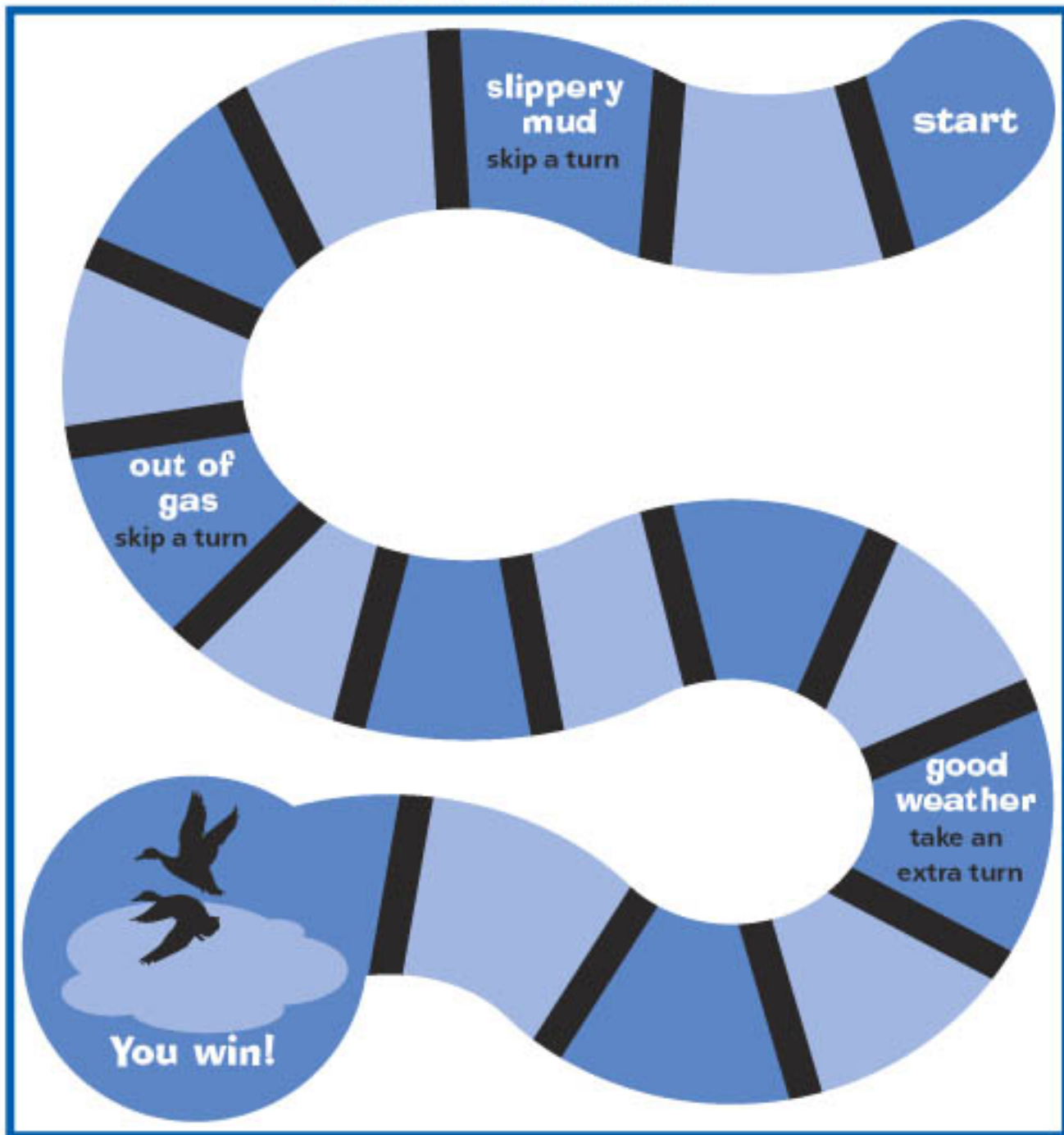

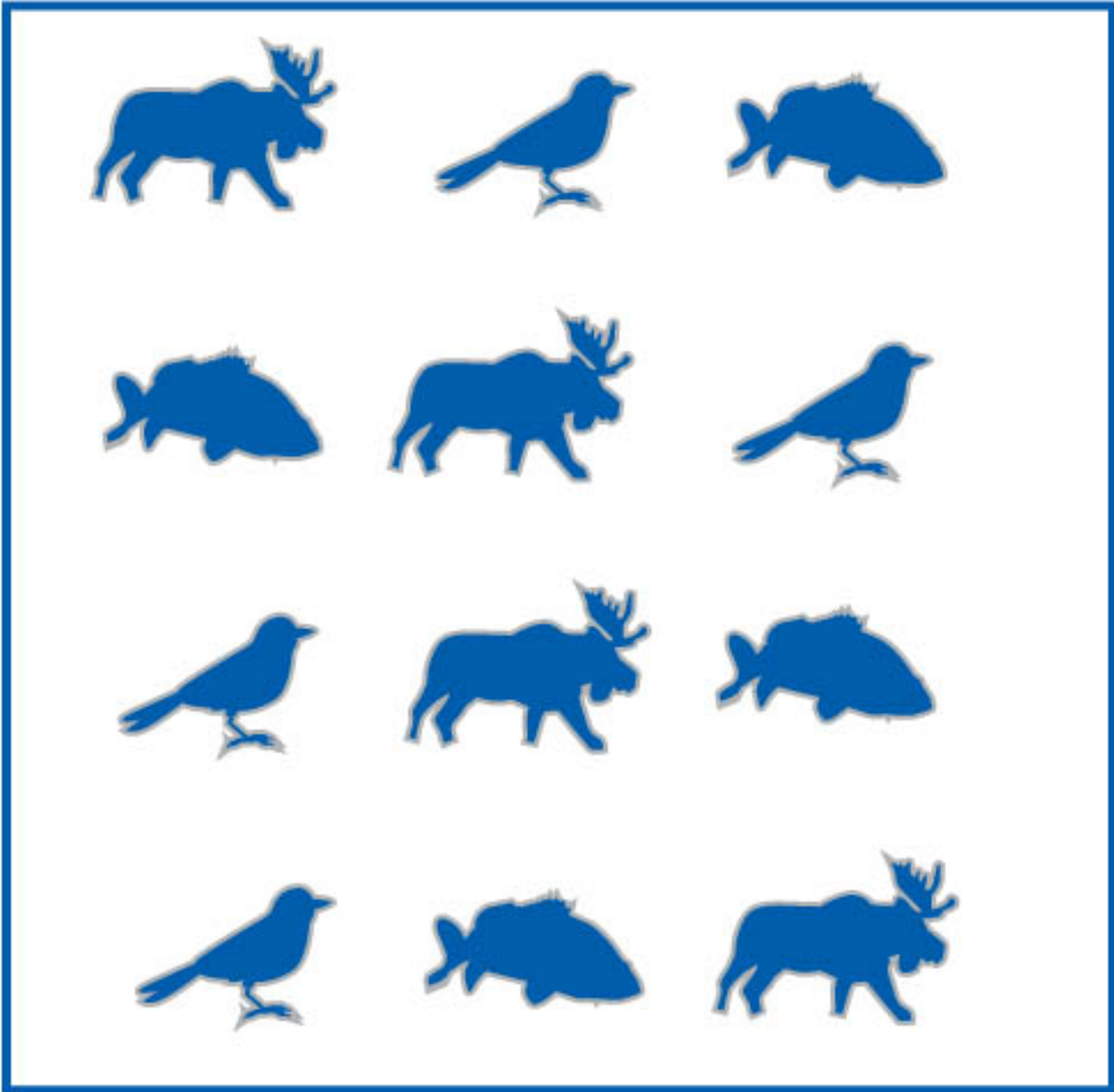
Dear Parents:
