Where special emphasis will be given to a specific TRIO program, we have noted that information. Some of the trainings will be held at the same time or close to the same time as a state meeting or a conference that you might also be attending. Where a training session is scheduled to coincide with a regional or state meeting/conference, we have noted that information
