Pool Operators Certification and Recertification Training Opportunities:

The Pool Operators Certification training is for individuals that are responsible for the structural and operational maintenance of pools, wading pools, diving tanks and spas located at apartments, hotels, health care facilities, home-owners associations or at any public and semi-private pool within the City of Albuquerque. All swimming pool operators are required to be trained and hold a valid certification prior to working on pools. Once the operator attends an approved training class and successfully passes the certification exam, their certification is valid for three years. The following are training course providers approved for the Albuquerque Environmental Health Department/Consumer Health Protection Division:
