The Board funded application 201-444 from the Grants Pass Irrigation District at it January 2002 at \$3 million, but did so in the context of a challenge grant with specific contingencies and timing requirements. OWEB funds were committed for removal of the dam itself, and must be matched with funding from other sources that will pay for other aspects of the project application, such as, renovation of water diversion facilities. The Board has now allocated \$1,250,000 towards the \$3,000,000 commitment.
