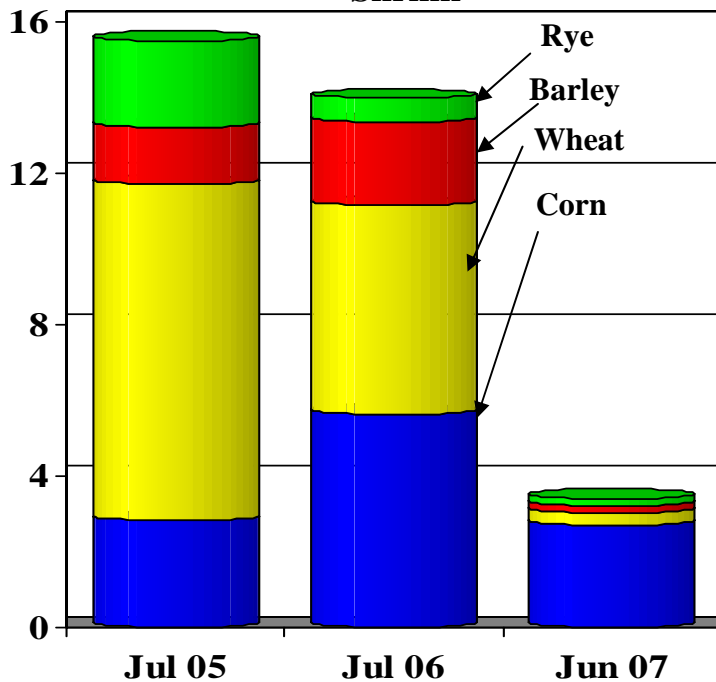




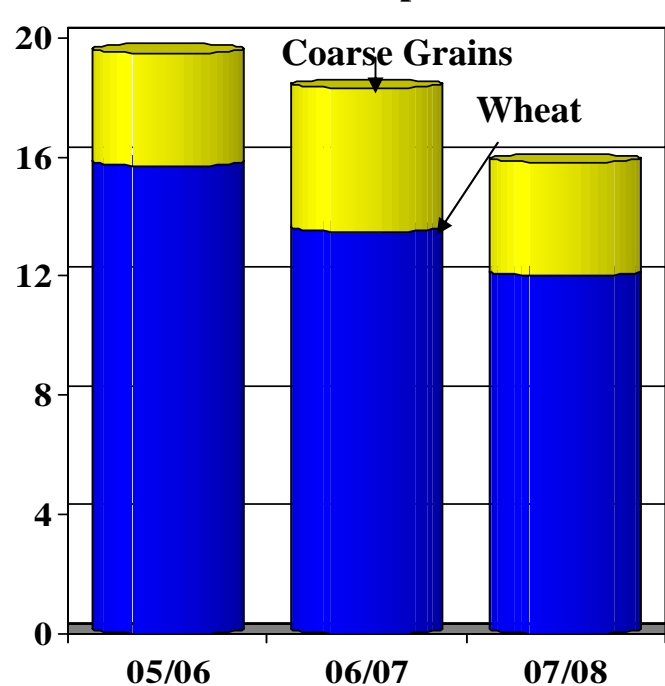

EU Grain Situation Expected to Be Tight in 2007/08

MMT **EU-27 Intervention Carryin Stocks Shrink**



MMT **EU-27 Exports Fall**



European grain supplies are expected to contract even further in 2007/08, exacerbating already tight global supplies. Very low carryin stocks and concern over crop prospects, especially in the eastern part of the Union, have caused domestic prices to soar. With intervention stocks for barley, wheat, and rye nearly completely depleted, the Commission is limited in its options for trying to dampen prices and ensure domestic feed millers have adequate supplies. As a result, the Commission may be reluctant to approve export licenses early in the season, similar to past years when domestic supplies were tight. With crops also shrinking in the Black Sea region, less European supplies could mean key Mediterranean markets will have to turn more to grain suppliers outside the region. For wheat, this could mean larger sales from the United States, where a larger crop is expected. For barley, it will likely mean stronger sales of Australian new crop barley to markets such as Saudi Arabia.

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The Foreign Agricultural Service (FAS) updates its production, supply and distribution database for cotton, oilseeds, and grains at 9 a.m. on the day the World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report is released. It is available on the FAS website (<http://www.fas.usda.gov/psdonline/>). This circular is released at 9:30 a.m. on the same day, together with its downloadable data set.

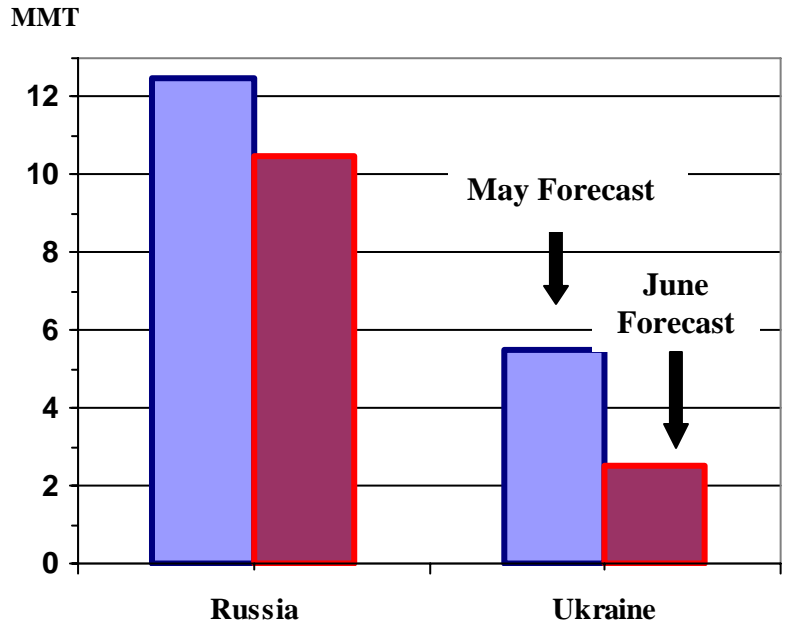

WHEAT: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:

Lower Exportable Supplies in the Black Sea Region: The sharp forecast drop in Ukraine's (-55%) and Russia's (-16%) exports this month provides a window of opportunity for other major suppliers. Not only are exports expected down, but Ukrainian supplies may not be available for export until later in the year because the government has stated it may temporarily curtail exports to pressure potentially high domestic prices. On the other hand, Russia is not expected to constrain exports. Both countries primarily export lower protein wheat to the Middle East and Mediterranean markets that use the grain for both feed and food.

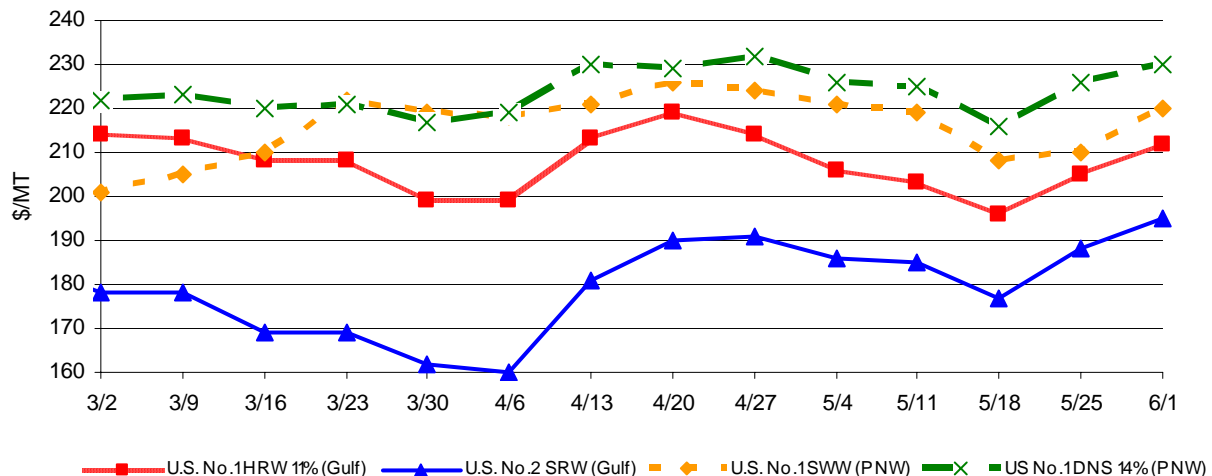
**Russian and Ukrainian

PRICES:

Domestic: For May, wheat prices for all classes dipped at the beginning of the month on favorable growing conditions, and then climbed on reports of considerable crop damage in Ukraine and Russia due to dry, hot weather. For the month, Hard Red Winter (HRW) rose \$6 per ton, Hard Red Spring (HRS) rose \$4, Soft Red Winter (SRW) rose \$9, and Soft White (SWW) fell \$1.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2007/2008

Selected Exporters

- **Argentina** is up 1.0 million tons to 9.5 million as higher production raises export prospects.
- **China** is up 500,000 tons to 2.5 million on expectations of attractive global feed quality wheat prices.
- **Russia** is down 2.0 million tons to 10.5 million as lower area and dry weather cuts exportable supplies.
- **Ukraine** is down 3.0 million tons to 2.5 million on exceptionally poor crop conditions that are expected to reduce production.
- **United States** is up 500,000 tons to 27.0 million due to slack competition from other major suppliers.

Selected Importers

- **EU-27** is down 1.0 million tons to 6.0 million on anticipation of smaller exportable supplies from the Black Sea region.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2006/2007

Selected Exporters

- **Argentina** is up 500,000 tons to 11.0 million with stronger than expected late-season exports.
- **EU-27** is down 500,000 tons to 13.5 million on reduced export sales and shipments.

Selected Importers

- **Azerbaijan** is up 300,000 tons to 1.0 million with continued strong late-season imports.
- **EU-27** is up 300,000 tons to 5.5 million due to pace to date.
- **India** is up 400,000 tons to 6.7 million on larger than expected imports.

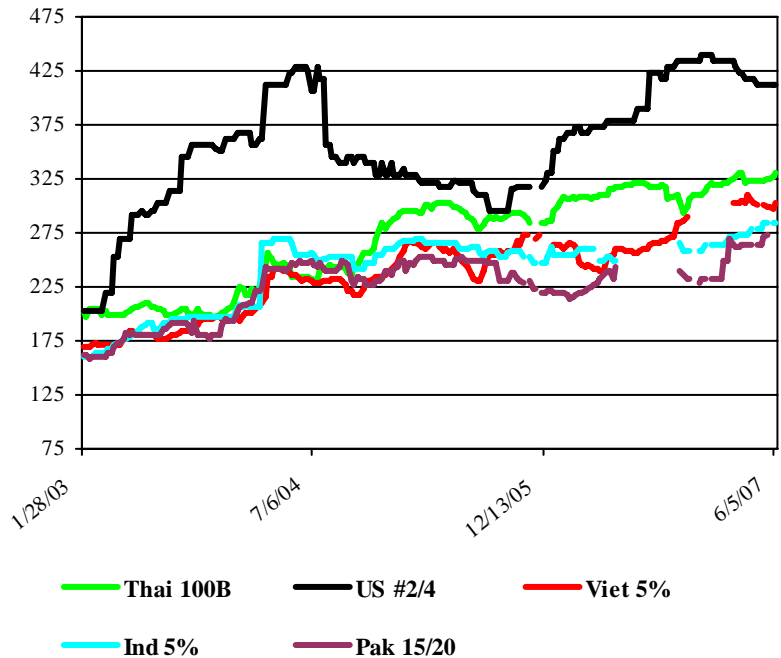
RICE: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES:

International: Thai quotes are up \$7 from last month to \$331 per ton, FOB, reflecting tight supplies and increased demand. Nominal quotes out of Vietnam are at \$303 per ton, FOB and reflect tight supplies.

Domestic: U.S. #2/4 long grain milled rice quotes are unchanged from last month at \$412 per ton, FOB. However, the spread between U.S. and Thai quotes is \$81, compared to \$61 per ton this time last year. California medium grain #1/4 prices remain unchanged from last month at \$525 per ton, FOB.

Selected Importers

- **Indonesia** is up 200,000 tons to 2.0 million tons on the expectation of additional buying.
- **Iran** is up 300,000 tons to 1.2 million tons based on a strong import pace.
- **Iraq** is down 400,000 to 900,000 tons due to slow buying and high shipping rates.

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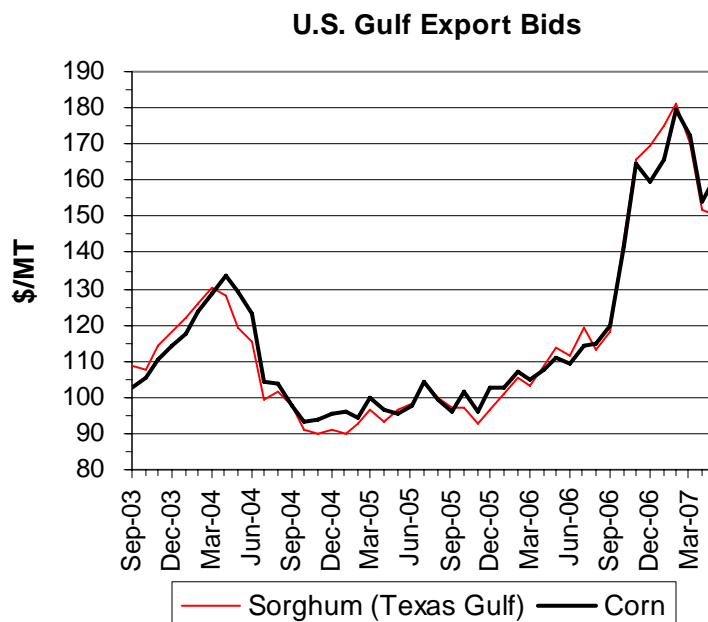

COARSE GRAINS: WORLD MARKETS AND TRADE

PRICES:

Domestic: May export bids for U.S. #2 yellow corn averaged \$161, up \$7 per ton and reversing a 2-month decline.

A large year-to-year increase in corn plantings and a strong finish to the planting season combined to ease supply concerns. However, continuing weather uncertainties, and strength in other commodity prices have supported higher corn prices.



TRADE CHANGES IN 2007/2008

Selected Exporters

- **Argentina barley** is raised 100,000 tons to 500,000 because of a higher production forecast.
- **Australia barley** is strengthened 200,000 tons to 4.5 million in expectation of less competition from Ukraine.
- **EU-27 barley** is up 300,000 tons to 3.0 million due to an increased production estimate and less competition from Black Sea suppliers.
- **Ukraine barley** is cut 1.0 million tons to 3.5 million as hot, dry weather reduced crop forecasts.

Selected Importers

- **Morocco barley** is raised by 200,000 tons to its highest level in nearly a decade at 900,000 because of a drought-decimated crop.
- **Saudi Arabia barley** is cut by 500,000 tons to 6.0 million due to the overall tighter global market.

TRADE CHANGES IN 2006/2007

Selected Exporters

- **United States corn** is cut by 1.0 million tons to 54.0 million as sales and shipments begin to slow and Southern Hemisphere competition is heating up.
- **Argentina corn** is raised 1.0 million tons to 14.0 million as export registrations have been partially opened and new-crop shipments are brisk. In addition, the production forecast is up 500,000 tons this month.
- **EU-27 corn** is up 200,000 tons to 500,000 based on export licenses.
- **Ukraine barley** is reduced 300,000 tons to 4.0 million because of a lowered new-crop production estimate.

Selected Importers

- **Colombia corn** is raised 200,000 tons to a record 3.5 million based on the pace of U.S. sales and shipments.
- **EU-27 corn** is boosted by 500,000 tons to 5.0 million and **EU-27 sorghum** is raised 200,000 tons to 600,000, both in line with recent import license awards. Tight domestic feed grain supplies, a strong Euro, and low or zero duties have stimulated imports.
- **China barley** is down 300,000 tons to 1.5 million. China imports malting barley and current high prices are inducing adjustments in the Chinese brewing industry. A similar change was made to the 2007/08 estimate.

Stocks: Unless otherwise stated, stock data are based on an aggregate of differing local marketing years and should not be construed as representing world stock levels at a fixed point in time.

Consumption: World totals for consumption reflect total utilization, including food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste; as well as differences in marketing year imports and marketing year exports. Consumption statistics for regions and individual countries, however, reflect food, seed, industrial, feed, and waste only.

EU Consolidation: The trade figures starting from 1999/00 represent EU-27 and exclude all intra-trade. For the years 1960/61 through 1998/99, figures are the EU-15 and also exclude all intra-trade. EU-15 member states' data for grains are no longer maintained in the official USDA

database. Data for the individual NMS-10, plus Bulgaria and Romania, exists only prior to 1999/00.

Statistics: (1) Wheat trade statistics include wheat, flour, and selected pasta products on a grain equivalent basis. (2) Rice trade statistics include rough, brown, milled, and broken on a milled equivalent basis. (3) Coarse grains statistics include corn, barley, sorghum, oats, rye, millet, and mixed grains but exclude trade in barley malt, millet, and mixed grains.

Unaccounted: This term includes grain in transit, reporting discrepancies in some countries, and trade to countries outside the USDA database.
