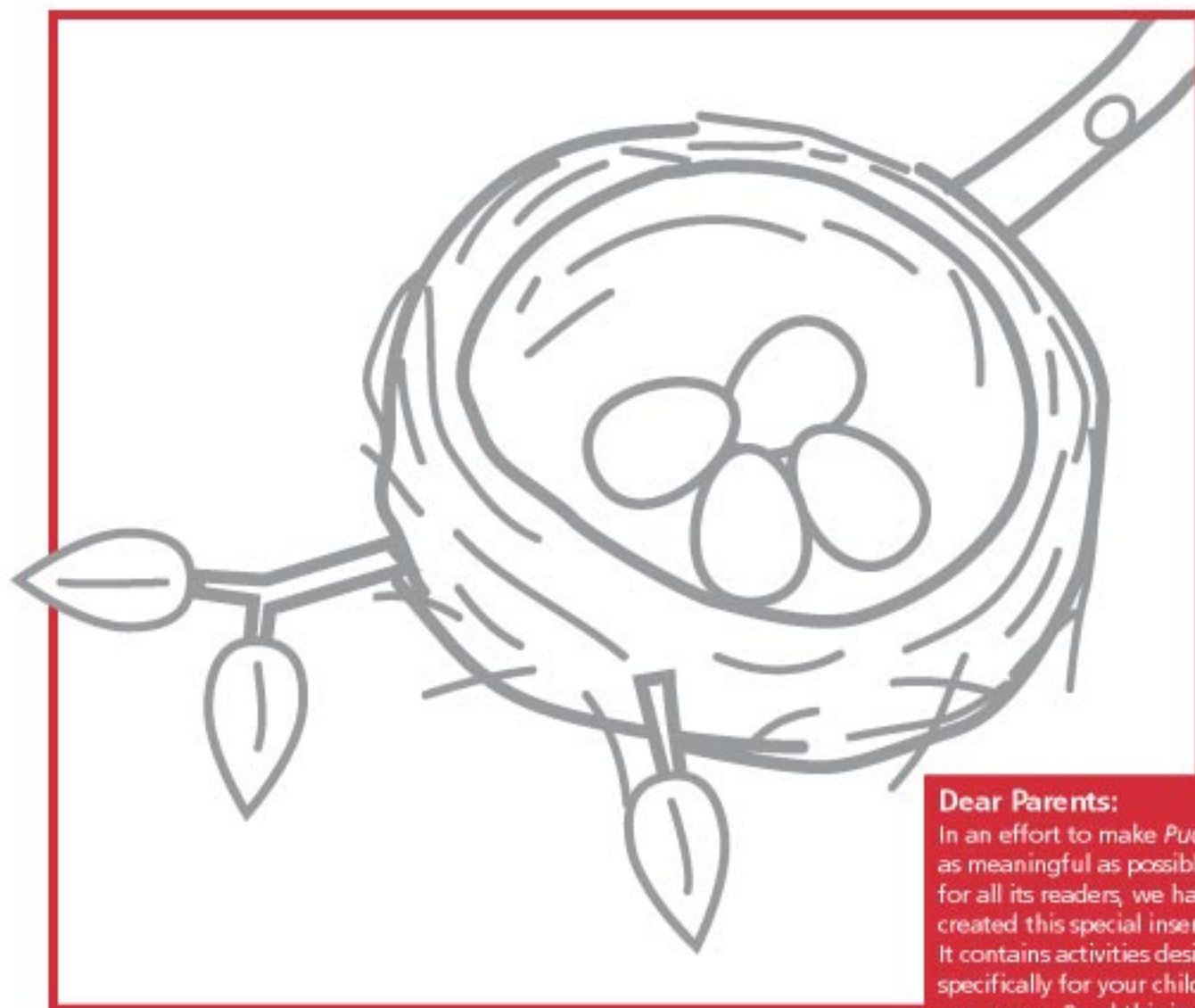

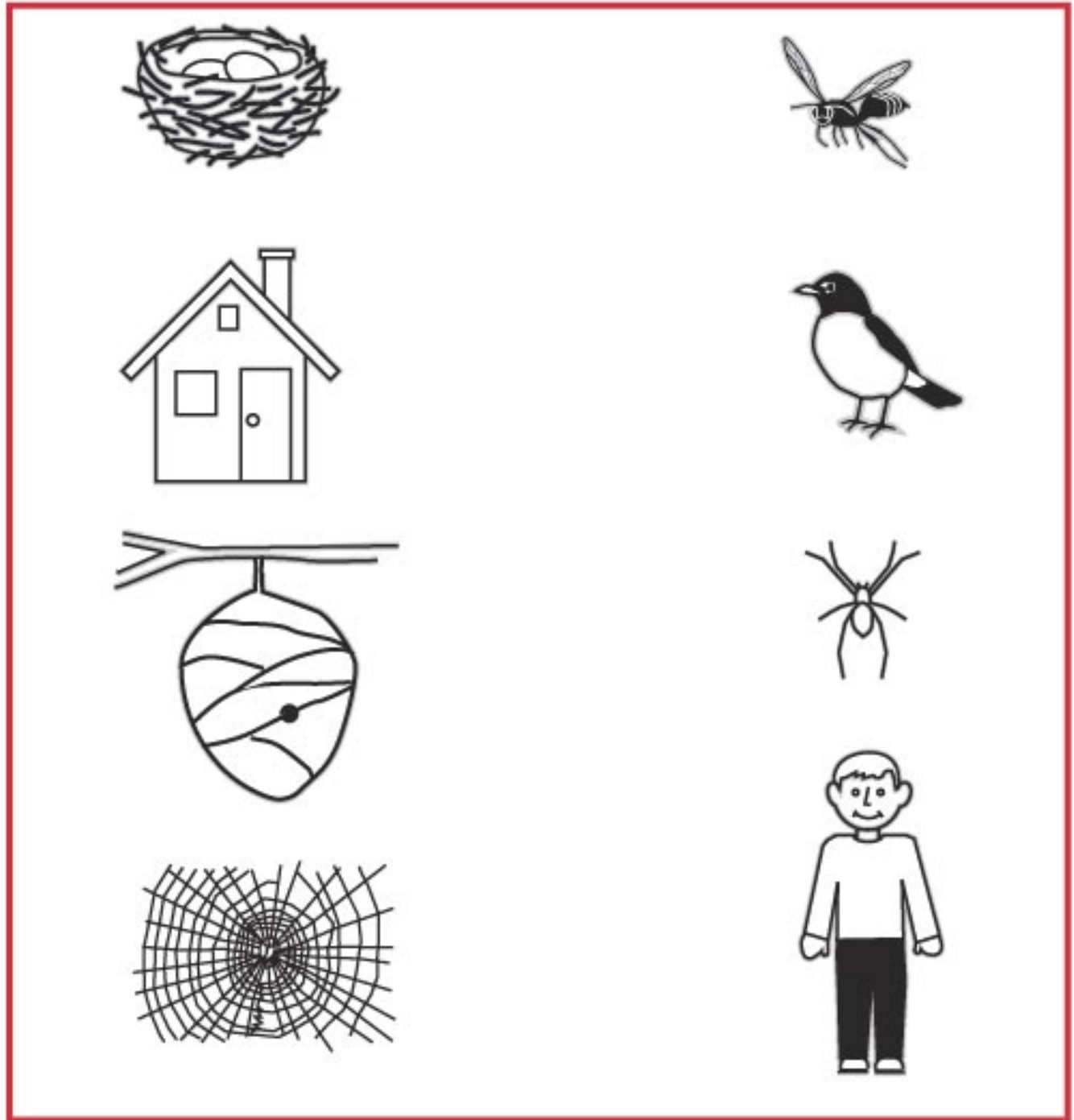


Robins lay blue eggs. How many eggs are in this robin's nest? Color the picture!

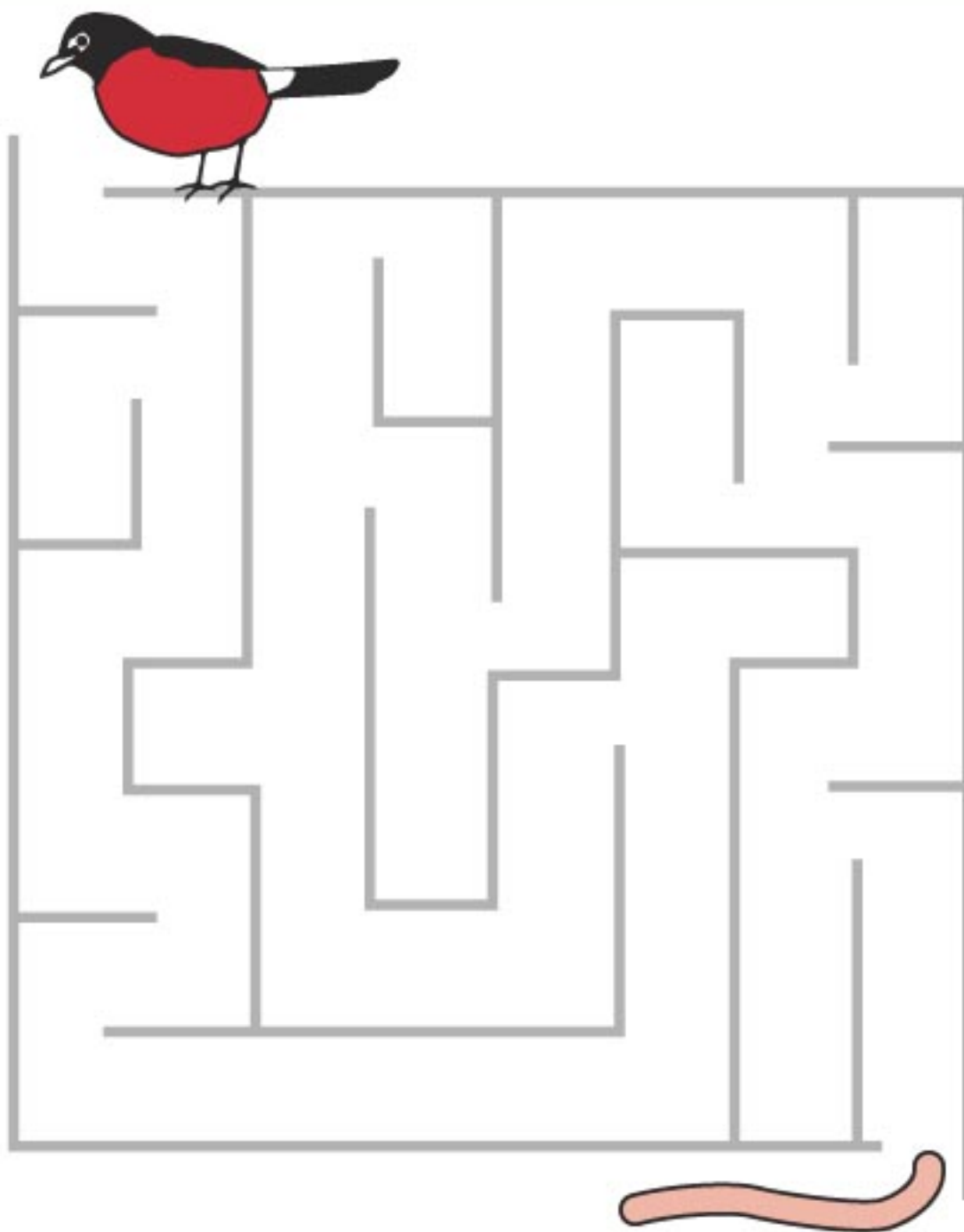
Dear Parents:

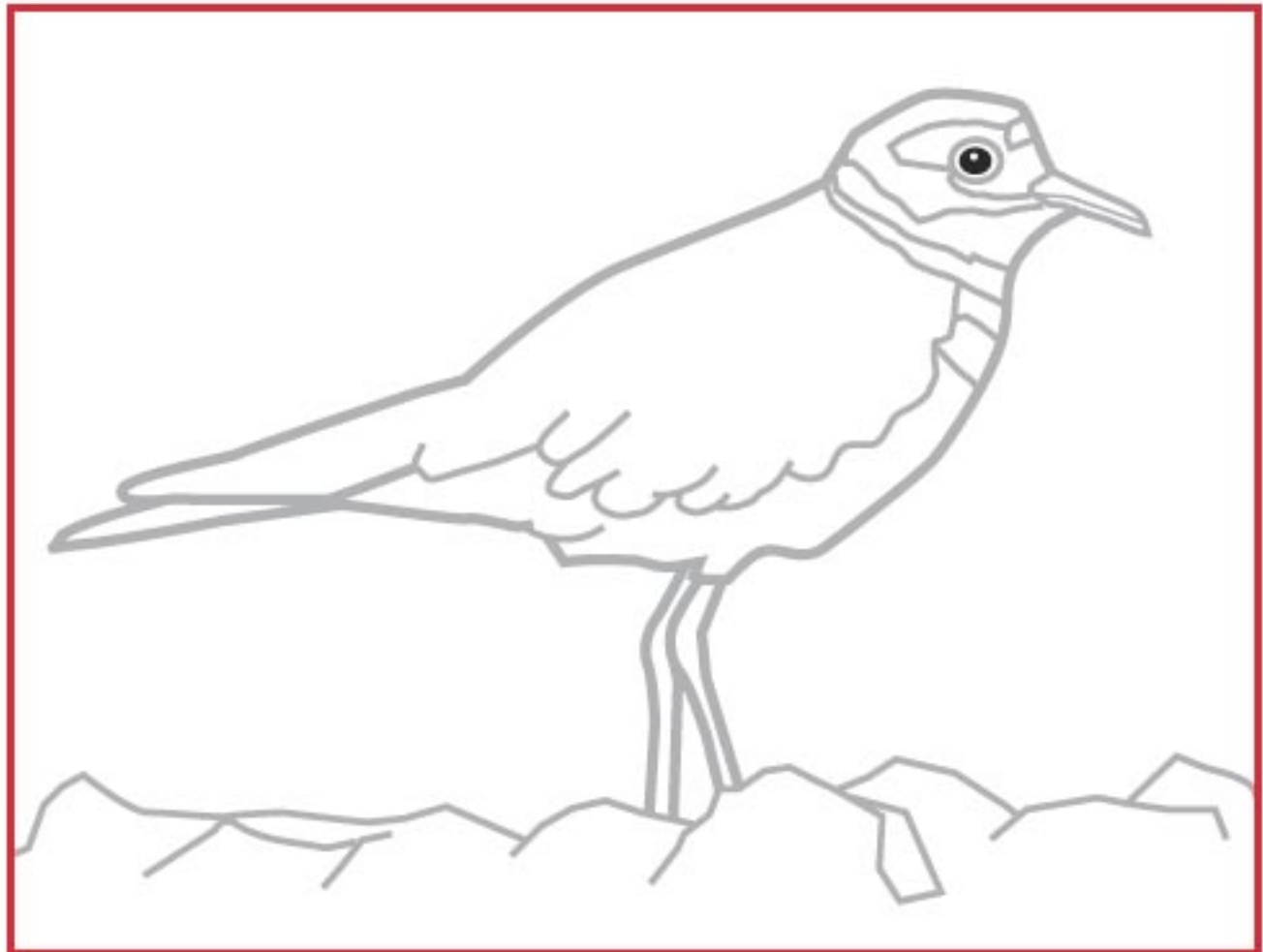
