OWEB is proposing rule amendments related to the administration of the OWEB grant program, including landowner agreement requirements contained in 695-005-0060(4) and 695-005-0030(4); grant amendment requirements contained in 695-005-0050(1); the ability of the Director to enter into rule waivers contained in 695-005-0070 and in divisions 10, 35, and 40; and the consistent use of the terms Director, Board, and effectiveness monitoring in divisions 5 and 10. OWEB is also proposing new rule language in division 4 that frames the ability of the OWEB Board to make watershed enhancement investments through the regular grant program or specific initiatives or programs. Public comment will be accepted on the proposed rules from July 7, 2008 through 5 p.m. on Friday, August 1, 2008.
