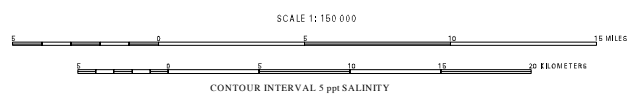
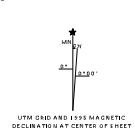


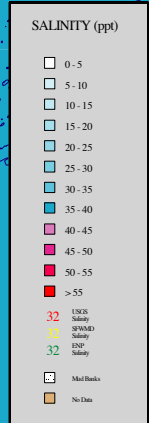

Salinity data collected by K. Ludwig and Nancy DeWitt of the U.S. Geological Survey between 25-27 October 1988. Data provided by the National Park Service, Everglades National Park was collected at monitoring stations between 25-27 October 1988. Data provided by South Florida Water Management District was collected by the Southeast Environmental Research Program of Florida International University on 25-27 October 1988. Salinity is calculated using Unesco algorithms from conductivity and temperature field measurements. Contours are based on interpolation and trends within the data set, developed and automated using contouring software.
