## Federal

Reinstatements and those persons initially inactive are excluded for totals to be correct (table 6.4).
"Other" exits include administrative closings.

Data for "electronic monitoring" represented approximately $70 \%$ electronic monitoring; the remainder are nonelectronically monitored home confinement.

## Alabama

Data are reported by the State and Birmingham City Parole Department.

All data are estimated.
Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, sex, Hispanic origin, race, "intensive supervision," and electronic monitoring.

## Arizona

"Other" entries include cases from out-of-State.

## Arkansas

January 1 population count is estimated (table 6.2).
"Active" supervision status cases are estimated.
"Intensive supervision" cases are estimated (table 6.9).
"Other" entries include return from out-ofState, transfers, reactivated from detainer, absconders, and custody out-of-State and in-State.
"Other" exits includes detainer, out-ofState parole termination, absconder, and incarcerated out-of-State.
"Other" races includes Mexicans, Cubans, Europeans, Australians, and other non-Americans of unknown race.

## California

Data are reported by the Department of Corrections and the California Youth Authority.

Felons supervised in California are included in January 1 count, entries, exits, December 31 count, sex, Hispanic origin, and race.

California felon inmates paroled to another State through interstate compact agreements are not included in entries, exits, sex, Hispanic origin, and race.

The total number of supervision status excludes 15,012 absconders and 2,392 out-of-State cases because they are not included in December 31 count (table 6.2).
"Other" exits include suspensions and other releases.
"Returned to incarceration - with revocation" is included with "returned to incarceration — other" (table 6.5).
"Other" races include any person who could not be specifically classified. Detailed data are estimated for supervision status, Hispanic origin, race, and "electronic monitoring."
"Other" exits include "discharges-court action pending," absent without leave at discharge, and end of jurisdiction.
"Other" races include an unknown number of Filipinos and other unspecified.

## Colorado

Total entries and total exits are estimated (table 6.2).
"Active" cases include interstate compact cases into Colorado (table 6.3).
"Other" entries are estimated and include interstate compact from other States.

Data for "transferred to another parole jurisdiction" are estimated (table 6.5).

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, and race.
"Electronic monitoring" is included with "intensive supervision."

## Connecticut

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin and race.

## Delaware

Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, and sentence length.

December 31 count includes all Delaware parolees because there are no local jails (table 6.2).
"Electronic monitoring" is operated by an outside agency.

## District of Columbia

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin and sentence length.
"Other" entries include parole/reparole grants, administrative status, consecutive sentences, and detainers.

## Florida

All data include cases that serve time in community supervision (Parole, MCR, Conditional Pardon, Community Control, Supervised Community Release, Provisional Release, Conditional Release, Control Release, Administrative Control Release, and Conditional Medical Release).
"Other" exits include pardons.
"Other" race include Latins of unknown race and other unspecified.

## Georgia

Detailed data are not provied for Hispanic origin.

Detailed data are estimated for sex, race, sentence length, "intensive supervision," and "electronic monitoring."

Because of accounting procedures and record keeping, the January 1 count, plus entries, minus exits, does not equal December 31 count (table 6.2)

## Hawaii

Data are for calendar year ending June 1994.

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic orgin and race.
"Other" entries include cases from the mainland.
"Other" supervision status includes cases in institutions (Federal or State) awaiting sentence or in Federal institutions serving a sentence.

## Idaho

Detailed data are not provided for entries.
"Successful completion" is estimated (table 6.5).

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, and race.

## Illinois

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, and race.
"Other" entries include transfers from other States and other unspecified cases.
"Other" exits include transfers to the Apprehension Unit and other unspecified cases.
"More than a year" includes cases with sentence of "one year or more" (table 6.8).

## Indiana

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin, race, and sentence length.

## Iowa

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, race, and sentence length.

## Kansas

The following counts exclude 573 absconders: January 1, December 31, supervision status, sex, Hispanic origin, race, and sentence length.

December 31 count includes 4,239 inState cases, and 2,052 out-of-State cases (table 6.2).
"Other" entries include release from prerevocation and administrative holding confinement, and previous absconders placed in jail.
"Other" exits include absconders, expiration of sentence, pre-revocation confinement, confinement for administrative holding, and others involving Kansas offenders who are out-of-State.
"Returned to incarceration-with revocation" includes condition violators and "returned to incarceration-other" includes release to detainer-new sentence (table 6.5).

"Other" supervision status includes delinquents in custody.

## Massachusetts

Detailed data are estimated for entries, December 31 count, and "intensive supervision."
"Other" races include Hispanics of unknown race and other unknown.

## Minnesota

Detailed data are estimated for "electronic monitoring."

Some of the "active" count includes "inactive" cases (table 6.3).
"Other" entries include released to intensive community supervision program.
"Other" races include Hispanics of unknown race, other unspecified, and unknown.

## Mississippi

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin, and sentence length.
"Other" entries are due to an information lag.
"Other" exits include a combination of "returned to incarceration - with new sentence" and "Returned to incarceration with revocation."
"Other" races include a combined estimate of and Asian Hispanics of unknown race.

Programs for "electronic monitoring and "bootcamp" exist but only for offenders with an "inmate" status.

## Missouri

All data are estimated.
Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin.

## Montana

Detailed data are not provided for entries, exits, Hispanic origin, and sentence length.
"Other" races include a combination of all races other than white.

## Nebraska

Detailed data for sex, Hispanic origin, and race are estimated.

## Nevada

"Active" and "absconder" status cases are estimated (table 6.3).

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, race, and sentence length.

Detailed data are estimated for "intensive supervision" and "electronic monitoring."
"Returned to incarceration - with revocation" includes "returned to incarceration with new sentence" (table 6.5).
"Successful completion" is estimated (table 6.5).

## New Hampshire

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, and race.

## New Mexico

All data are estimated.
Because of accounting procedures and record keeping, January 1 count, plus entries, minus exits, does not equal December 31 count (table 6.2).

## New York

"Other" exits include board action and court orders.
"Other" races include Hispanics of unknown race and other unspecified.

## North Carolina

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin and sentence length.
"Other" entries include an adjustment residual.

## North Dakota

Detailed data are not provided for "intensive supervision" and "electronic monitoring."

North Dakota does not keep daily records of "absconders; data are collected at the termination of sentence (table 6.3).
"Other" exits include absconders and miscellaneous exits.

## Ohio

Detailed data are estimated for sex, Hispanic origin, and race.

Detailed data are not provided for sentence length and supervision status.
"Other" entries include out-of-State placement.
"Other" exits include status changed to inactive.

## Oklahoma

"Other" races include Hispanics of unknown race and unknown.

## Oregon

"Other" entries include transitional leave.
"Other" exits include cases unknown at the time of data collection.
"Intensive supervision" and "electronic monitoring" includes probation and parole cases.

## Pennsylvania

Detailed data are estimated for exits, sex,
Hispanic origin, and race.
Detailed data are not provided for sentence length.
"Other" supervisory status includes detainees.
"Other" exits include absconders, transfers, and unknown.

## Rhode Island

"Other" supervisory status includes INS detainees, persons in Federal detention or witness program, and persons under State detention warrants.
"Reinstatement of parole" includes reparole after revocation, (table 6.4).
"Returned to incarceration - other" includes "persons who are held on detention warrants by the parole board to serve the balance of the parole time expired while held on that warrant" (table 6.5).
"Other" exits includes absconders.

## South Carolina

Detailed data are not provided for Hispanic origin and sentence length.
"Other" supervision status includes supervised by INS.
"Other" exits include pardon and medical.
"Other" races include an unknown combination of all races other than black or white.

## South Dakota

Detailed data are estimated for Hispanic origin.

Tennessee
"Other" supervisory status includes detainer cases.
"Other" exits include expired sentence.
"Intensive supervision" is "enhanced supervision" (table 6.9).

## Texas

All data are estimated.
"Successful completion" includes discharged cases (table 6.5).
"Returned to incarceration - with revocation" includes all revocations for year including those with new convictions and those with no new convictions (table 6.5).
"Electronic monitoring" cases are included in the total "intensive supervision" cases.

## Utah

"Other" entries include parole to custody.
"Not of Hispanic origin" includes unknown (table 6.6).

## Virginia

Detailed data are estimated for sex.
"Other" entries include restored to supervision, transferred from other district, transfer from other State, returned from other States.
"Other" exits include out-of-State cases, termination, miscellaneous, administrative, and others.
"Other" races include Hispanic of unknown race and other unspecified.

## Washington

All data are estimated.
"Other" exits include out-of-State.
"Other" races include offenders of mixed race.

## Wisconsin

Because of missing data, January 1 count, plus entries, minus exits, does not equal December 31 count (table 6.2).
"Other" supervision status includes vacating order issued and violation warrant issued.
"Other" exits include voluntary/involuntary return, revised and remanded, and errors.

## Wyoming

"Other" supervisory status include compact cases supervised for another State.
