

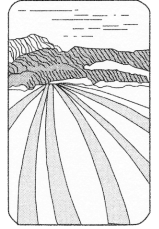

On Friday, October 19, 2007 the Federal-State Audit Team performed an audit at Example Company verifying your companies good agriculture practices. The Good Agriculture Practice (GAP) audit criteria is contained in the USDA Federal-State Audit Checklist. An eighty percentile is required to obtain a passing score and GAP certificate. The audit scope and audit results are as follows:
