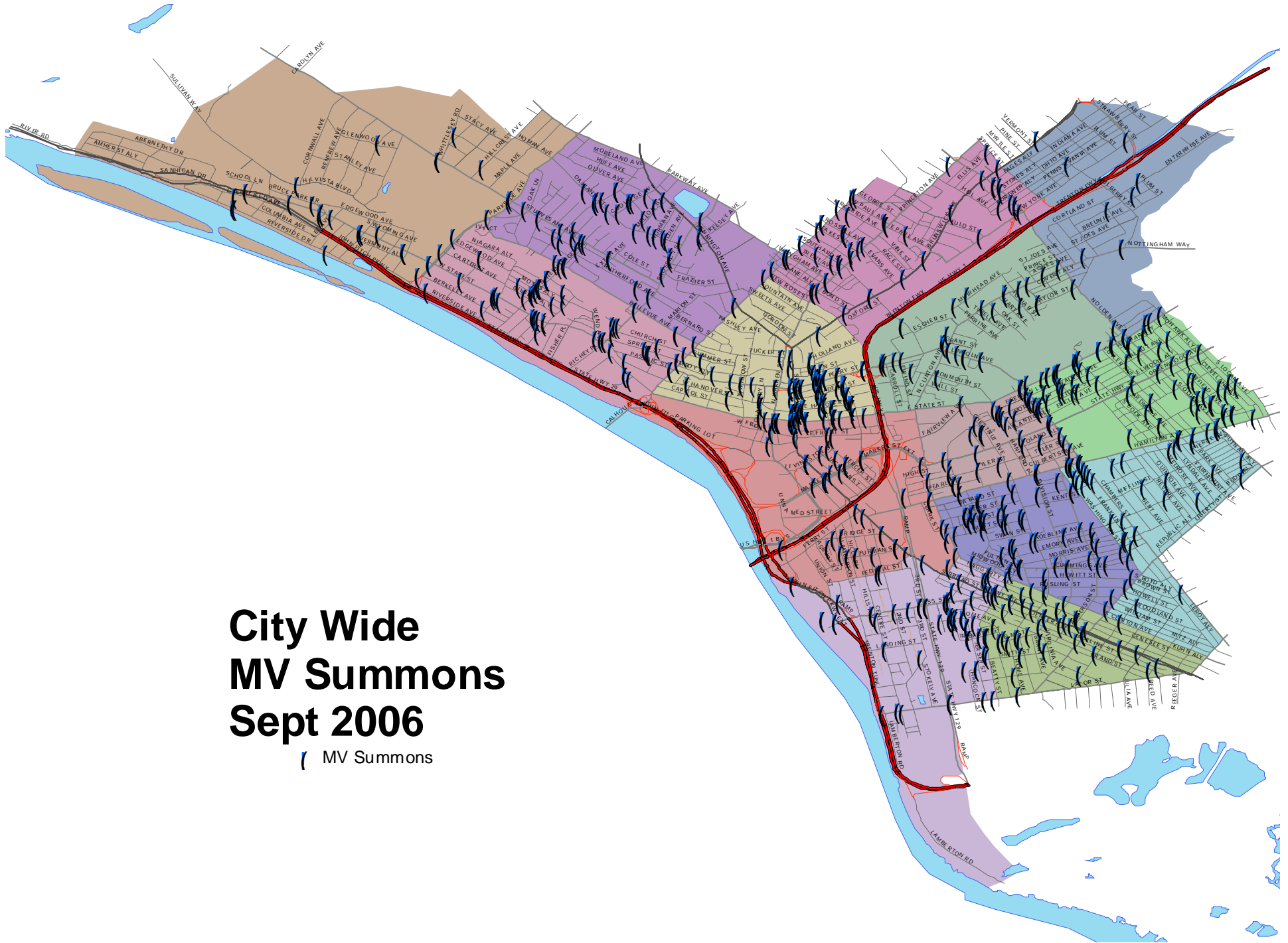

- 920 Motor Vehicle Accident Report Submitted**  
Code shall include related actions [i.e. summonses, tows except reports of crime(s) 901 or Arrests 906-908.]
- 921 Field Inquiry Report Submitted**
- 922 Gang Intelligence Report Submitted**  
Includes subjects of Code 921, if gang members.
- 923 Administrative Report Submitted**
- 924 Alcohol Beverage Control Referral Submitted**
- 930 Motor Vehicle Summons Issued**  
List number or type (parking vs. moving). No Accident Report Required.
- 931 Sent On Way (SOW)**  
No Field Inquiry, Gang or Arrest Reports required.
- 932 Gone On Arrival (GOA)**  
Complainant and/or cause not at scene at time of arrival.
- 933 Checked O.K.**  
Cause of complaint or conditions are satisfactory or do not require additional police action.
- 934 Advised**  
Caller provided information or made aware of corrective action(s) on cause of call.
- 935 Referred to Court**  
Individuals referred to court regarding civil matters and/or action that do not require police action or reporting.
- 936 Handled By Other Unit**  
Assignment or activity is taken by, or designated to, another Trenton Police unit.
- 937 Handled By Other Authority**  
Responsibility for action or reporting is the proper jurisdiction of another law enforcement or government agency.
- 938 No Cause for Service**  
Upon a preliminary investigation by responding officer(s) the incident is unfounded or does not require action or reporting by the Trenton Police.
- 939 Assignment Completed**  
Completion of assignments [i.e. prisoner transport, prisoner/hospital guard, meal period, traffic posts, etc.]
- 940 No Action - Duplicate Call**  
Cite case number in remarks.
- 950 No Disposition Submitted by Police**  
Dispositions not called in by unit/officers at/by conclusion of tour.
- \*960 Related Call**
- \*961 Abandoned Vehicle Referral**
- \*962 Cancelled**

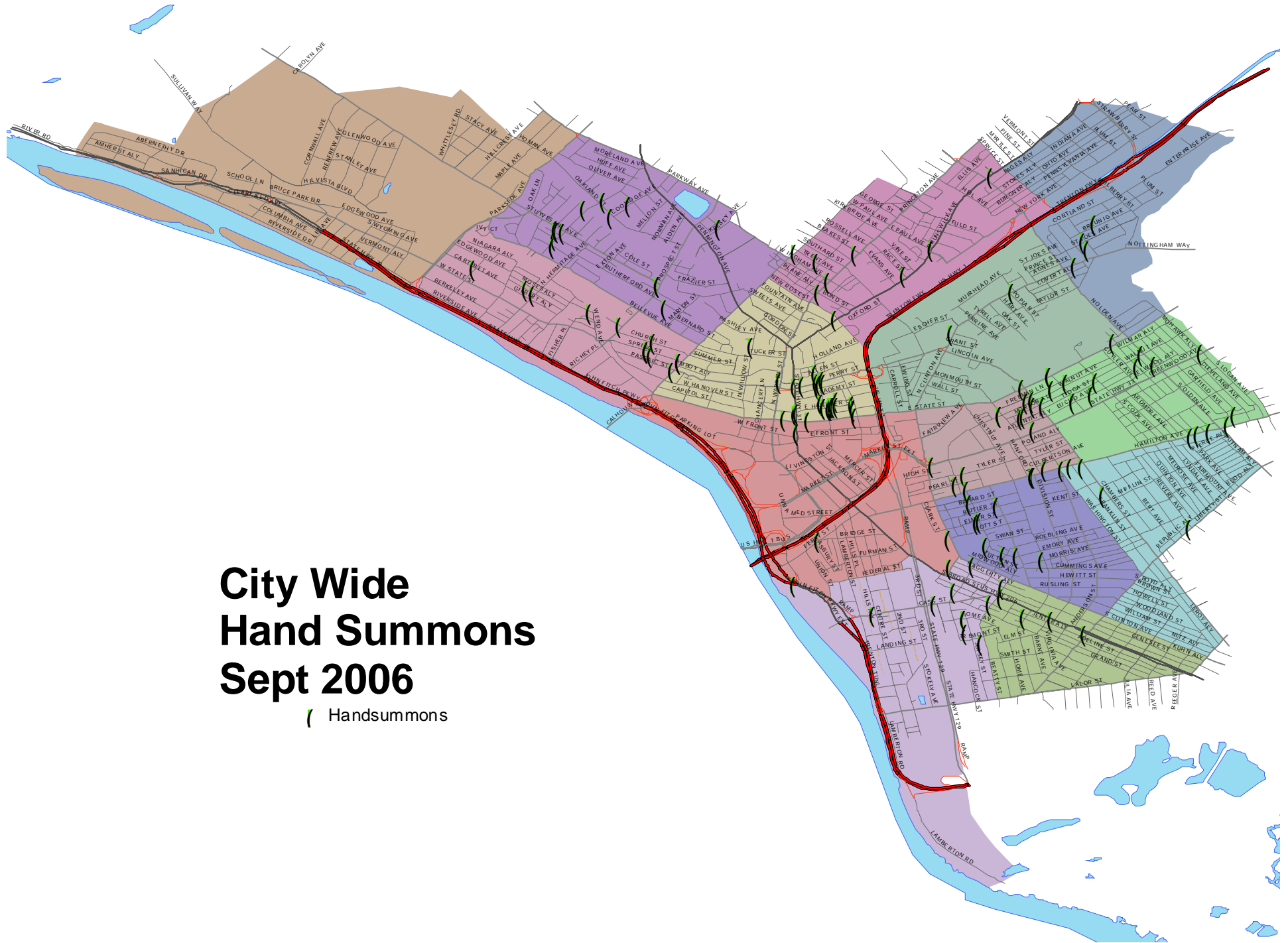

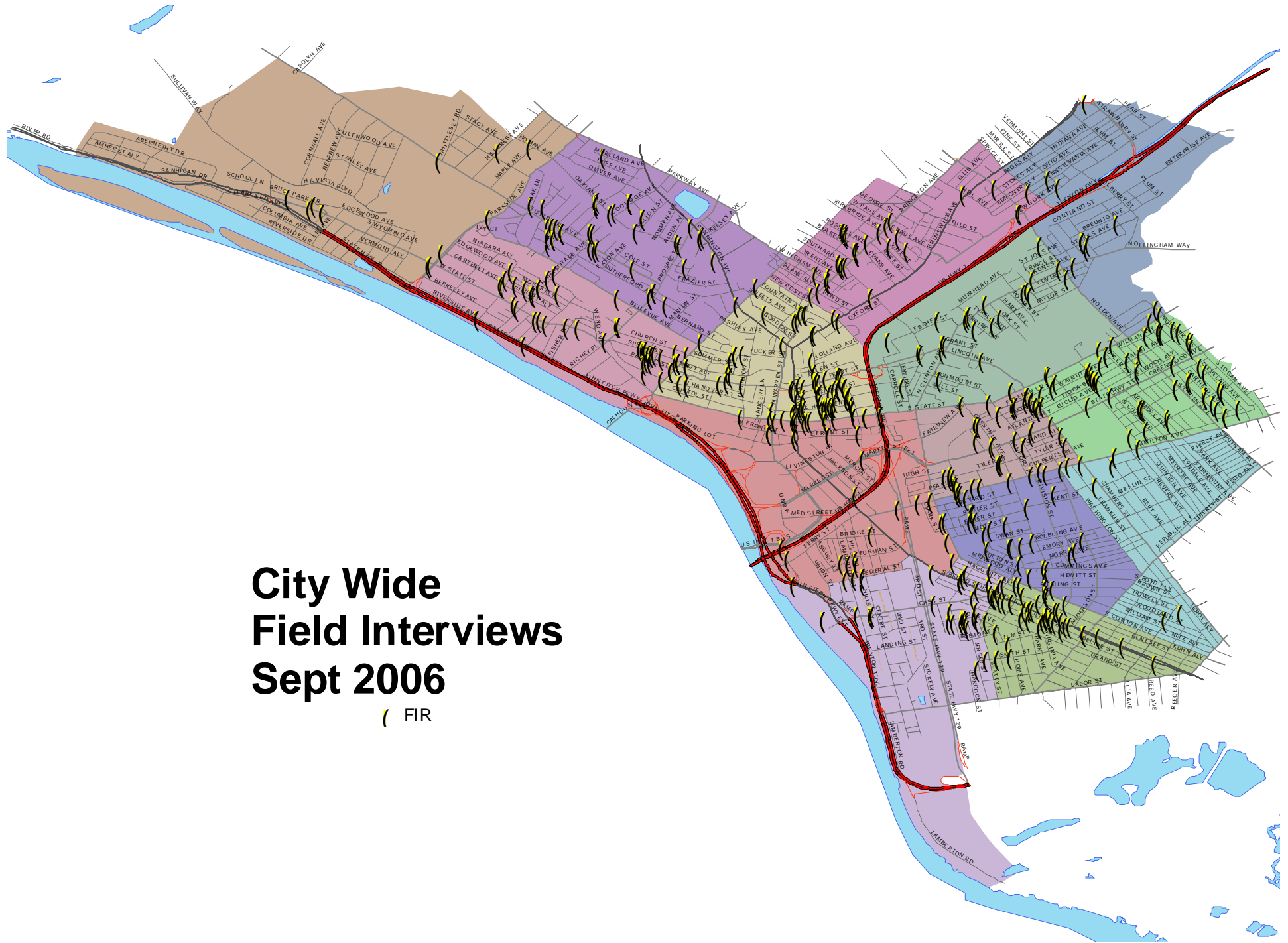
# City Wide MV Summons Sept 2006
