

Important InformationAbout Your Prescription Drug Coverage

This information is for any member of your household who has **both** Medicare and Medicaid (Oregon Health Plan) coverage.

On January 1, 2006, a new federal program called the Medicare Prescription Drug program will pay for most of your prescription drugs, instead of the Oregon Health Plan (OHP).

What this Means to You

On January 1, 2006, your Medicare Advantage Plan will start paying for most of your prescription drugs. Because you are already in a Medicare Advantage Plan that will pay for your prescription drugs on January 1, 2006, you do not have to do anything to receive this new drug benefit.

In October, your Medicare Advantage Plan will send you a list of the drugs they will pay for, the pharmacies you can use, and other important information about your drug benefit.

The OHP will continue to pay for all other covered health services.

In the fall of 2005, the federal government will send you information explaining the Medicare Prescription Drug program, its coverage, and how it affects you.
