Examples of materials to be collected include:

- batteries
- paint & workshop supplies
- cleaning & pool supplies
- lawn & garden products
- indoor pesticides & thermometers
- automotive products
- and other hazardous chemicals

We CANNOT accept:

- animal manure/carcasses
- human waste or other biological waste (anything blood-related or bodily fluids, home IVs, tubing or dialysis equipment)
- sharps/needles
- spoiled food/mold damaged items
- tires, furniture and general trash
- ► Collect damaged chemical containers and place them curbside for proper disposal or take to a designated location.
- ► Clearly mark containers before placing them out for disposal. Place leaking containers in plastic bags to prevent spills.
- ► Household hazardous items may contain materials that should never be dumped, poured down drains or into streets.
