- Since September 1, 2005, loan agreements have been made to six companies for a total of 13.2 million barrels.
- Delivery quantities and schedules are determined by the purchaser through commercial facilities.
- Contracts are awarded "up to" the requested volume.

The loan agreement contracts are:

ExxonMobil has contracted for 6 million barrels, half sweet and half sour from Bayou Choctaw.

Valero has contracted for 1.5 million barrels of Bayou Choctaw sweet.

Placid Refining has contracted for 1.0 million barrels of sweet from Bayou Choctaw.

ATI (Total) has contracted for 1.2 million barrels of sour from Big Hill.

BP has contracted for 2.0 million barrels of Bayou Choctaw sweet.

Marathon has contracted for 1.5 million barrels total, of which 1.0 million barrels will be sweet and 500,000 barrels will be sour from Bayou Choctaw.
