

Figure 1: Prevalence of Disability by Age Group


Figure 2: Prevalence of Disability by Race/Ethnicity




Figure 4c: Health Care Coverage for Adults Under 65




Figure 4b: Immunizations




Figure 4d: Continuous Health Care Provider by Age Group
