Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 333-069 requires that any person removing or stabilizing paint on housing or child Care settings built before 1978 must obtain a Permit from the Department of Human Services. **Complete this form and return it with a check or money order in the amount of \$5.00 made payable to Department of Human Services, to:**

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In applying for this Permit, I understand that I am pledging to abide by the provisions of OAR 333-069, and specifically that when removing or stabilizing paint on housing or child Care settings built before 1978, I will do the following:

- 1. Not use prohibited work practices, including hydro or other power blasting and power-sanding unless the work area is contained in a way that permanently prevents paint dust and debris from creating a lead-based paint hazard.
- 2. When removing paint on pre-1978 housing or child Care settings, I will post a sign warning the public of POSSIBLE LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARDS. The writing on the sign shall be visible from 30 feet. (Signage is not required if a state-certified Inspector finds the work area to be free of lead-based paint).
- 3. Provide the required notification of possible lead-based paint hazards to owners or occupants of pre-1978 housing or child Care settings.

Social Security Numbers Required on Permit Applications

As part of your application for an initial or renewed lead-based paint permit issued by the Department of Human Services, you are required to provide your Social Security Number to the Department. This is mandatory. The authority for this requirement is **Oregon Laws 1997, Chapter 746, Section 117 (ORS 25.785) and 42 USC § 666 (a) (13).** Failure to provide your Social Security Number will be a basis to refuse to issue or renew the permit you seek. Although a number other than your Social Security Number appears on the face of the permit issued by the Department, your Social Security Number will be used for child support enforcement purposes only, unless you authorize other uses of the number.
