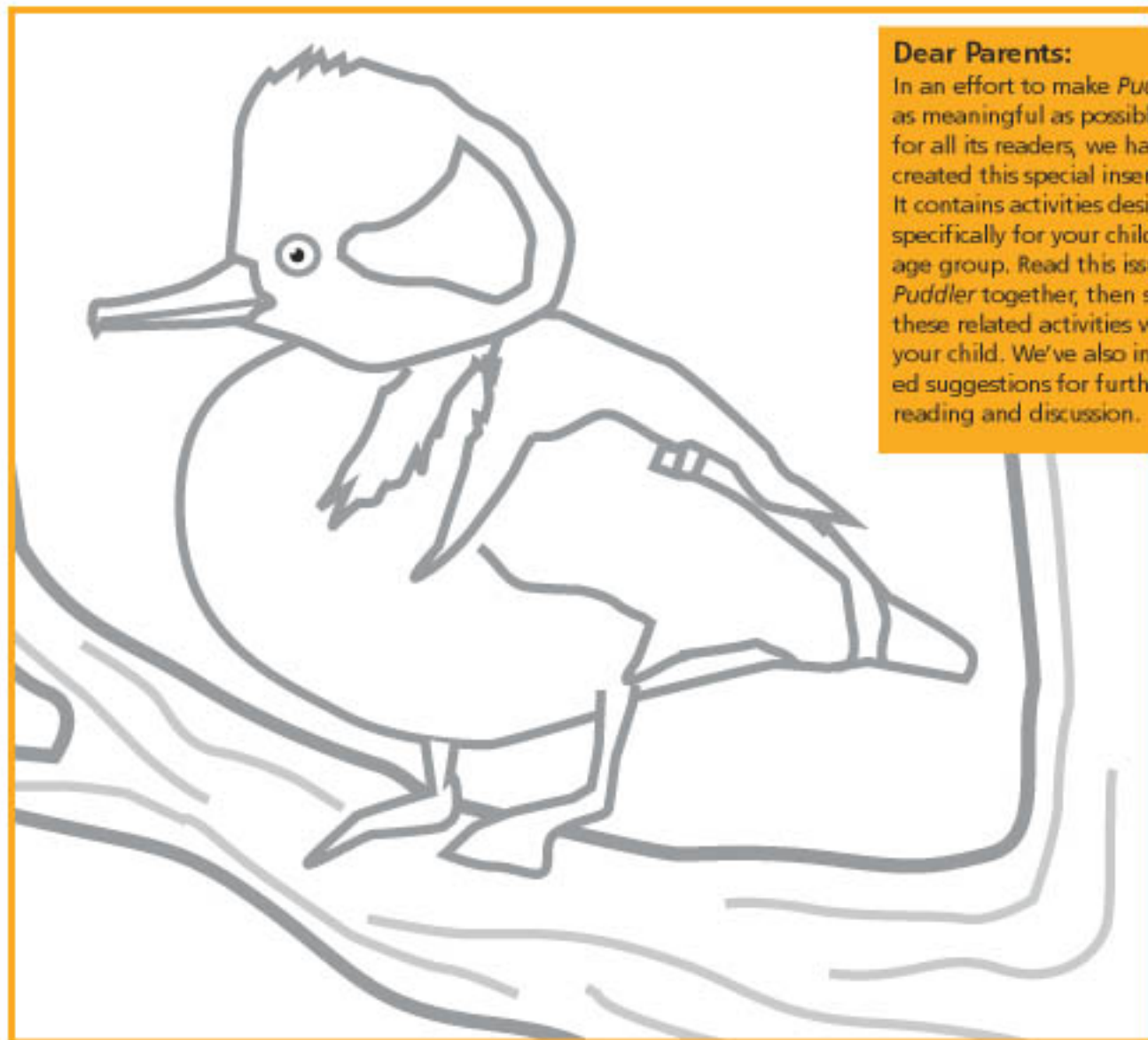

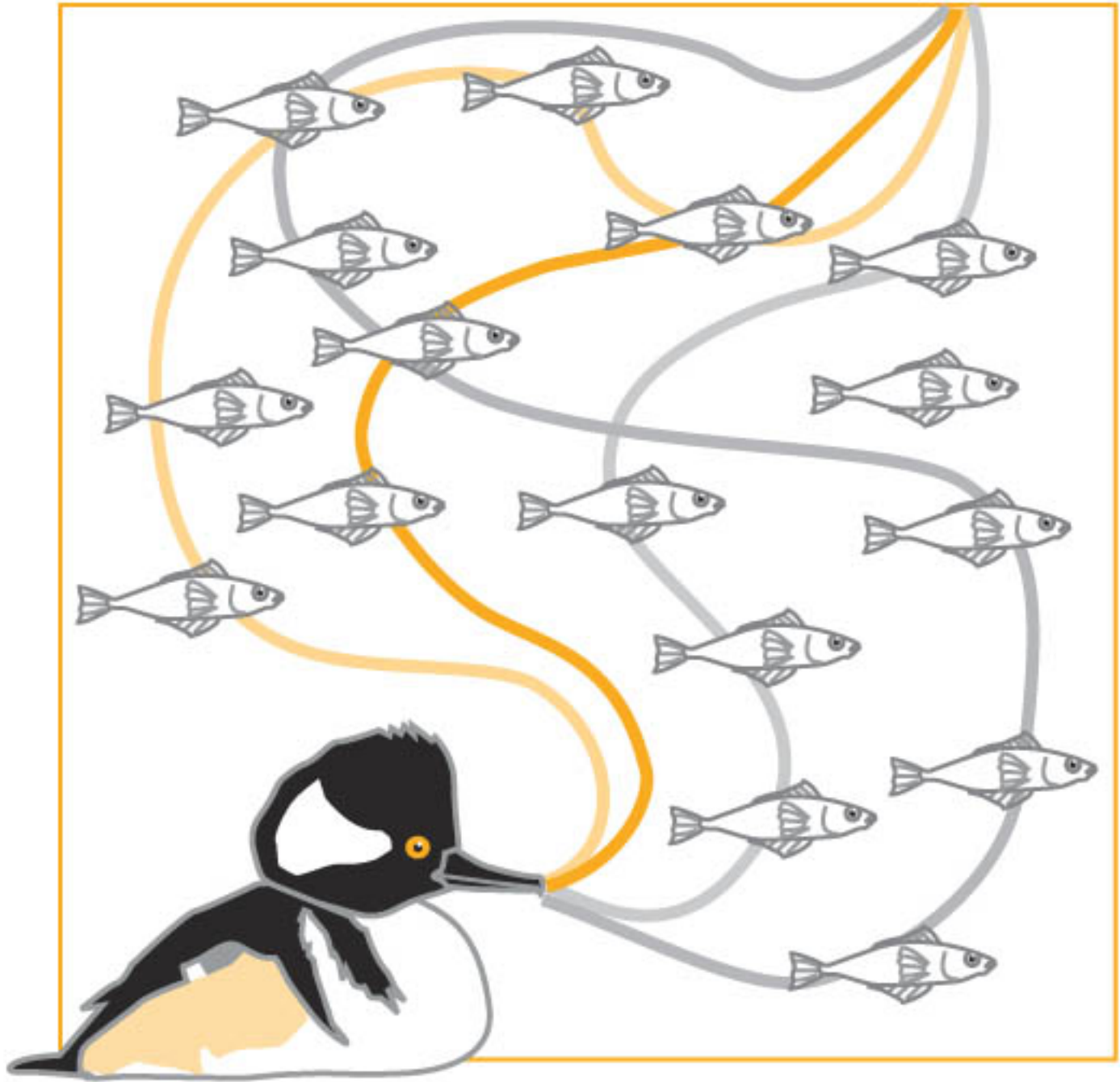

Use the pictures in I.D. Me to help you choose colors.

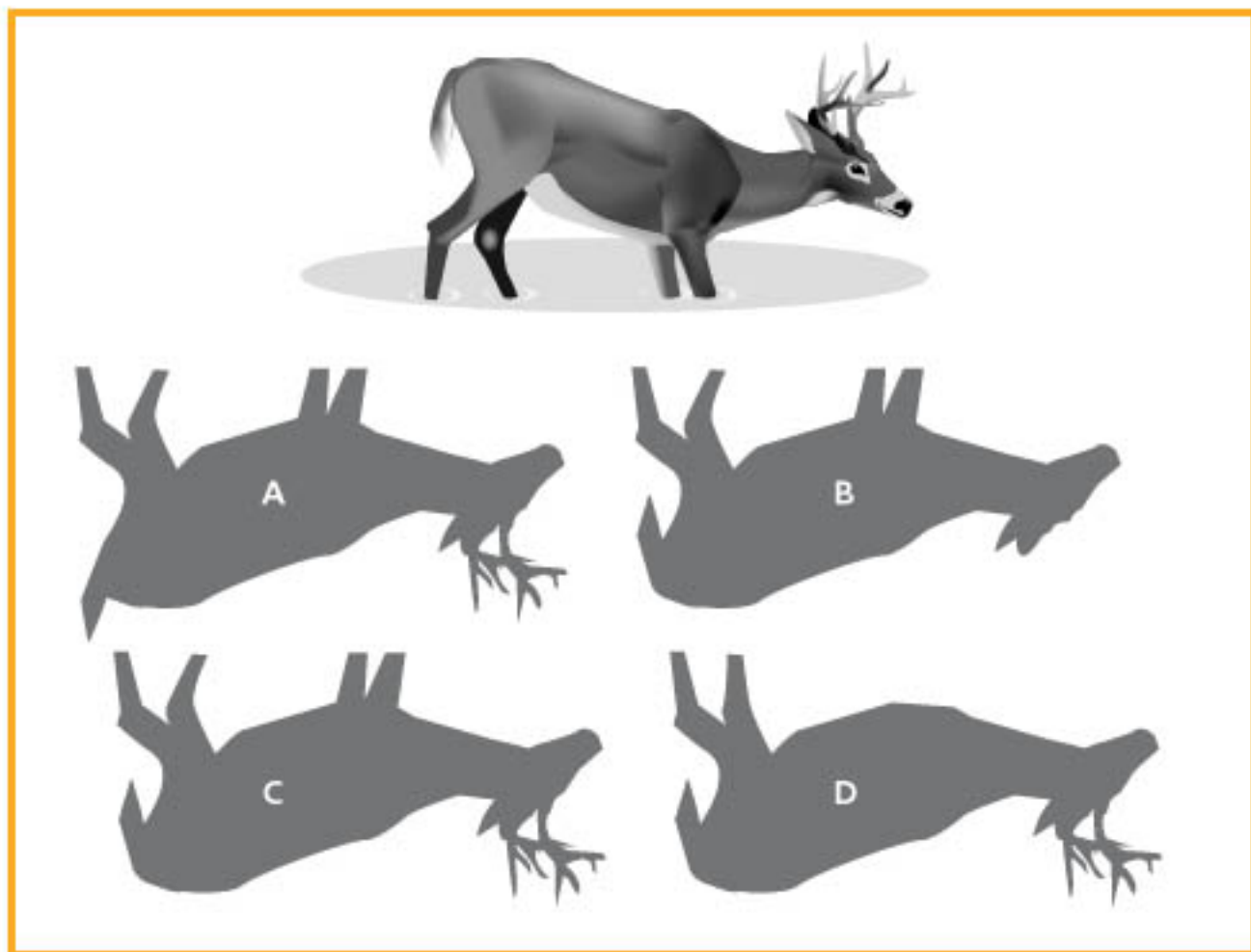
