Oregon E-waste Fees and Exemptions

The DAS statewide policy for Sustainable Acquisition and Disposal of Electronic Equipment (107-009-0050) considers most obsolete and/or excess electronic equipment to be e-waste. Items of this category include information technology equipment, the waste from such equipment, televisions, copiers, facsimile machines, oscilloscopes, telephones, radios, electronic test equipment and other equipment that is primarily comprised of circuit boards, CRT monitors, plasma monitors, and liquid crystal displays, and other electronic components.

*Items in this category: CPUs, LCD monitors, servers, laptops, printers, fax machines, cell phones, scanners, copiers and miscellaneous electronics. Electronics that have been separated from billable e-waste and sorted into lots by like items (e.g. all CPU's together) will not charged to the generating agency. Please refer to this sample Property Disposition Request (PDR) for an example of how e-waste should be sorted to minimize charges.
