

Important Medical Information

Your options for choosing a primary care provider (PCP)

Effective March 1, 2006, OMAP enrolled some or all members of your household into Central Oregon Independent Health Services (COIHS)'s managed care plan. OMAP has contracted with this plan to manage and provide your medical care.

You have a choice

Because the North Lake Clinic does not accept COIHS clients, OMAP is offering you a choice:

- If you choose to stay with COIHS, you will need to select one of their listed providers as your PCP.
- If you choose not to be enrolled in COIHS, you will have an “open card” or fee-for-service OMAP Medical ID.

OHP clients who are not enrolled in a Medical Plan can receive medical services from any provider who will accept their OMAP Medical Care ID.

If you want the North Lake Clinic to provide your health care services, you can choose to be disenrolled from COIHS and then receive services from the North Lake Clinic on a fee-for-service basis.

Medical Care ID


Your April OMAP Medical Care ID will show either COIHS as your Medical Plan, or it will show that you are not in any Medical Plan.

Dental and Mental Health Care

Your Dental and Mental Health Plans have not changed. You will continue to receive these services from your current providers.
